# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### CONCERNING

#### COOPERATION IN PARTICLE PHYSICS AND RELATED FIELDS

The Museo Storico della Fisica e Centro Studi e Ricerche "Enrico Fermi" (Centro Fermi) in Rome, Italy and Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory (Fermilab), in Batavia, Illinois, United States of America, hereinafter collectively the "Participants",

Recognizing their mutual interest in promoting cooperation in scientific and technological exchanges concerning particle physics and related fields, including the dissemination of Enrico Fermi's scientific legacy,

State their understanding as follows:

- 1. Centro Fermi and Fermilab intend to facilitate scientific cooperation by the following forms:
  - A. Exchange of scientists or engineers for short-term and long-term periods;
  - B. Exchange of publicly available information; and
  - C. Such other forms of cooperation as may be mutually decided upon.

## General Considerations

- A. To coordinate the activities under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), each Participant should designate a contact person to whom correspondence is to be addressed.
- B. Cooperative activities under this MOU may commence upon signature by the Participants and continue for a five (5) year period unless earlier discontinued. A Participant that wishes to discontinue its participation in the activities contemplated by this MOU should endeavor to provide the other Participant 30 days written prior notice. This MOU may be modified by the mutual consent of both Participants in writing.
- C. This MOU does not create any legally binding obligations between the Participants.

- D. Each Participant is to be responsible for the costs it incurs in participating in cooperative activities under this MOU.
- E. Each Participant should conduct the cooperation under this MOU in accordance with applicable laws and regulations to which it is subject, and international agreements to which its Government is a party.
