AMENDMENT (1)

TO THE

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND

THE POWER REACTOR AND NUCLEAR FUEL DEVELOPEMENT CORPORATION OF JAPAN IN THE FIELD OF LIQUID METAL COOLED FAST BREEDER REACTORS

Whereas the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Power Reactor and Nuclear Fuel Development Corporation of Japan (PNC), (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"), have cooperated in the development of Liquid Metal Fast Breeder Reactor (LMFBR) technology under the terms of the Agreement Between the USDOE and the PNC in the Field of Liquid Metal-Cooled Fast Breeder Reactors (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"), signed on March 4, 1969, and renewed on January 31, 1979;

Whereas the cooperation has proceeded to the satisfaction of both Parties;

Whereas the Parties wish to continue their present cooperation;

Whereas the Parties wish to continue discussions with the intention of updating the Agreement to reflect changes which have taken place since it was last renewed;

Whereas Article 16 of the Agreement provides for extension of the Agreement by mutual consent of the Parties;

NOW THEREFOR, the Parties agree to extend the term of the Agreement for one year, until January 31st, 1990.

In witness whereof, DOE and PNC agree to this extension, to be effective upon signature.
