



## **NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) based on completion of an Environmental Assessment (EA) to describe and evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with the:

**White Earth Nation Wind Energy Project II**  
**Becker and Mahnomen Counties, Minnesota**  
**DOE/EA 1809**

DOE's Golden Field Office has determined that providing Congressionally Directed Federal funding to the White Earth Nation to purchase and install up to four small to mid-sized wind turbines at two sites near the towns of Waubun and Naytahwaush on the White Earth Reservation in Mahnomen County in western Minnesota would not constitute a major Federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the National Environmental Policy Act.
