

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and a Notice of Wetland Action based on the adoption of a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Environmental Assessment (EA) that described and evaluated the potential environmental impacts associated with the:

Ocean Renewable Power Company, LLC's
Cobscook Bay Tidal Energy Project
Cobscook Bay in Washington County, Maine (DOE/EA 1916)

Based on an independent review of the FERC EA, DOE's Golden Field Office has determined that that authorizing the expenditure of federal funding to ORPC Maine build, install, operate, and monitor a commercial-scale array of five grid-connected TidGen™ hydrokinetic energy conversion devices on the sea floor in Cobscook Bay does not constitute a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the *National Environmental Policy Act* (NEPA). Therefore the preparation of an environmental impact statement is not required and DOE hereby Adopts FERC's Environmental Assessment for Hydropower License (FERC Project No. 12711-005) for the Cobscook Bay Tidal Energy Project.
