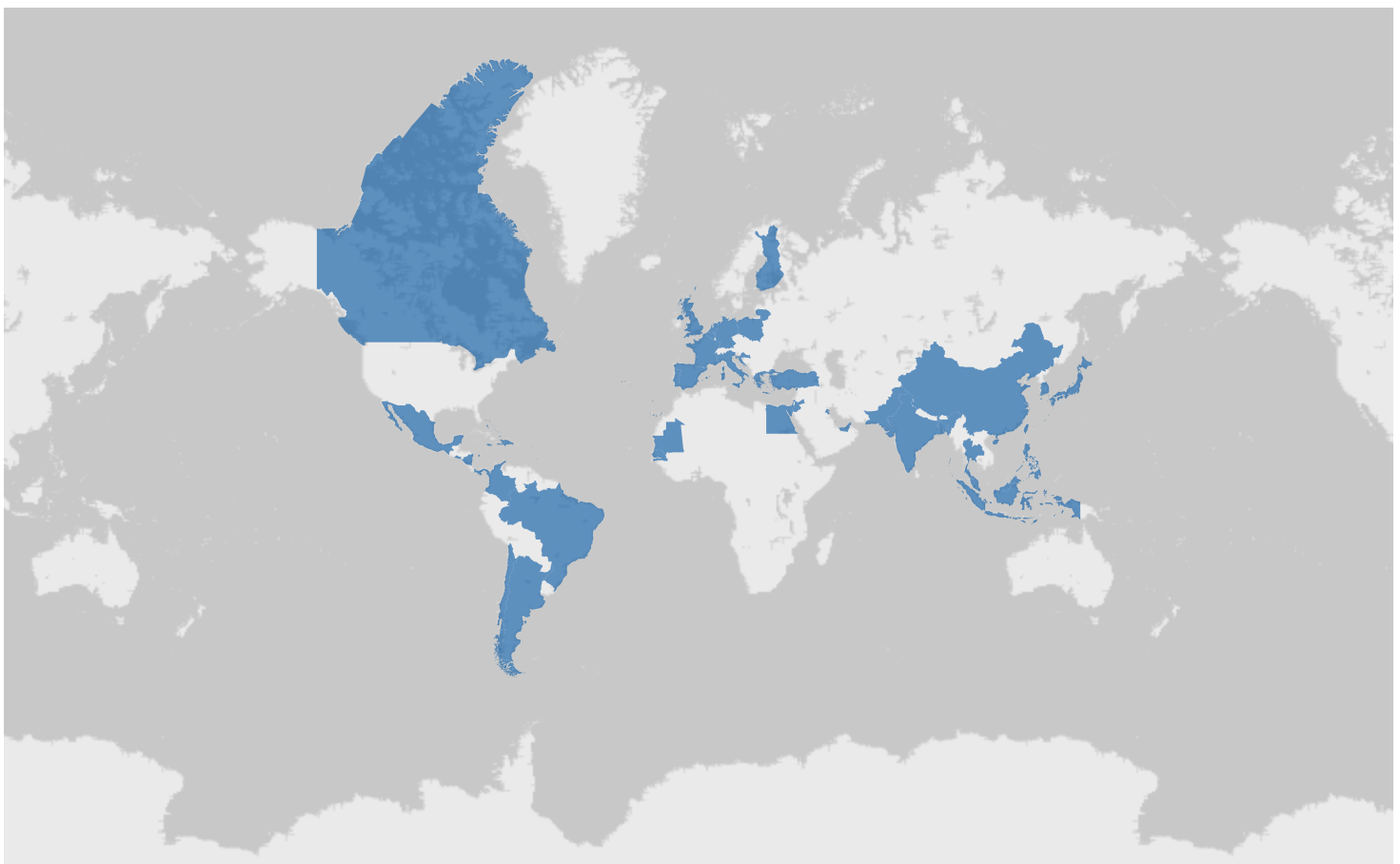

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Executive Summary

July 2026

Summary

In July 2026, United States natural gas exports were 827.2 Bcf and imports were 251.8 Bcf, resulting in 575.4 Bcf of net exports.

U.S. LNG Exports

U.S. exports of natural gas in the form of liquefied natural gas (LNG) were 518.7 Bcf (62.7% of total U.S. natural gas exports) and reached 35 countries.

- Asia (201.5 Bcf, 38.8%), Europe (200.5 Bcf, 38.7%), Africa (77.6 Bcf, 15.0%), Latin America/ Caribbean (39.1 Bcf, 7.5%)
- 0.4% decrease from June 2026
- 18.7% increase from July 2025
- 85.7% of total LNG exports went to non-Free Trade Agreement countries (nFTA), while the remaining 14.3% went to Free Trade Agreement countries (FTA).

U.S. LNG exports to the top five countries of destination accounted for 51.1% of total U.S. LNG exports.

- Egypt (75.6 Bcf, 14.6%), Netherlands (54.7 Bcf, 10.5%), India (47.0 Bcf, 9.1%), Japan (46.9 Bcf, 9.0%), and Italy (40.9 Bcf, 7.9%).

U.S. Imports and Exports by Pipeline and Truck with Mexico

U.S. natural gas exports to Mexico were 227.6 Bcf and imports from Mexico were 0.1 Bcf, resulting in 227.4 Bcf of net exports.

- 0.6% increase from June 2026
- 6.6% increase from July 2025

U.S. Imports and Exports by Pipeline and Truck with Canada

U.S. natural gas exports to Canada were 80.9 Bcf and imports from Canada were 251.3 Bcf, resulting in 170.5 Bcf of net imports.

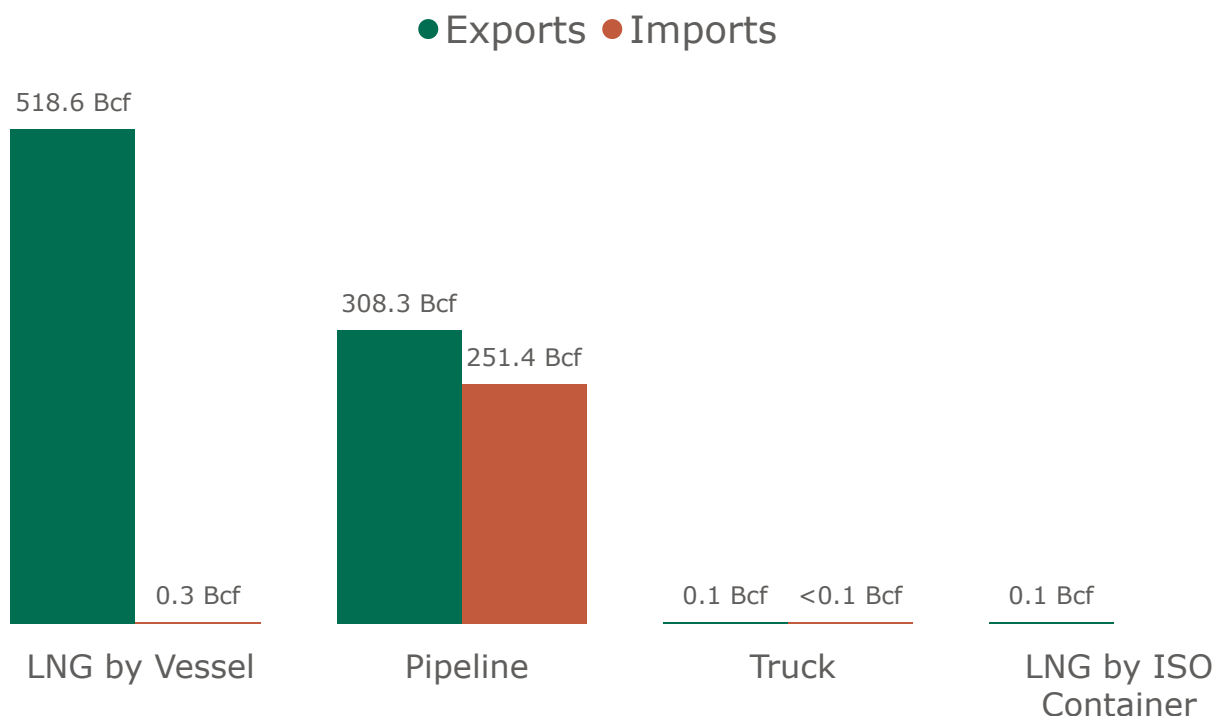

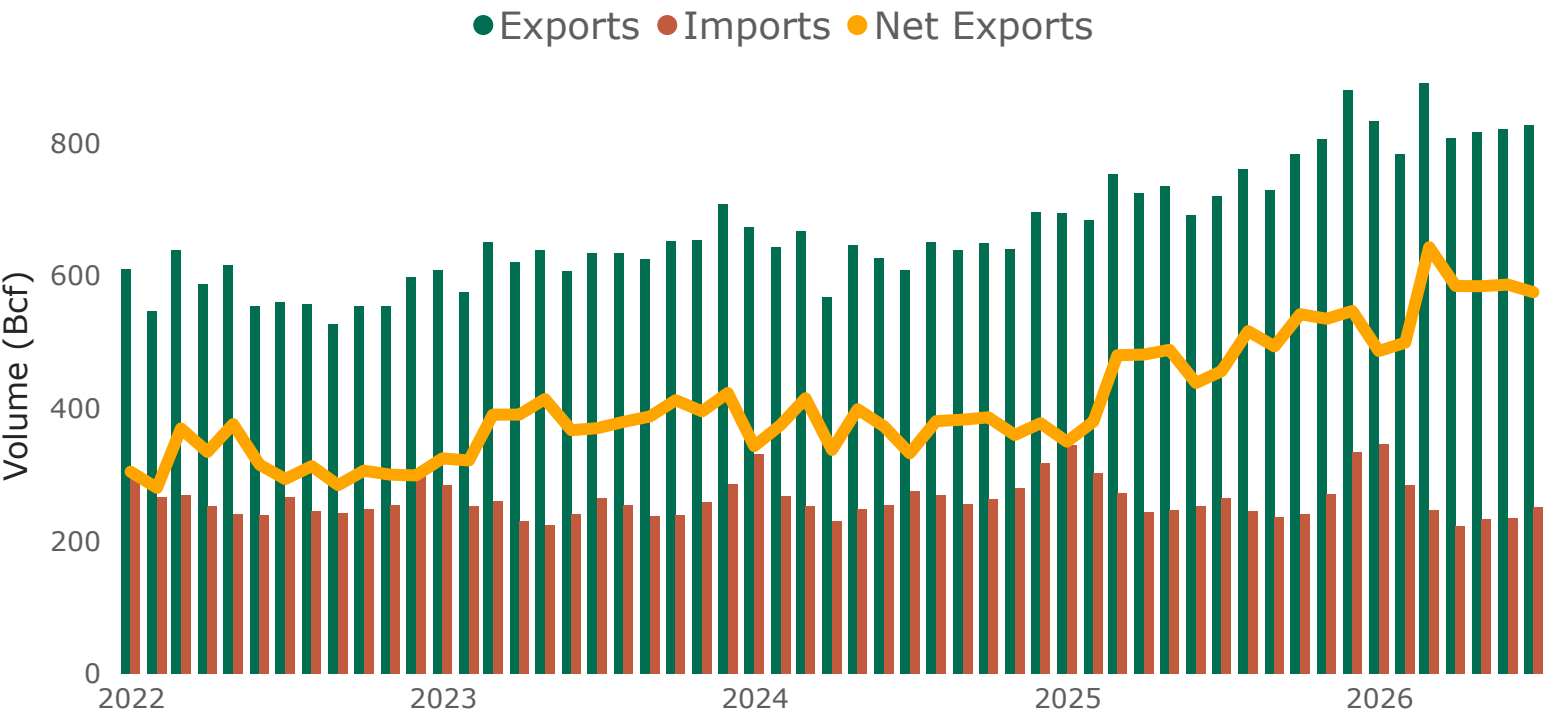

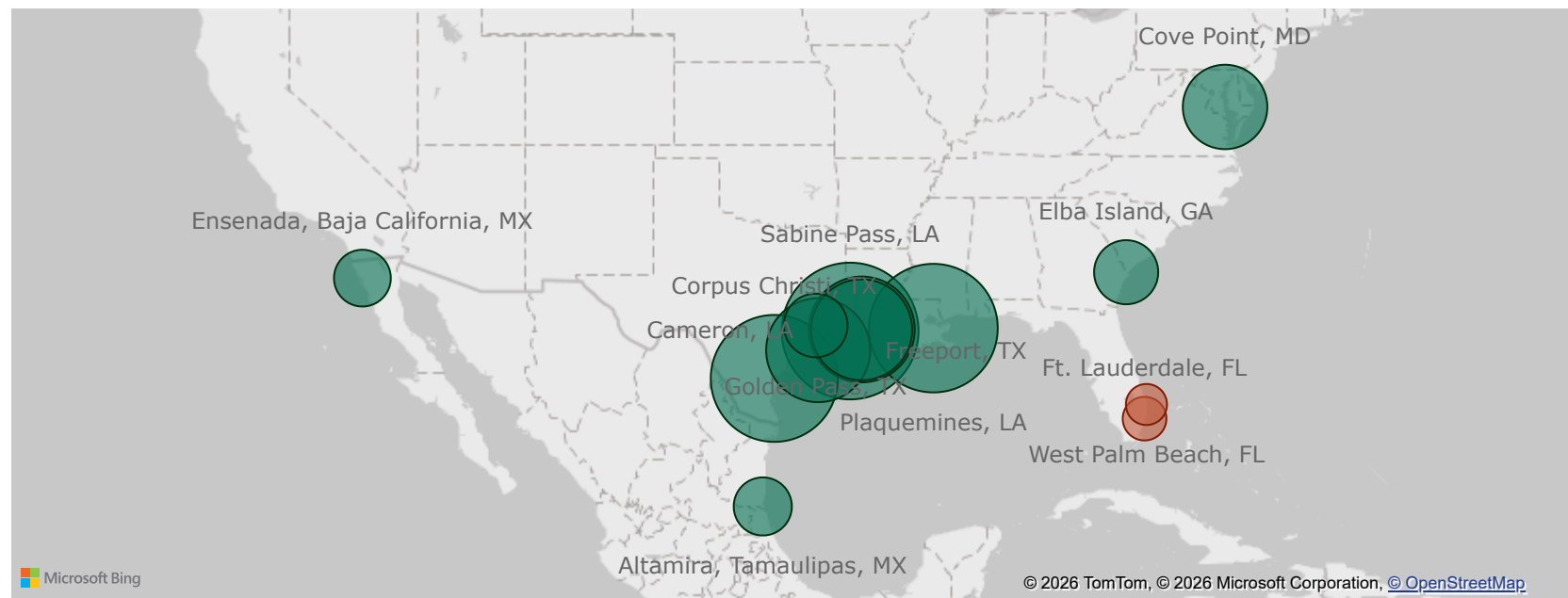

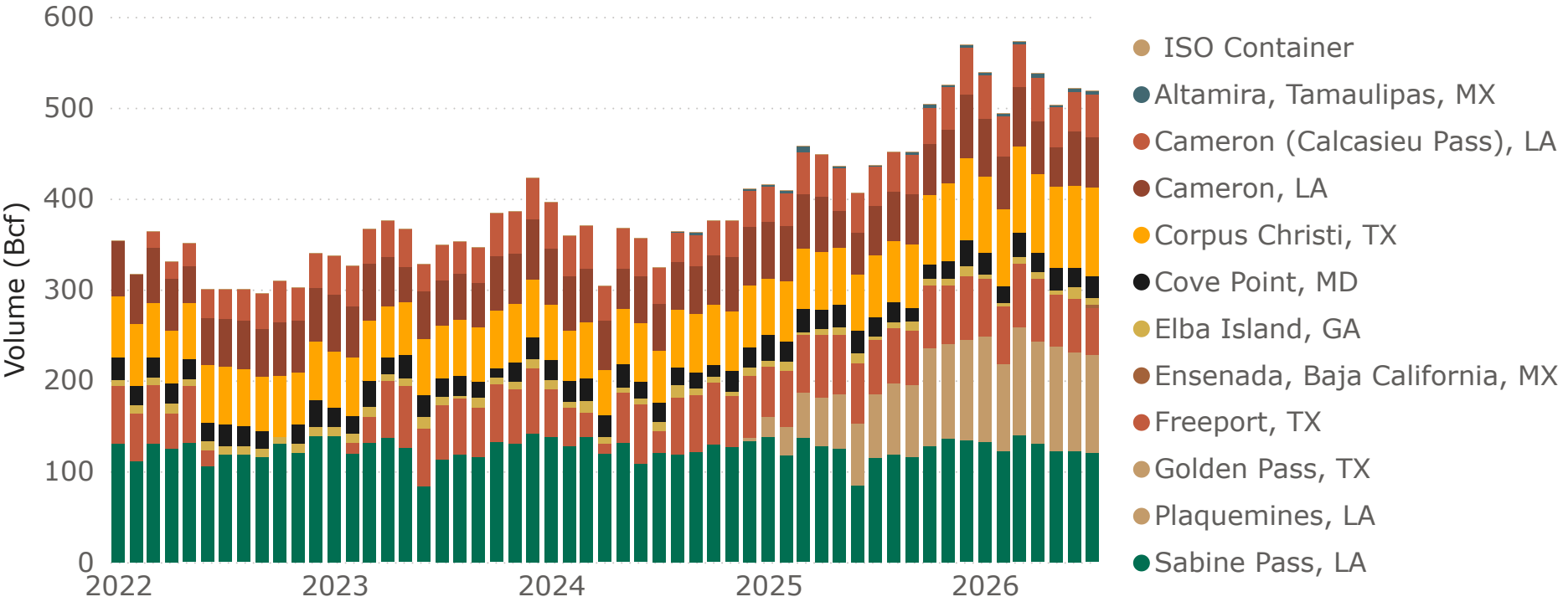

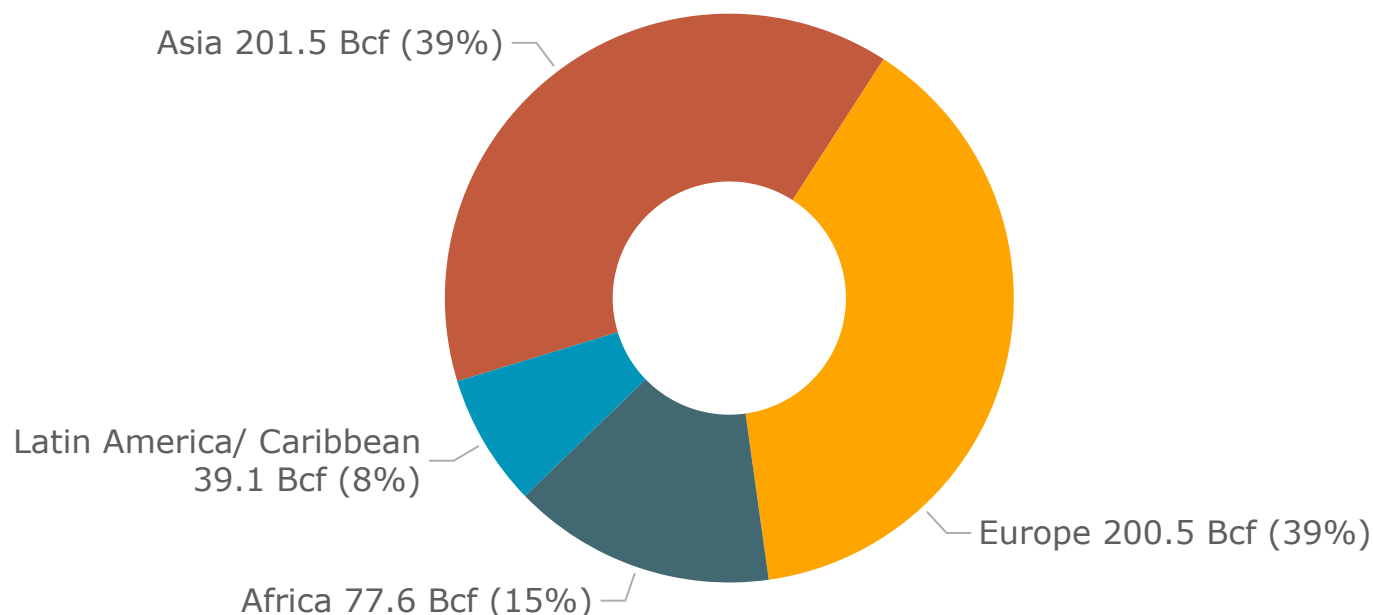

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U.S.-Produced LNG Exports by Region of Destination



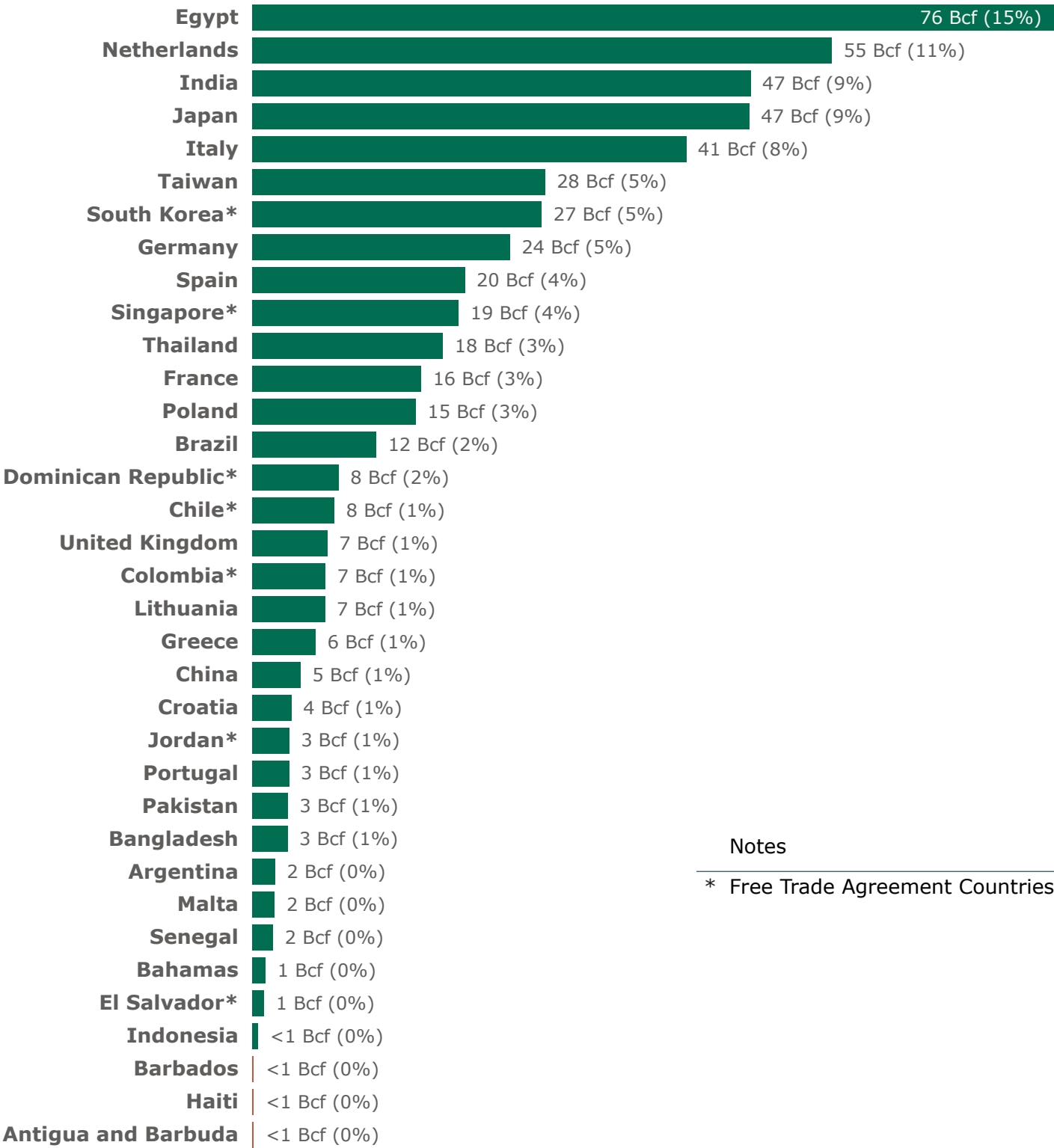
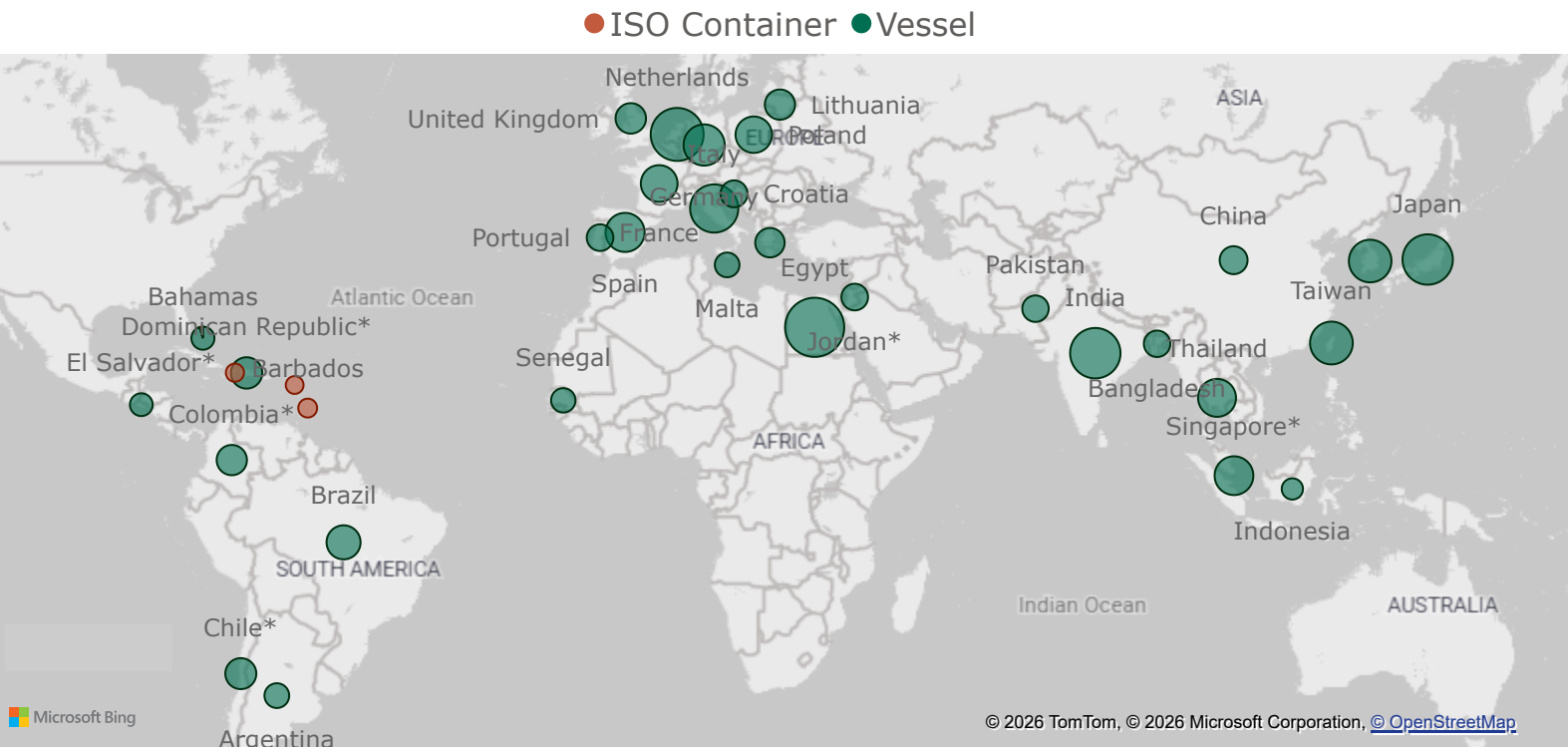

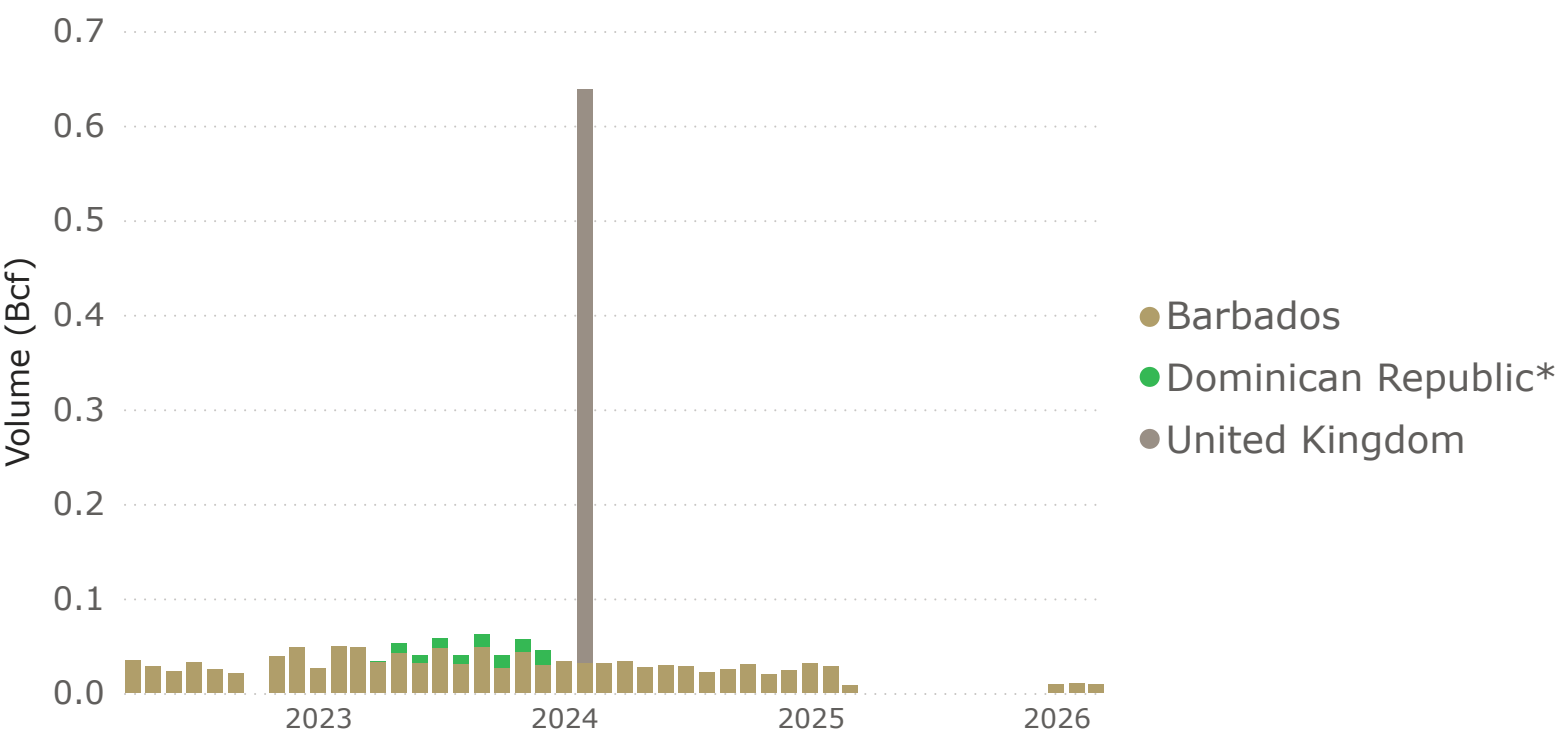

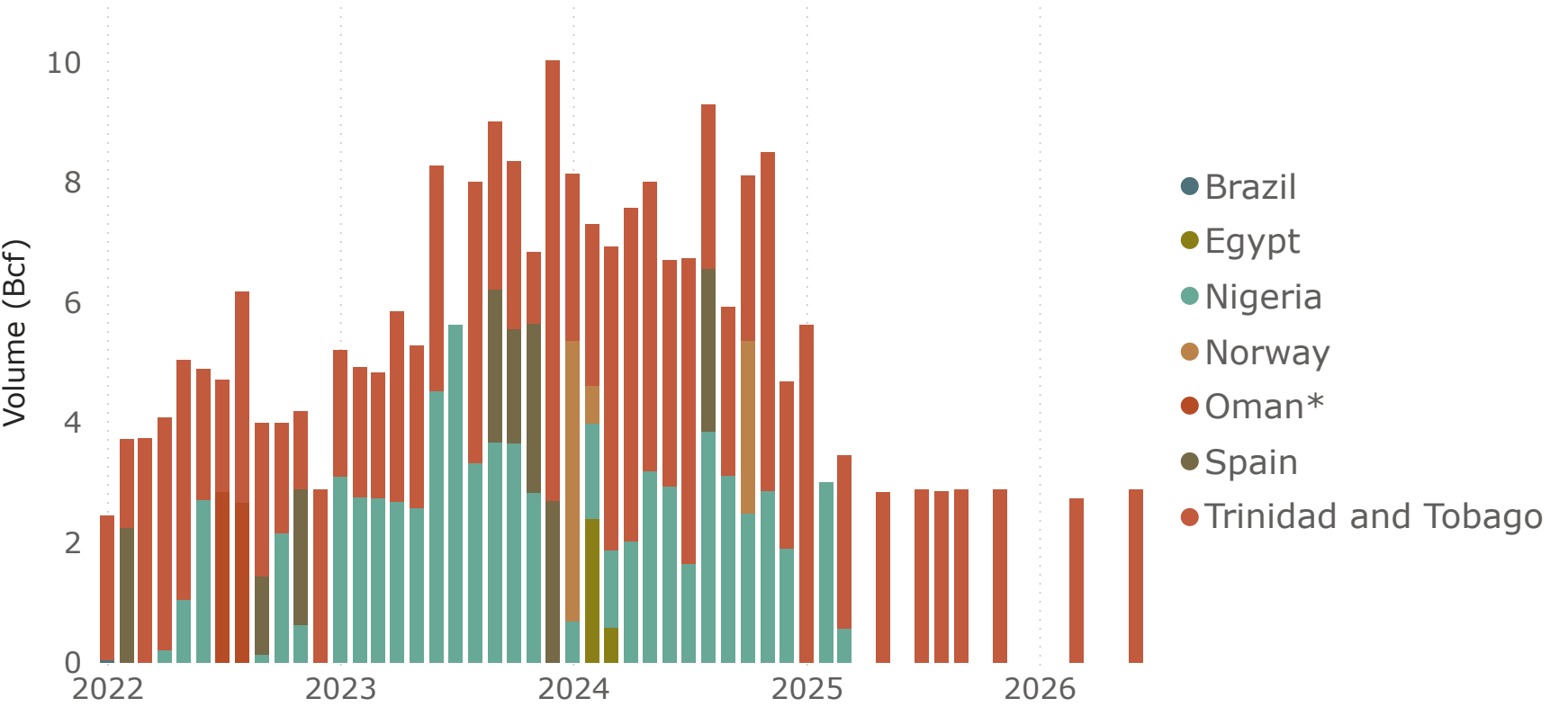

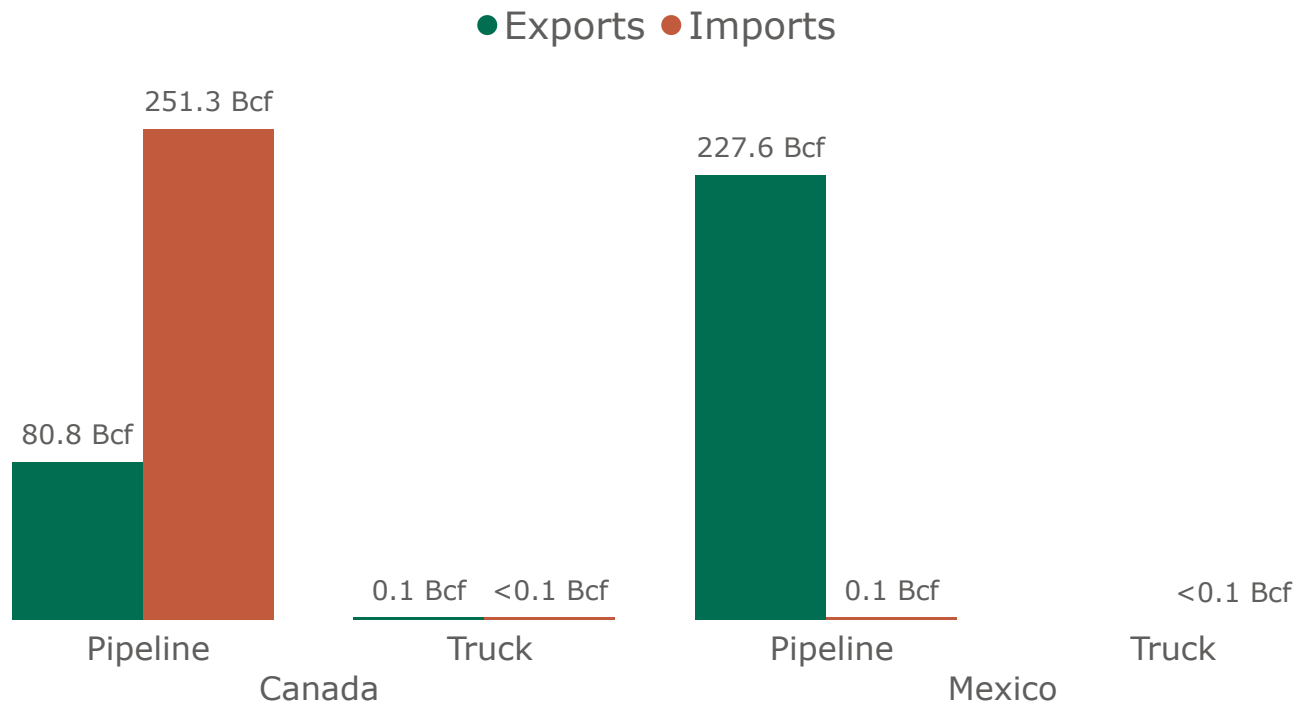

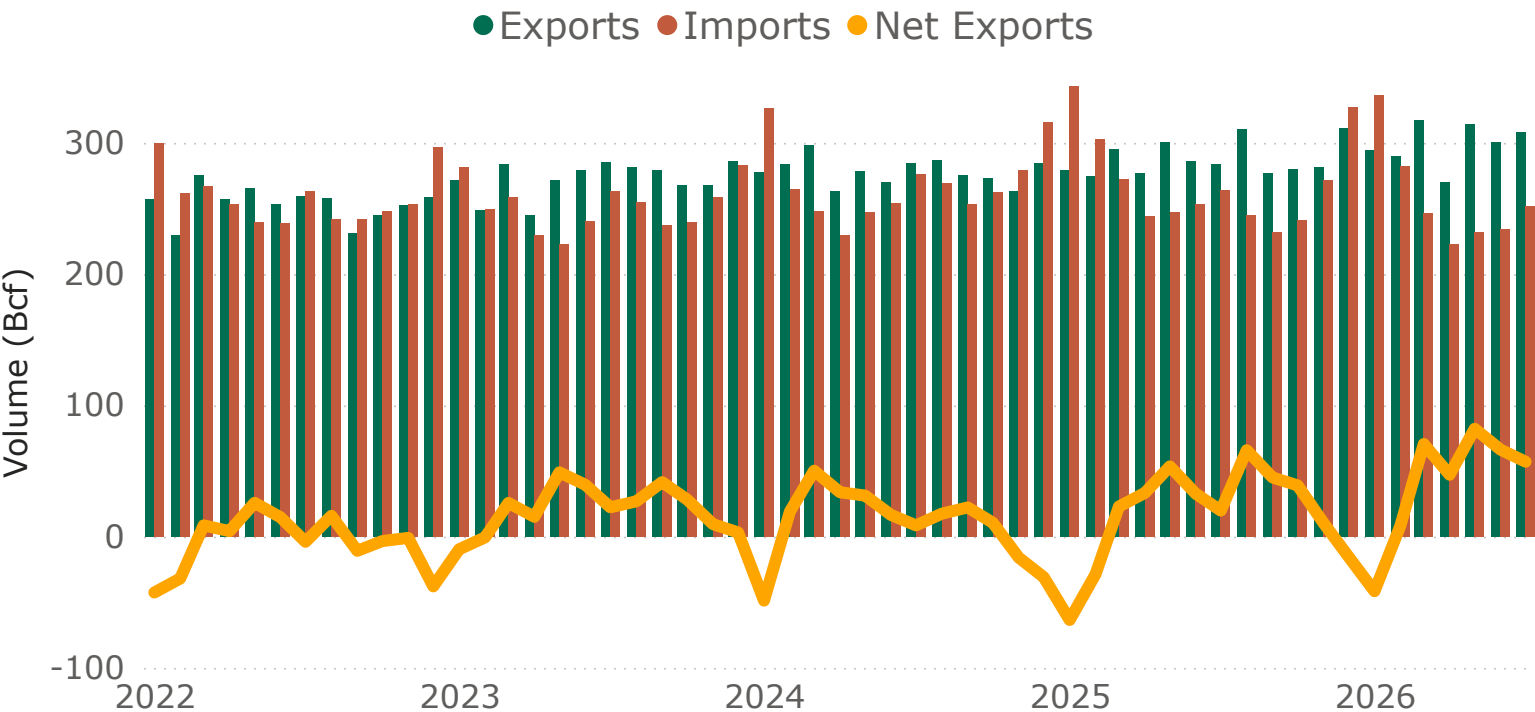

U.S. Natural Gas Imports & Exports by Pipeline & Truck



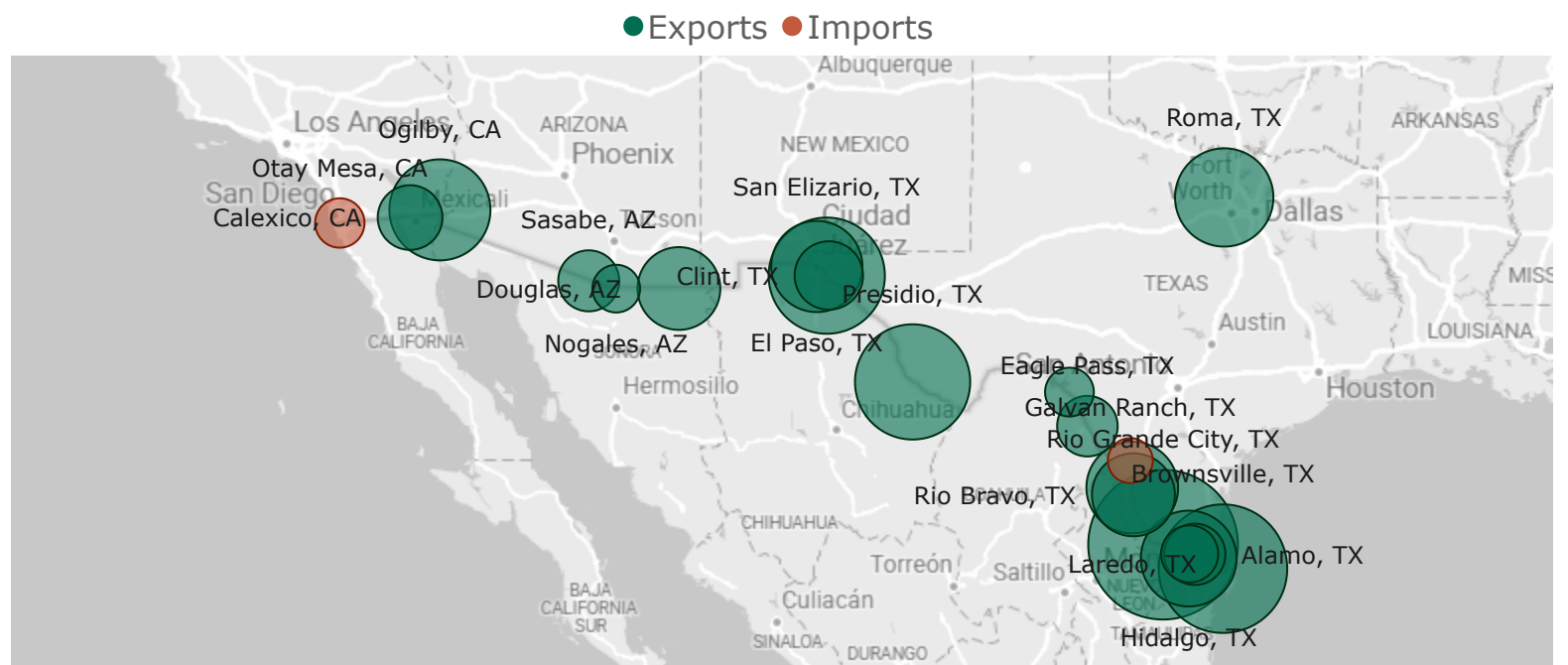

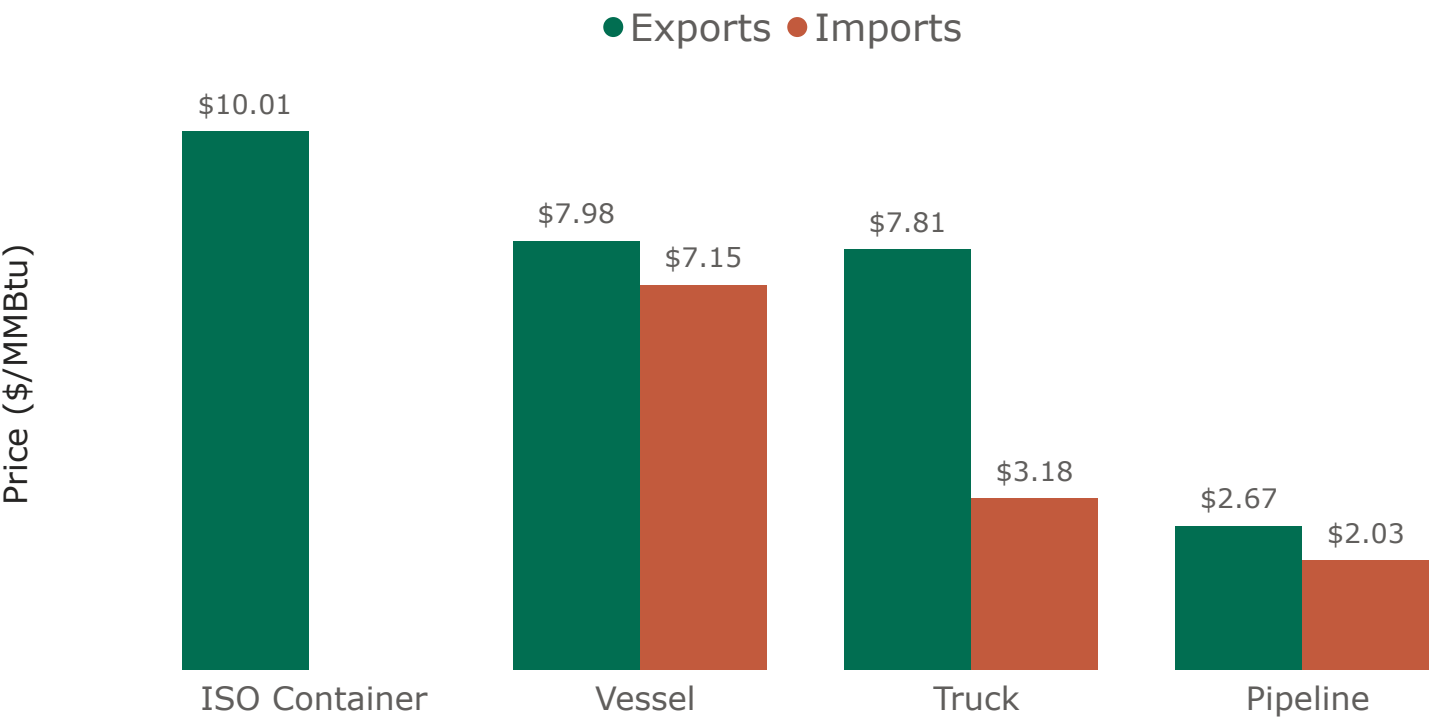

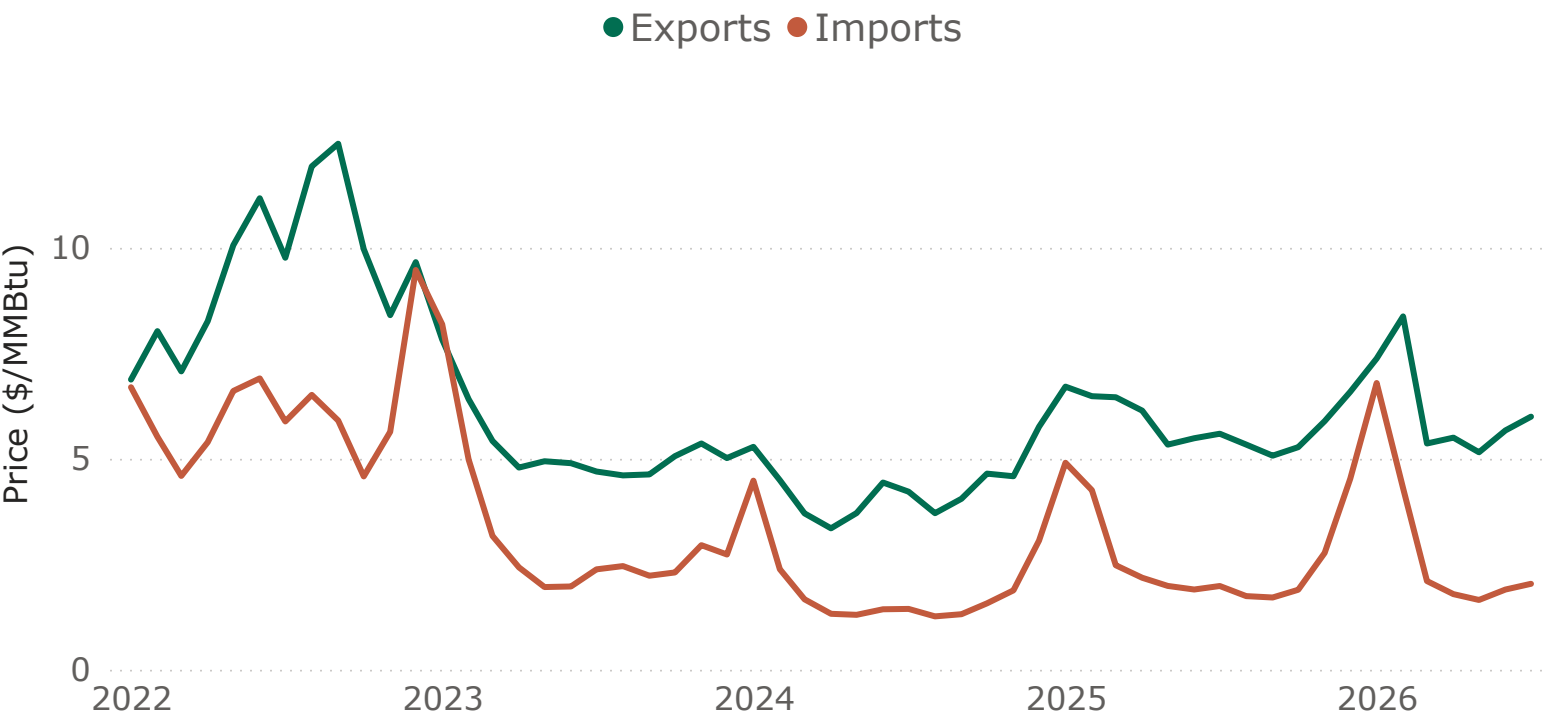

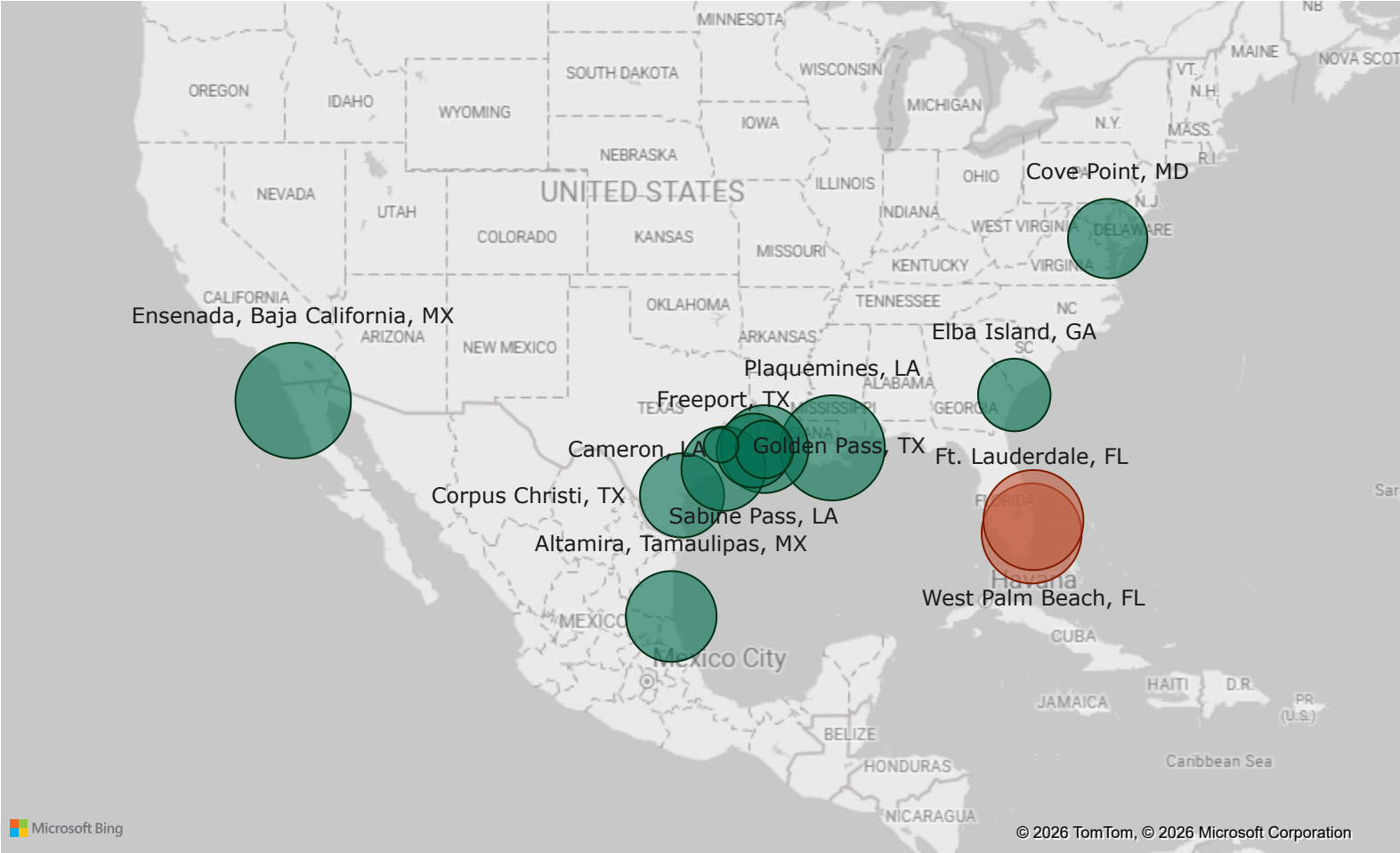

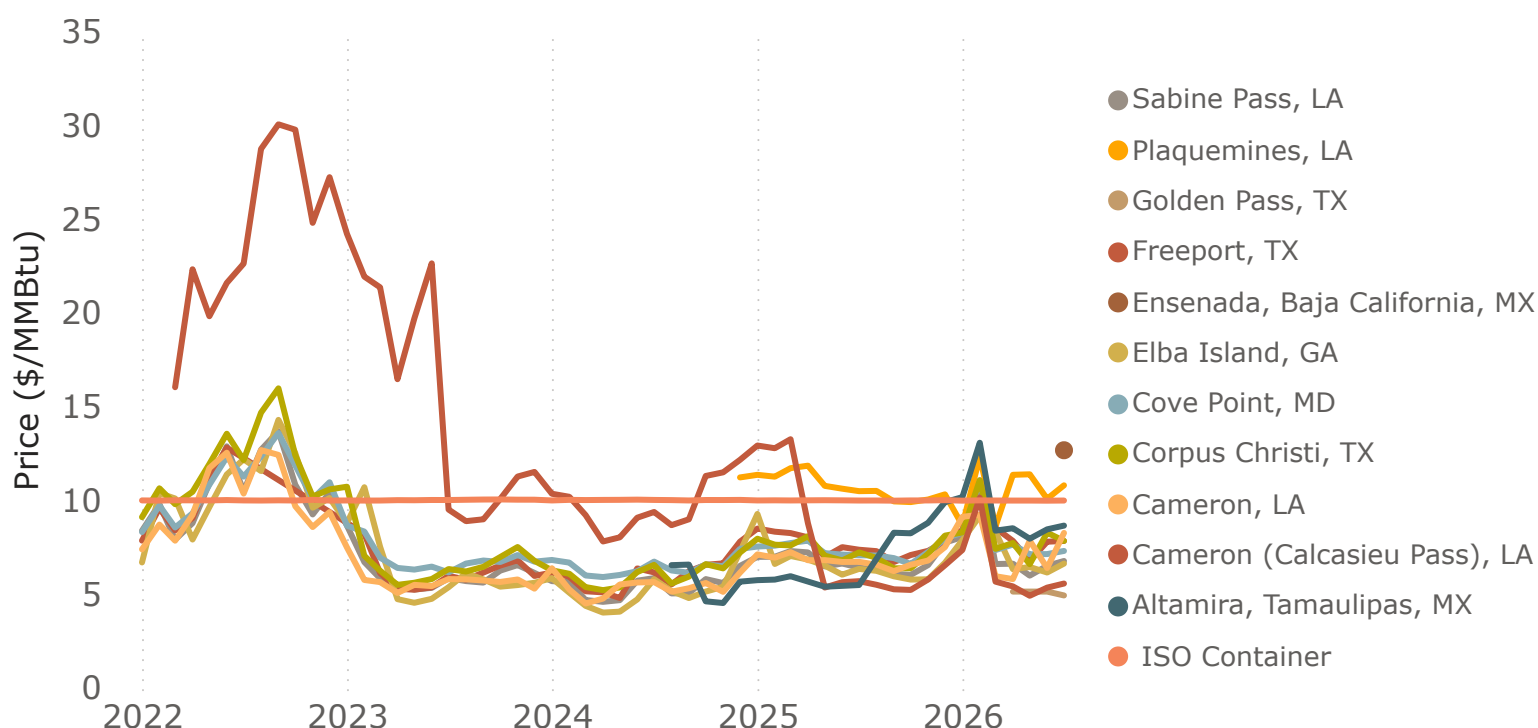

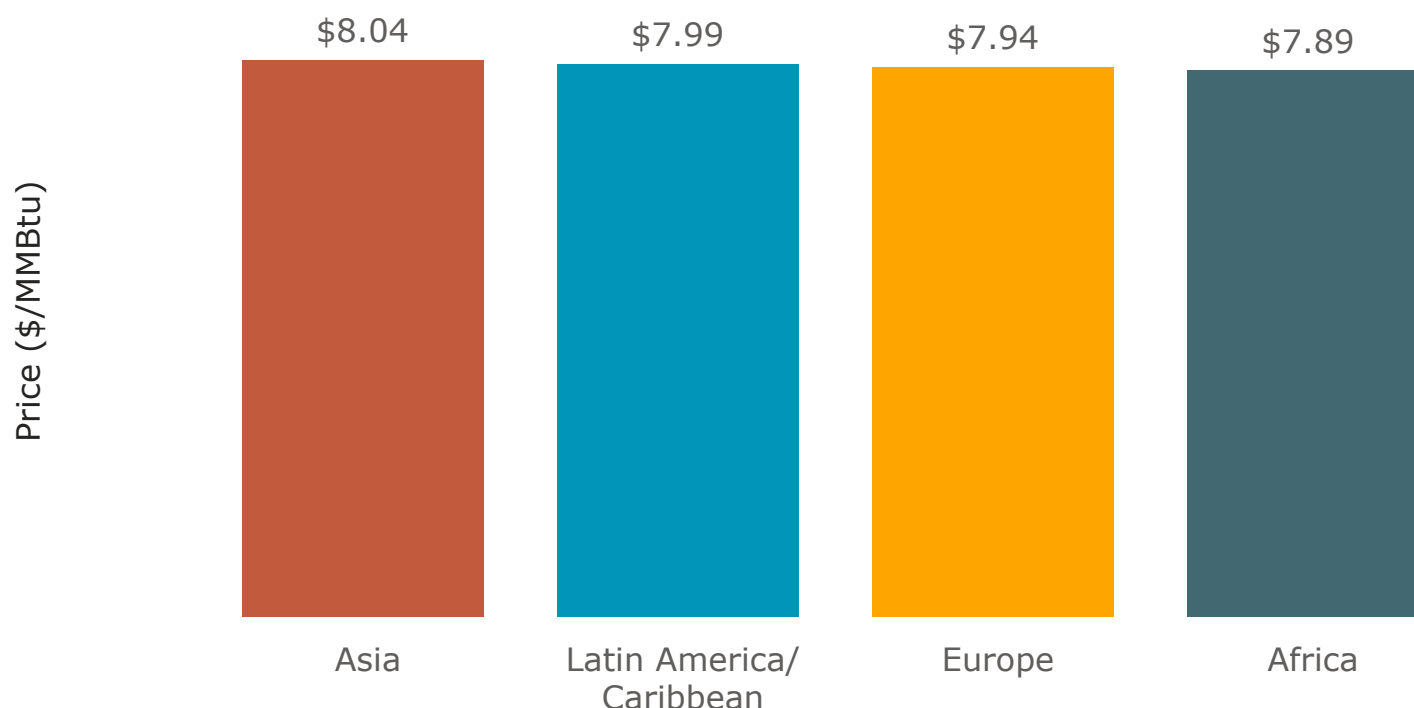

U.S.-Produced LNG Export Prices by Region of Destination (July 2026)



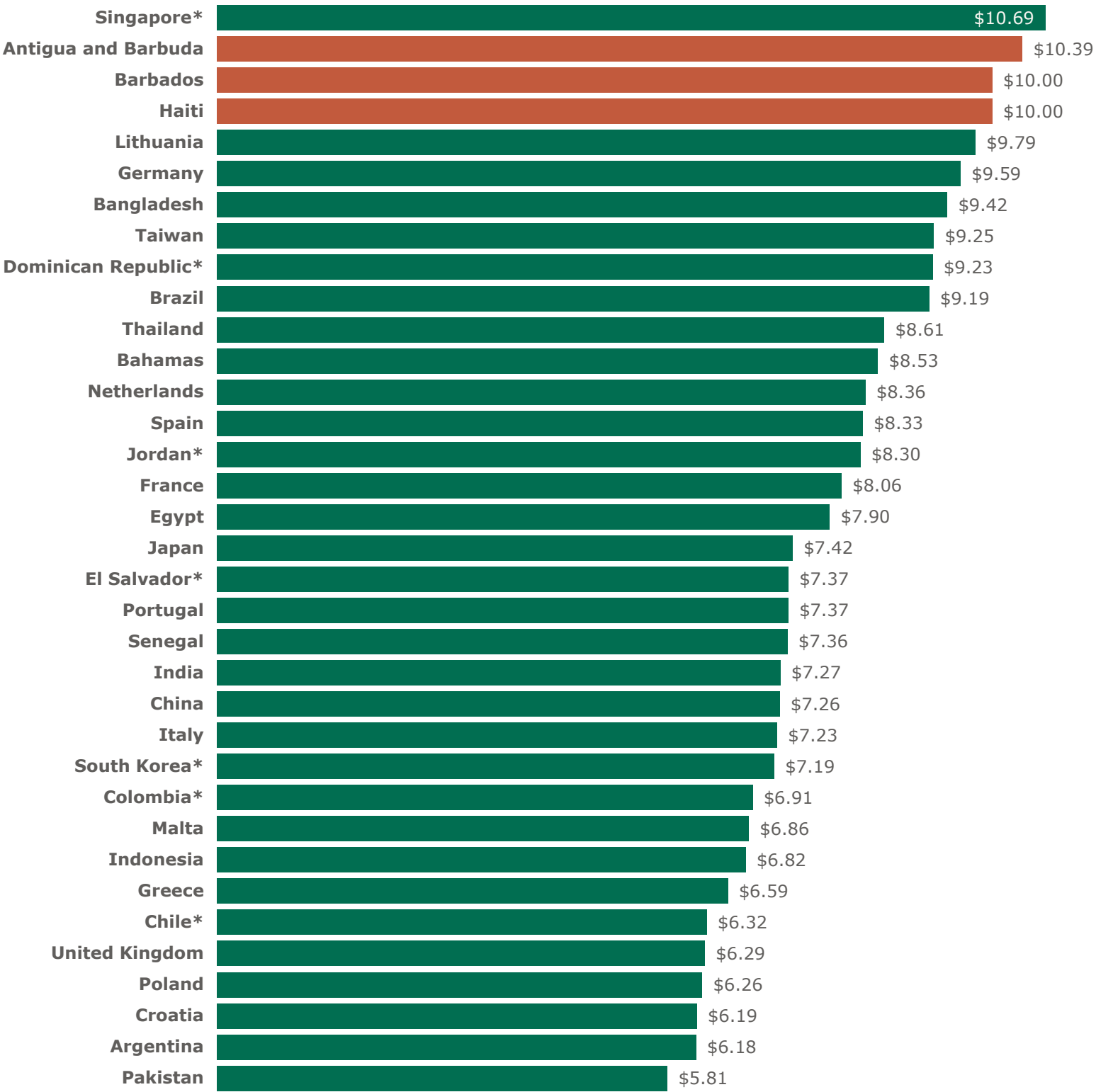
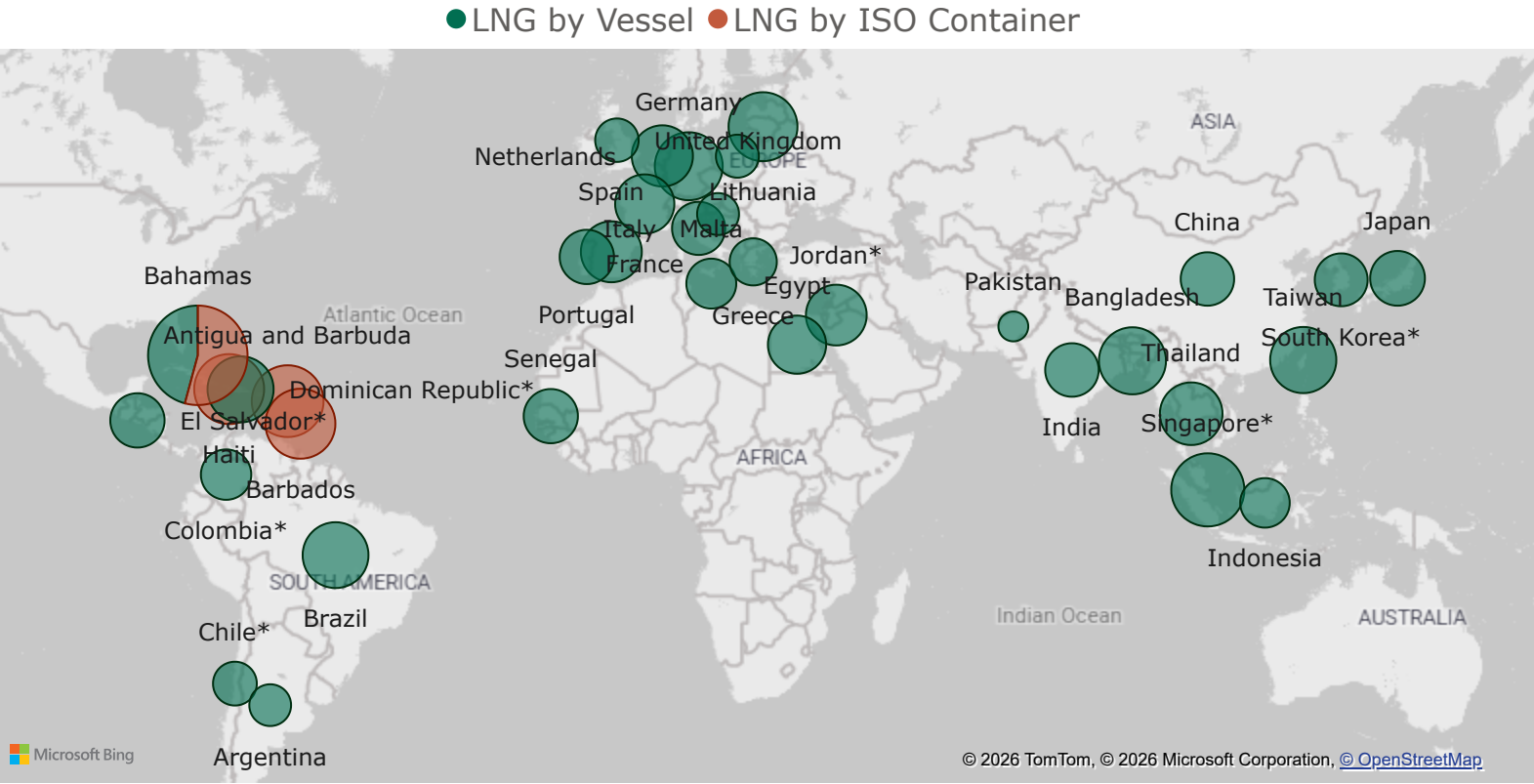

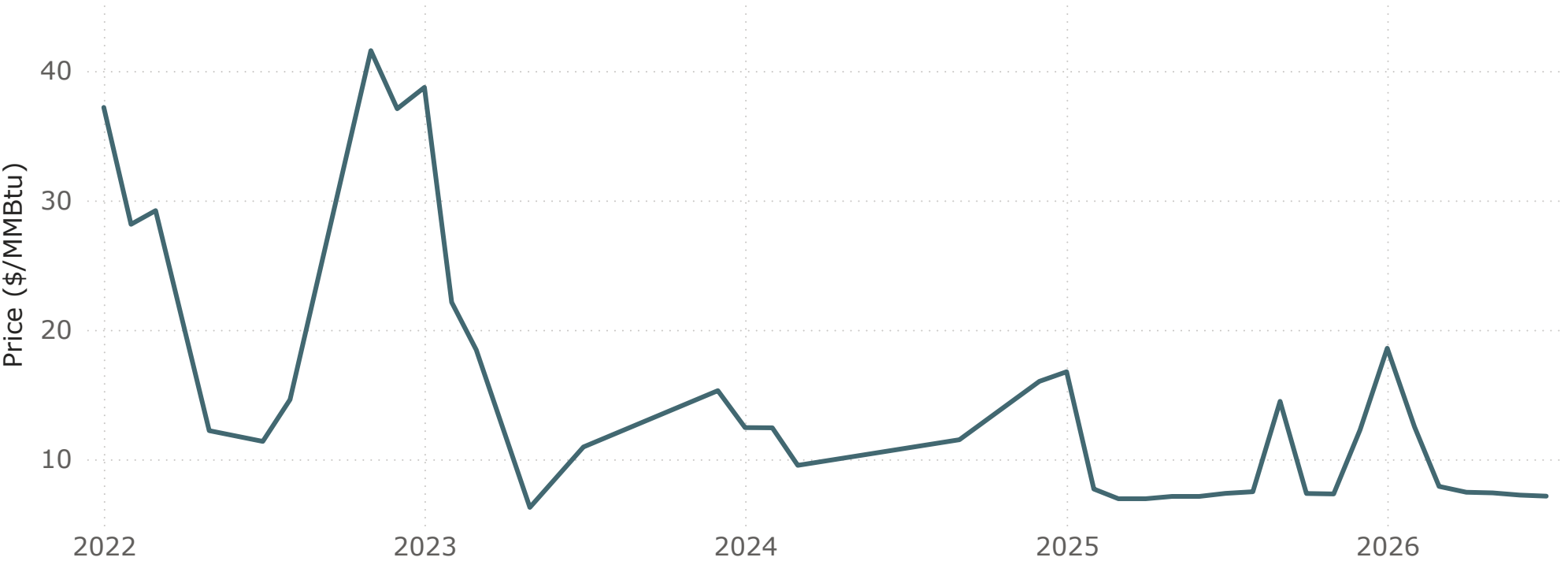

U.S. LNG Import Prices (July 2026)



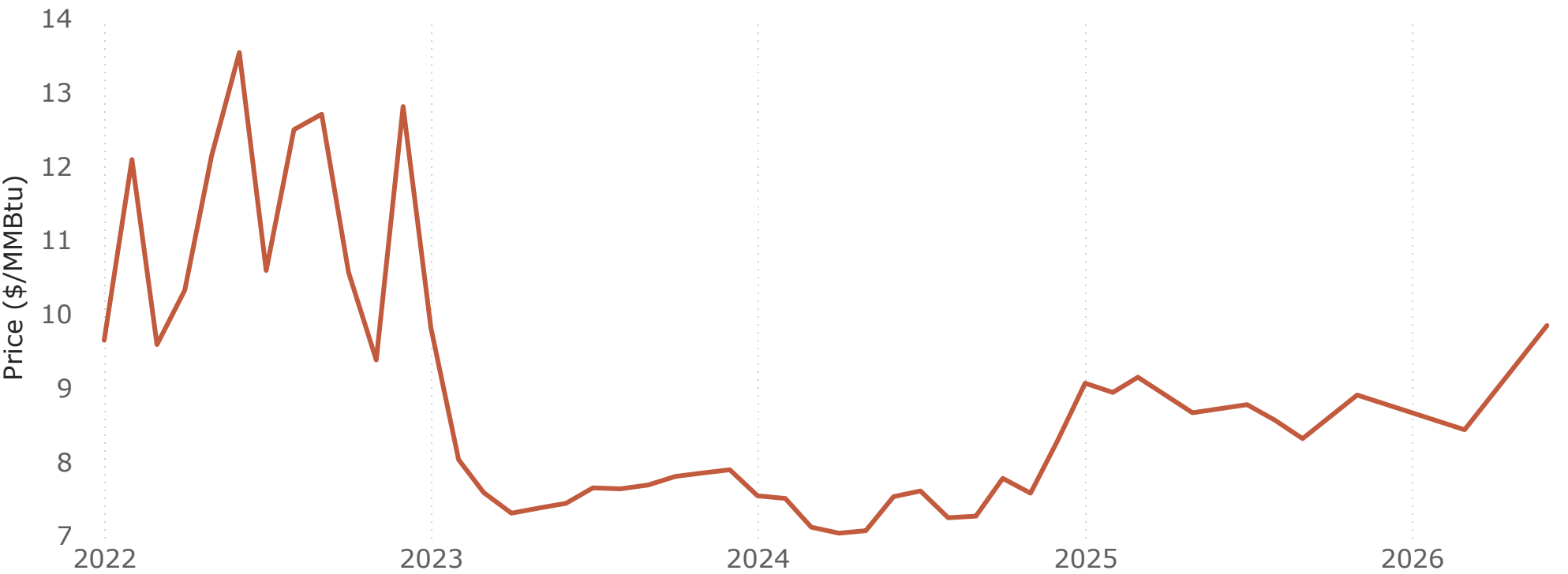

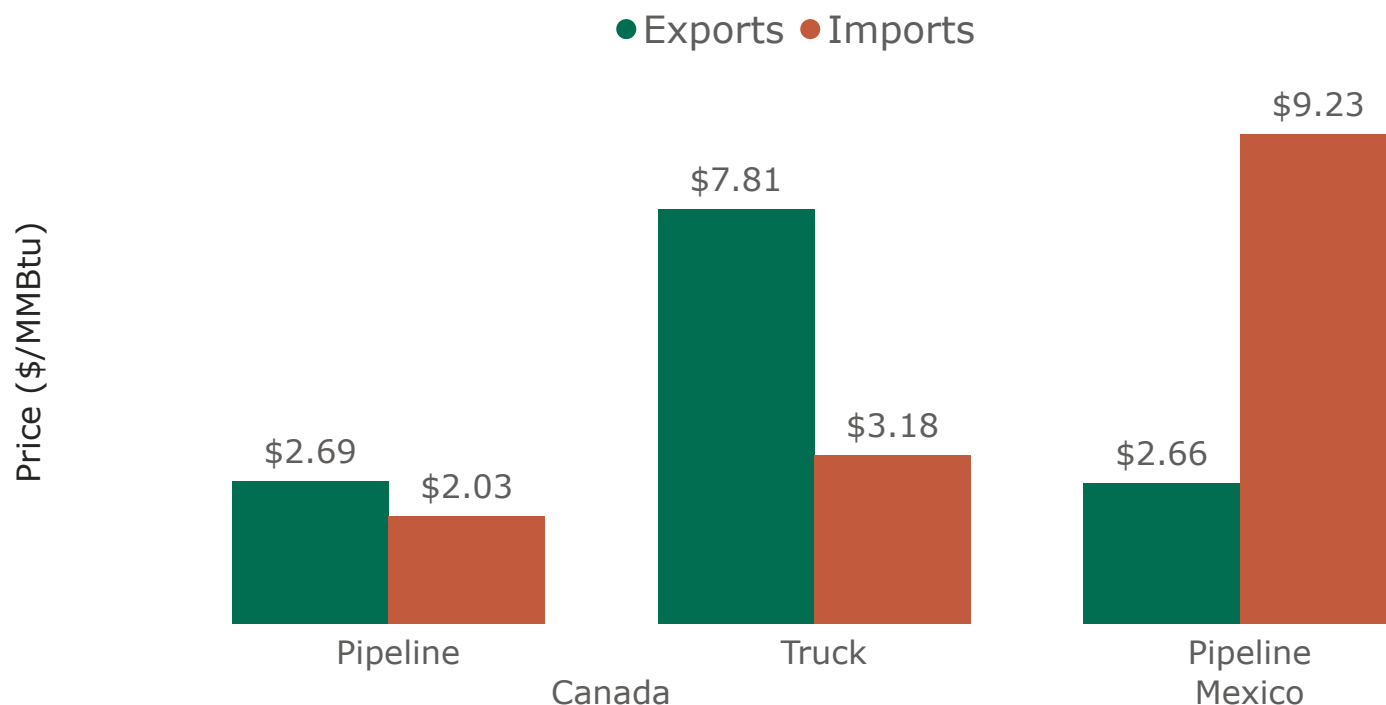

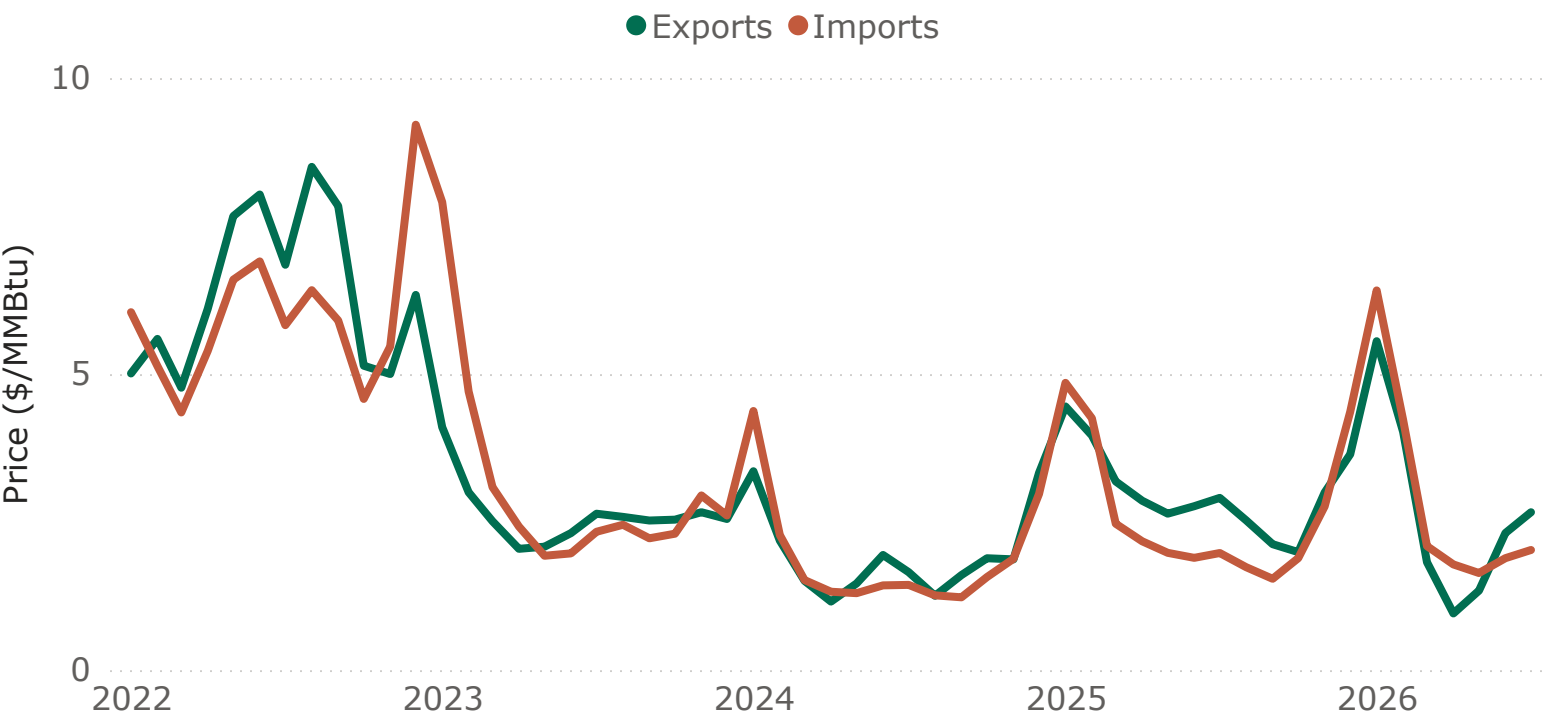

U.S. Natural Gas Import & Export by Pipeline & Truck Prices



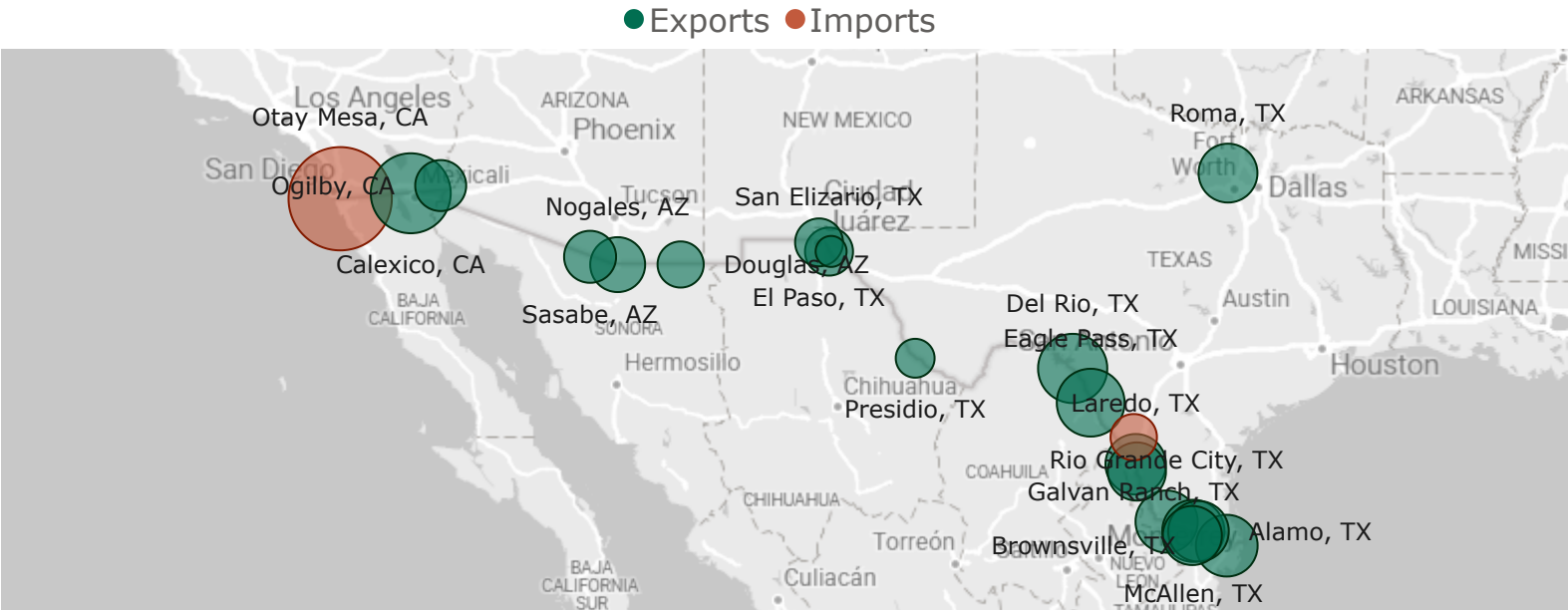

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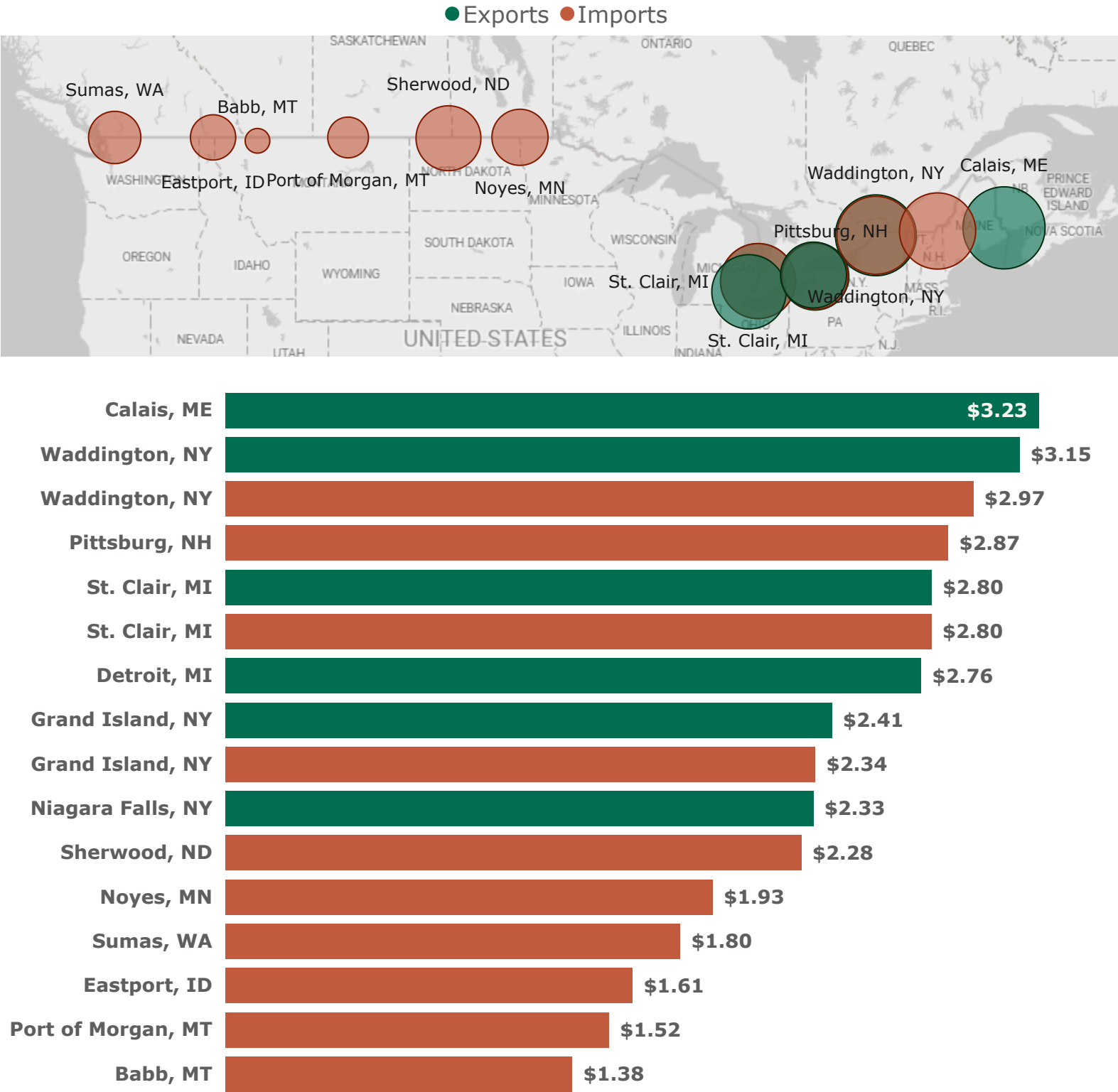

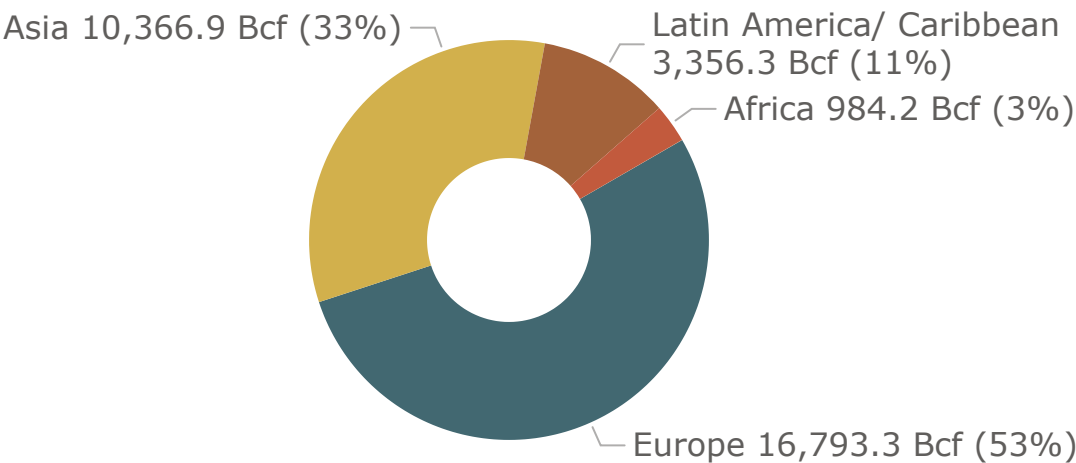

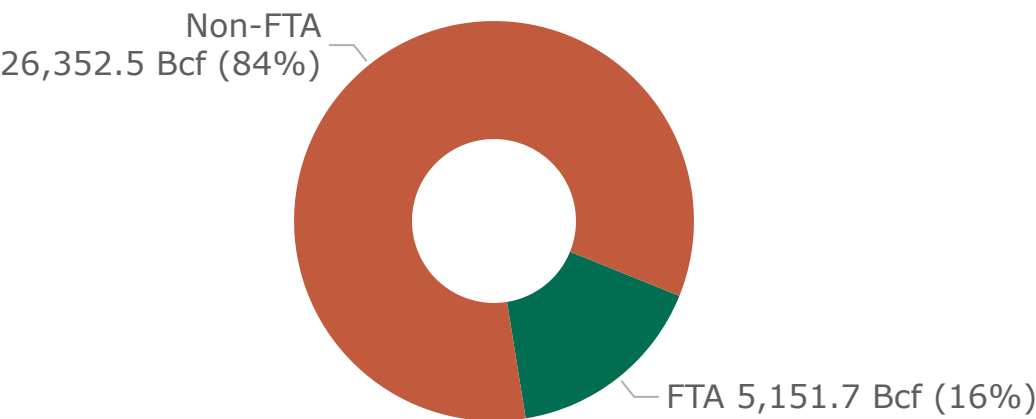
Cumulative U.S.-Produced LNG Exports

Notes and Definitions

1. Compressed Natural Gas (CNG)

Compressed natural gas (CNG) is natural gas that is compressed to less than 1% of the volume it occupies at standard atmospheric pressure.

2. Free Trade Agreement (FTA)

Countries that have a free trade agreement with the United States requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas.

3. Import & Export by truck & pipeline Prices

The import & export prices by pipeline & truck include the price of natural gas and the transportation cost up to the U.S. border.

4. Imports and Exports by Truck

Natural gas imports & exports by truck included compressed natural gas (CNG) and liquefied natural gas (LNG).

5. Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG)

Liquefied natural gas (LNG) is natural gas that has been liquefied by reducing its temperature to -260 degrees Fahrenheit at atmospheric pressure.

6. LNG Export Prices

LNG export and re-export prices are free on board (FOB) and include all costs of the LNG up to the point of export, including commodity costs and liquefaction fees.

7. LNG Import Prices

LNG import prices are landed and include the price of the LNG, the transportation cost to the U.S. terminal, and the cost of offloading the LNG but do not include the cost of regasification.

8. LNG Re-Exports

LNG re-exports are exports of foreign-sourced LNG that was previously imported into the U.S.

9. Long-Term

Long-term imports or exports are volumes traded under a company's long-term authorization. This type of authorization is for a term of more than two years and is for companies that intend on having long-term gas purchase and/or sales contracts.

10. Publication Date

Data are current as of the publication date. Any revisions to reported data will be published in the next scheduled Natural Gas Imports and Exports Monthly.

11. Reporting Metric

Authorization holders are required to file volume data in thousand cubic feet (Mcf). Therefore, data collected does not necessarily include equivalent amounts of energy, measured in million British thermal units (MMBtu).

12. Short-Term

Short-term imports or exports are those cargos imported or exported under a company's short-term or "blanket" authorization. This type of authorization covers supply contracts with terms up to 2 years, including spot cargos. The authorization is not based on a specific supply contract, but covers all of the importer's short-term supply deals. DOE does not have copies of those contracts and they are not filed with the applications.

13. Split Cargo

Some cargos might be split cargos. Split cargos refer to a single shipment of LNG where portions of the cargo have different transactional characteristics.

14. Spot Cargo

Spot cargos are a one-time transaction for near-term delivery of a specific quantity of LNG at a specific location. Spot cargos could be included in either long-term or short-term authorization types.

15. Volume

Authorization holders are required to file volume data in thousand cubic feet (Mcf). Therefore, data collected does not necessarily include equivalent amounts of energy, measured in million British thermal units (MMBtu).

16. World Region Classification

The world region classification is based on the United Nation standard country or area codes for statistical use (M49). For classification purposes,Turkiye is grouped into Europe.
