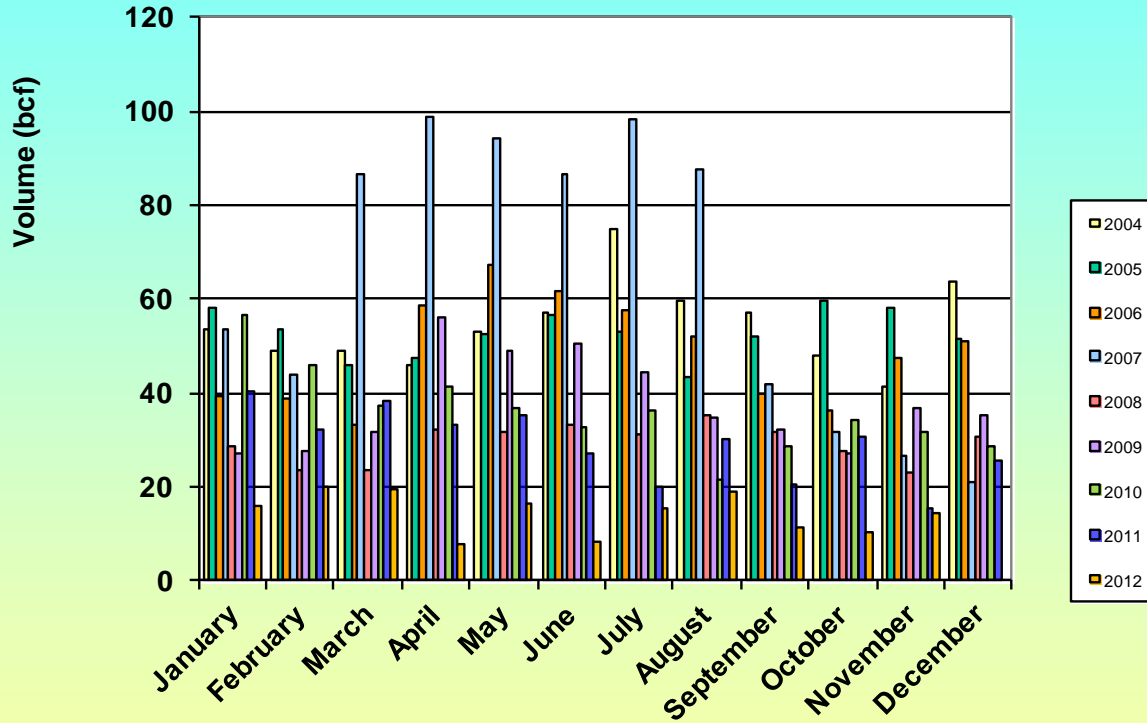

LNG Import Volumes by Month (Bcf)



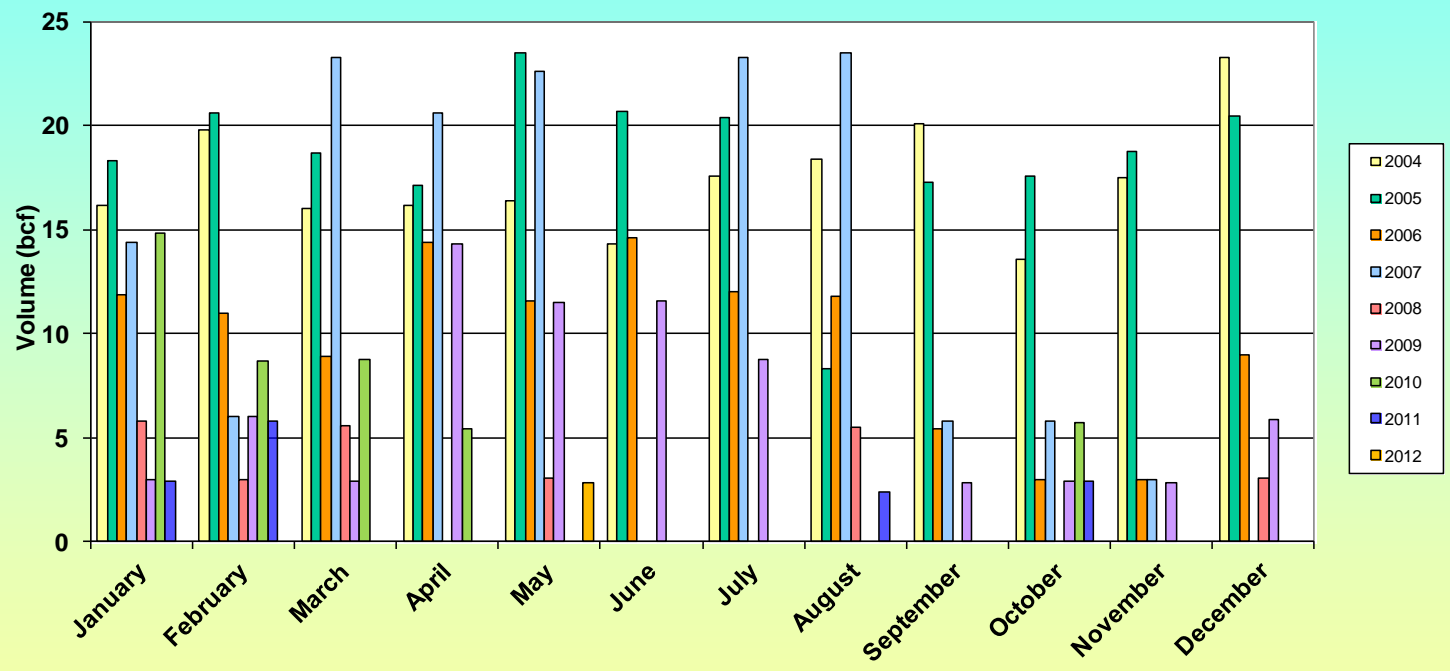

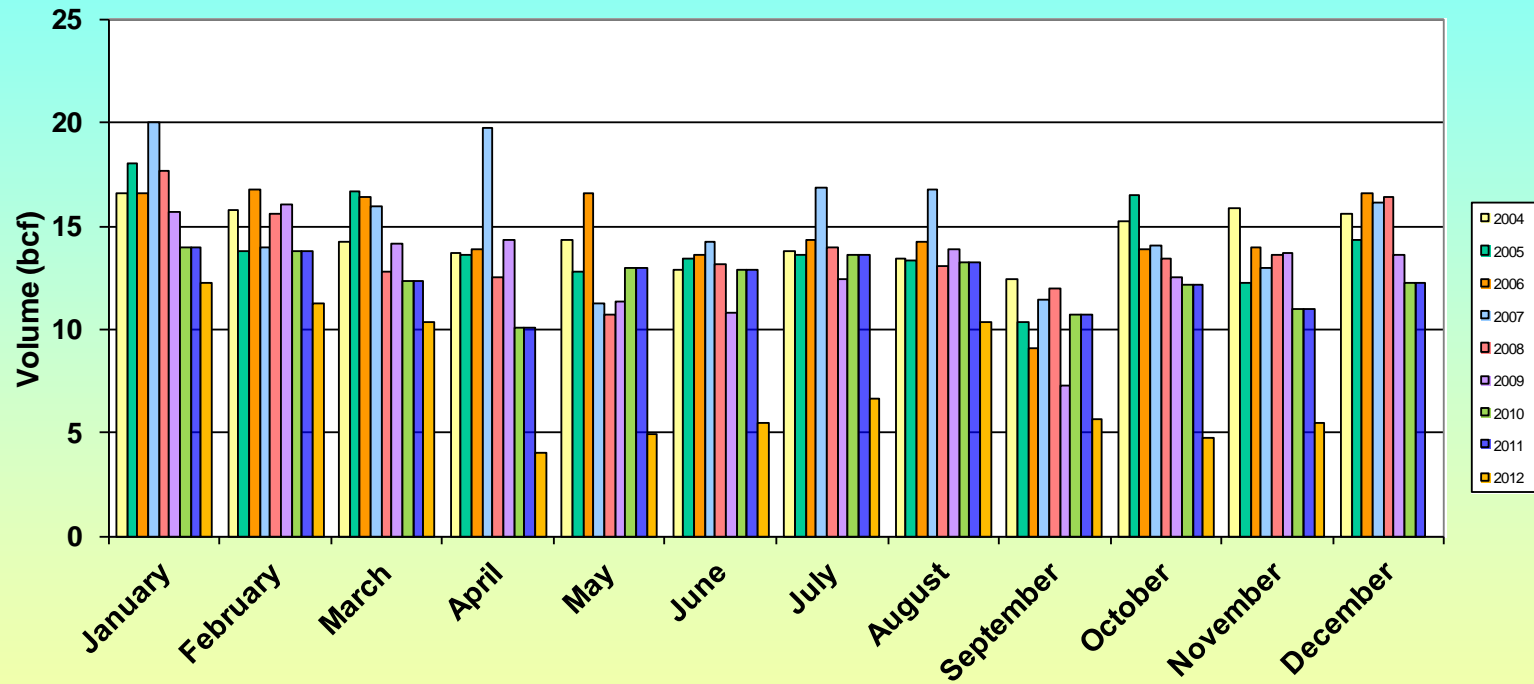




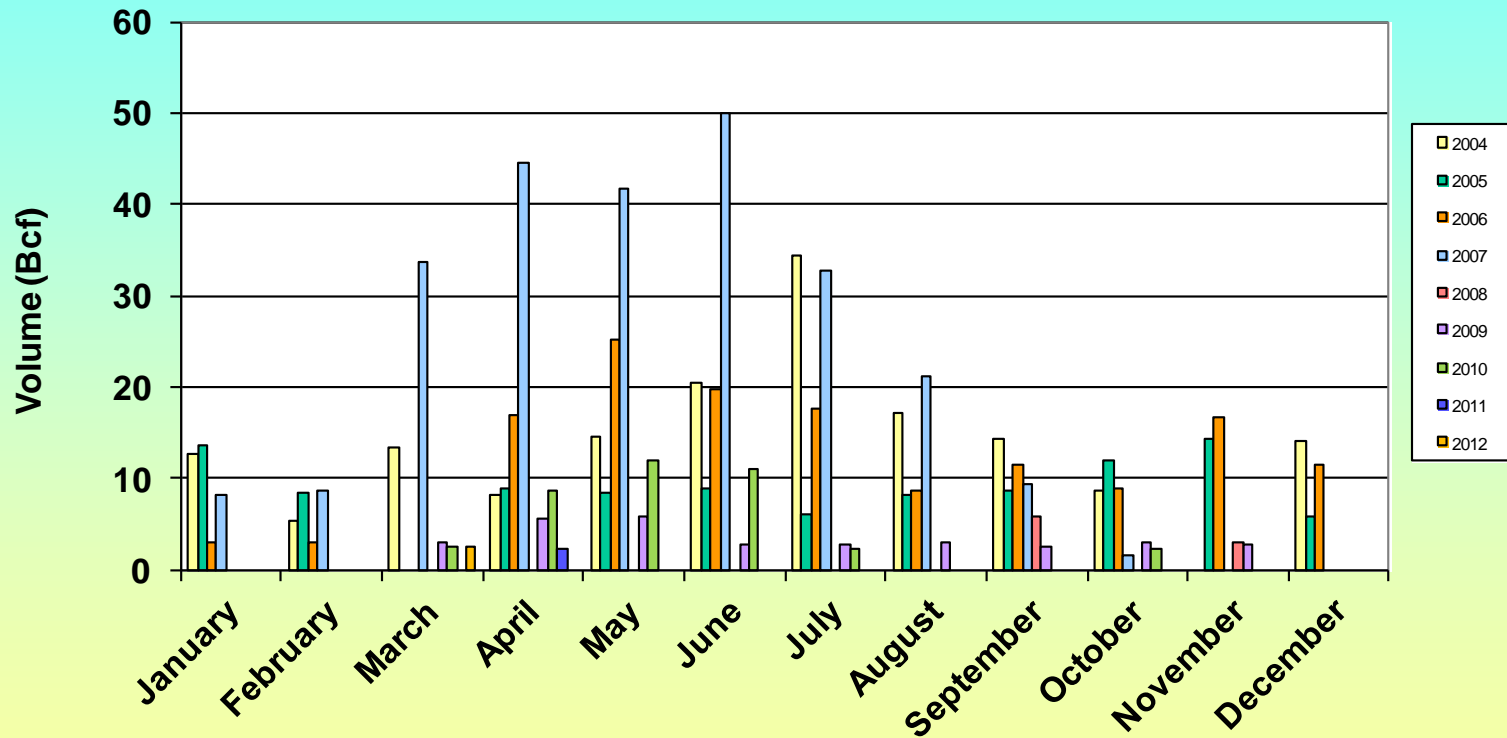
Monthly LNG Imports – Cove Point 2004 – 2012



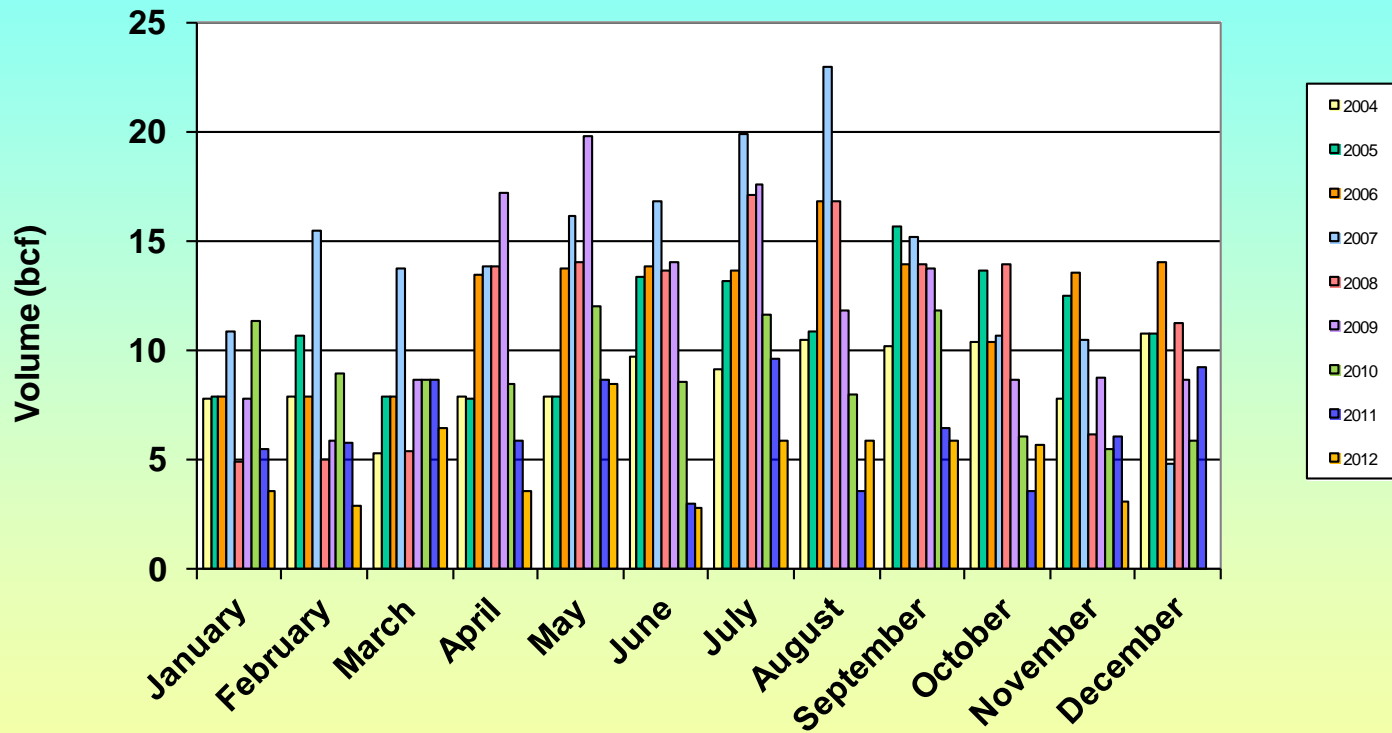

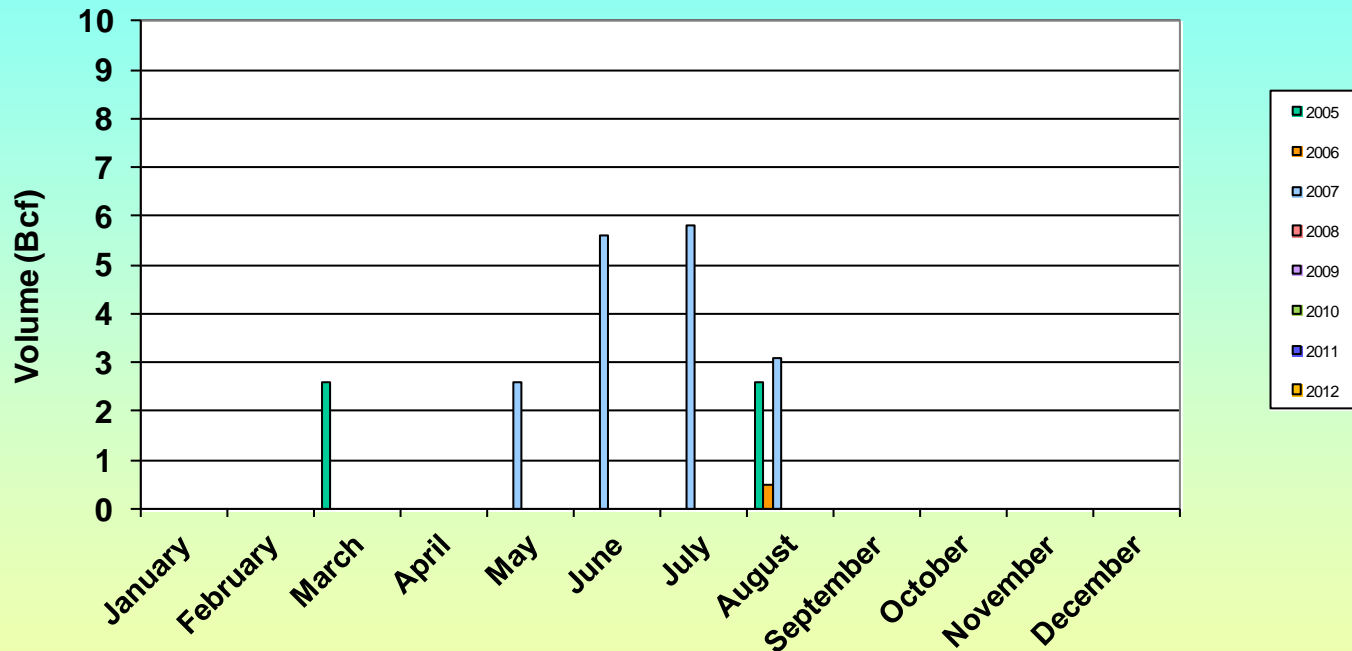

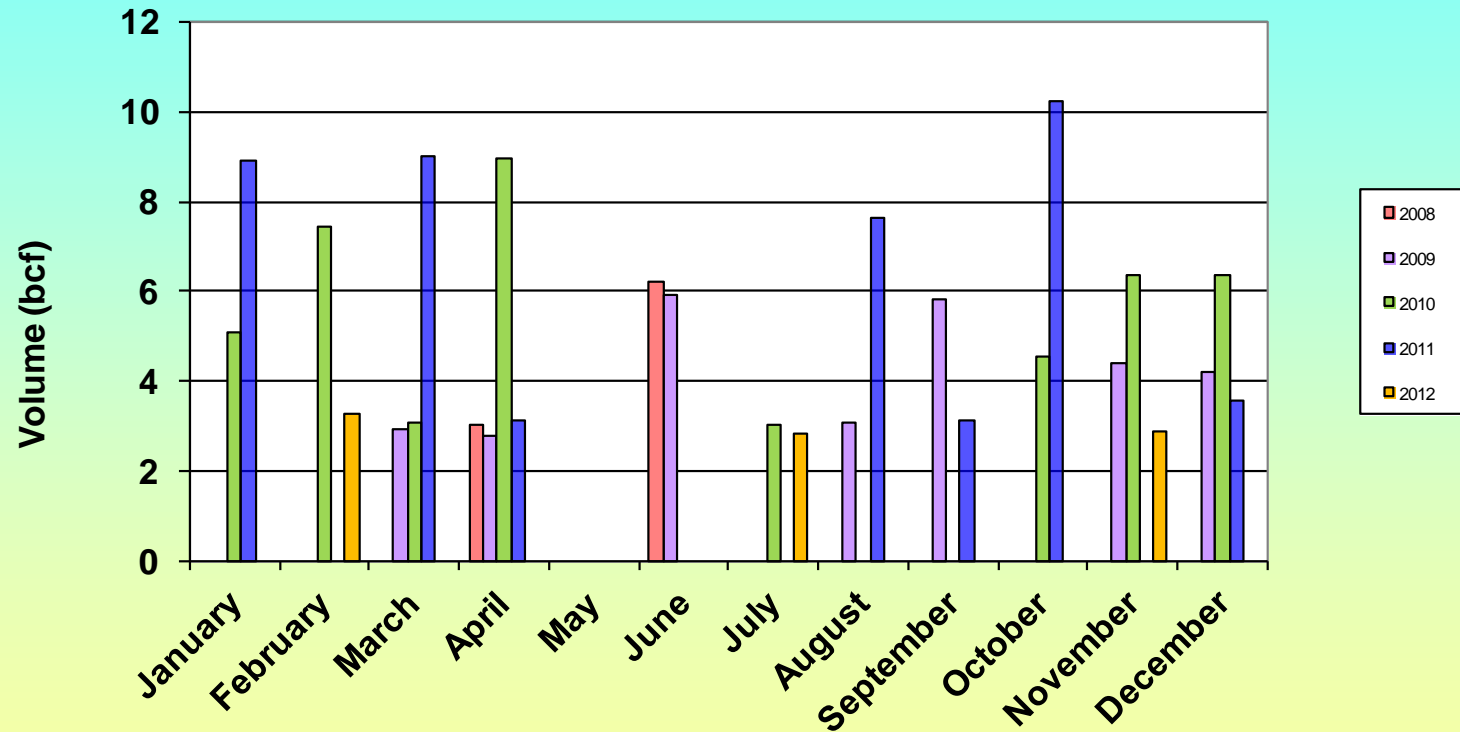


Gulf Gateway received its first cargo in March 2005. Excelerate Energy has announced that it will retire the Gulf Gateway terminal in the near future.

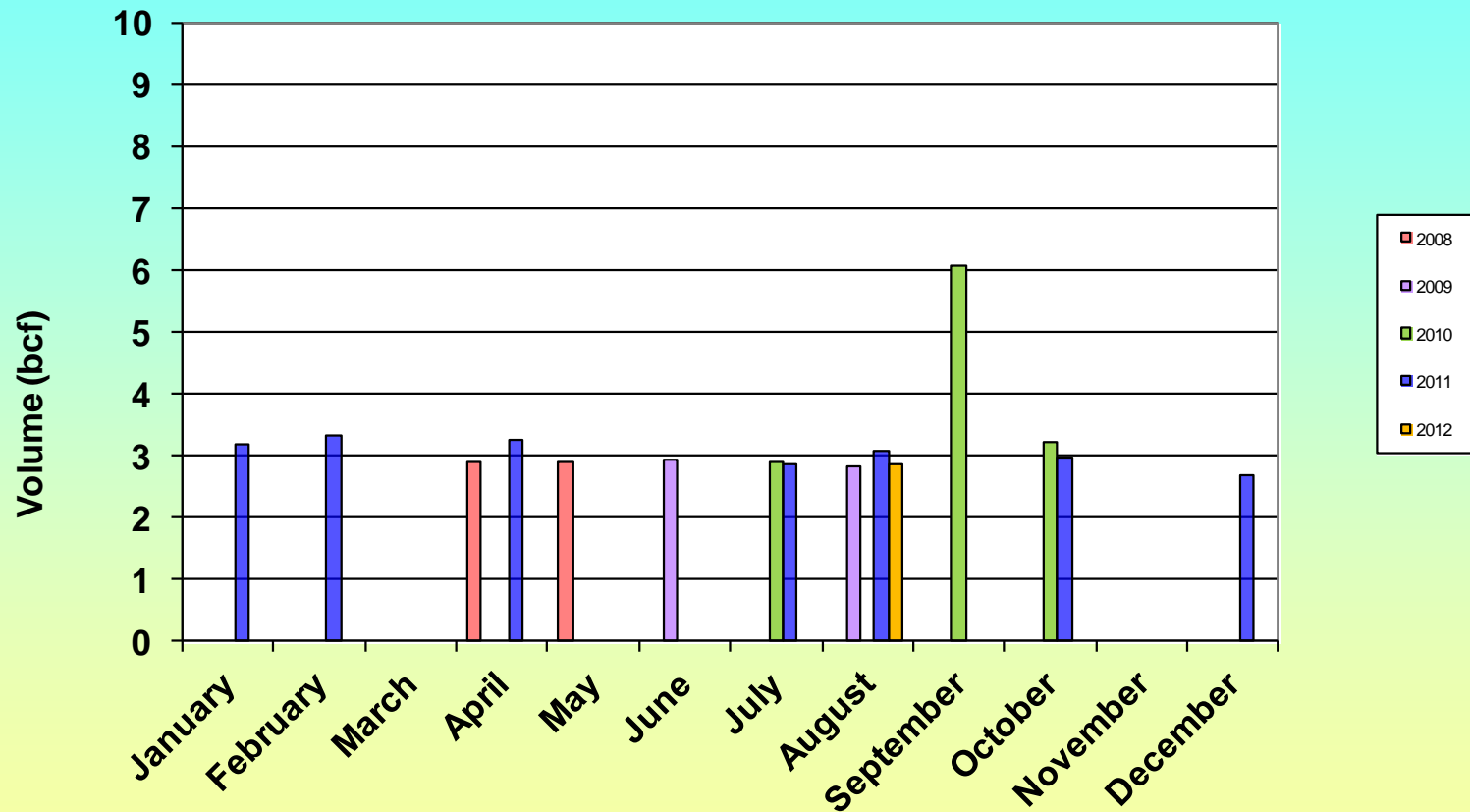


Monthly LNG Imports – Sabine Pass 2008 – 2012



Sabine Pass received its first cargo in April 2008.

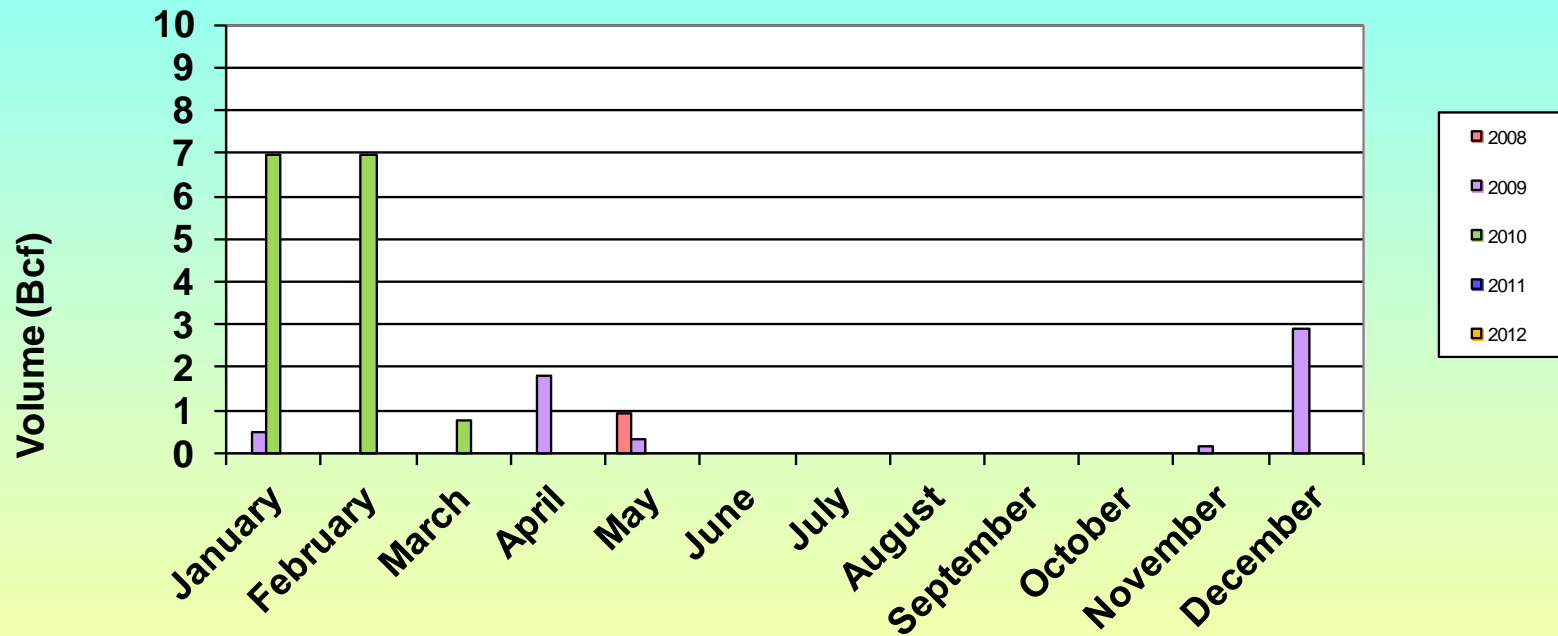
Monthly LNG Imports – Freeport 2008 – 2012



Freeport received its first cargo in April 2008.



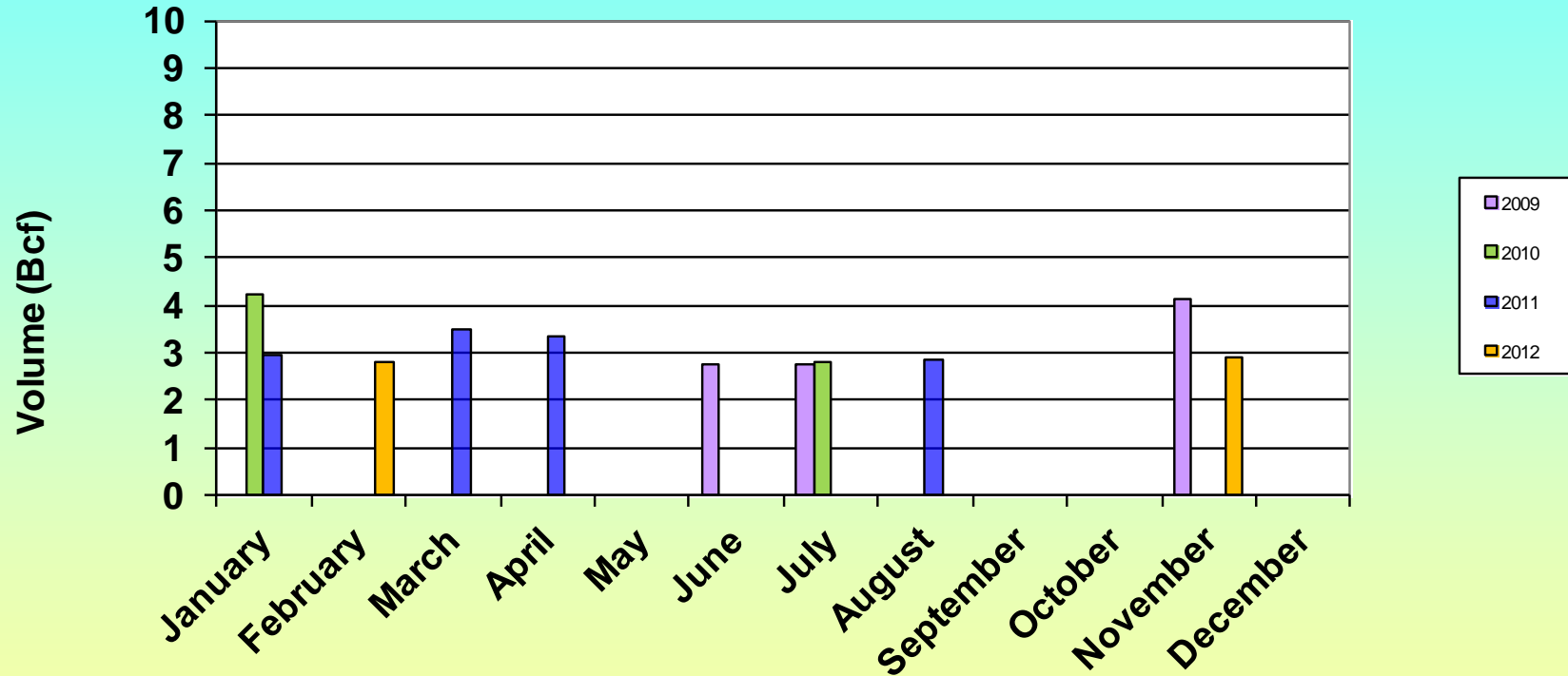
Monthly LNG Imports – Northeast Gateway Energy Bridge 2008 – 2012



Northeast Gateway received its first cargo in May 2008.

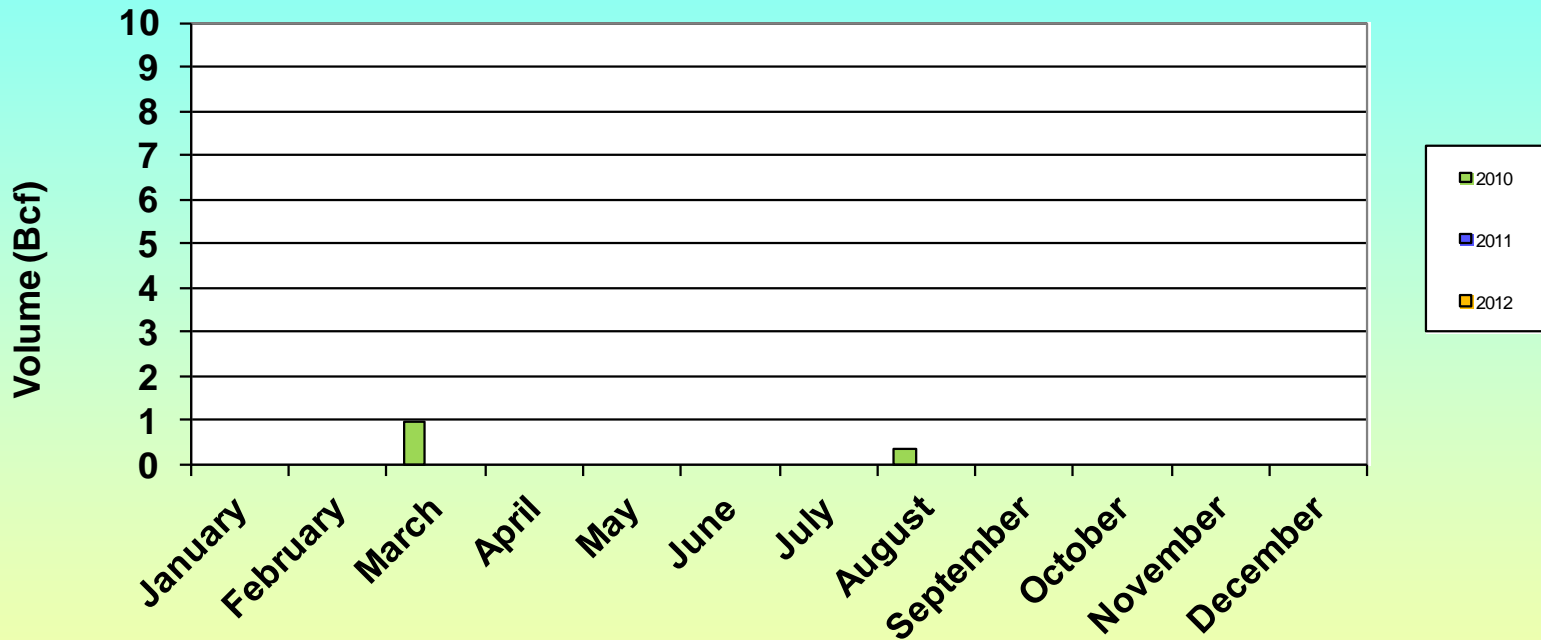


Monthly LNG Imports – Cameron 2009-2012

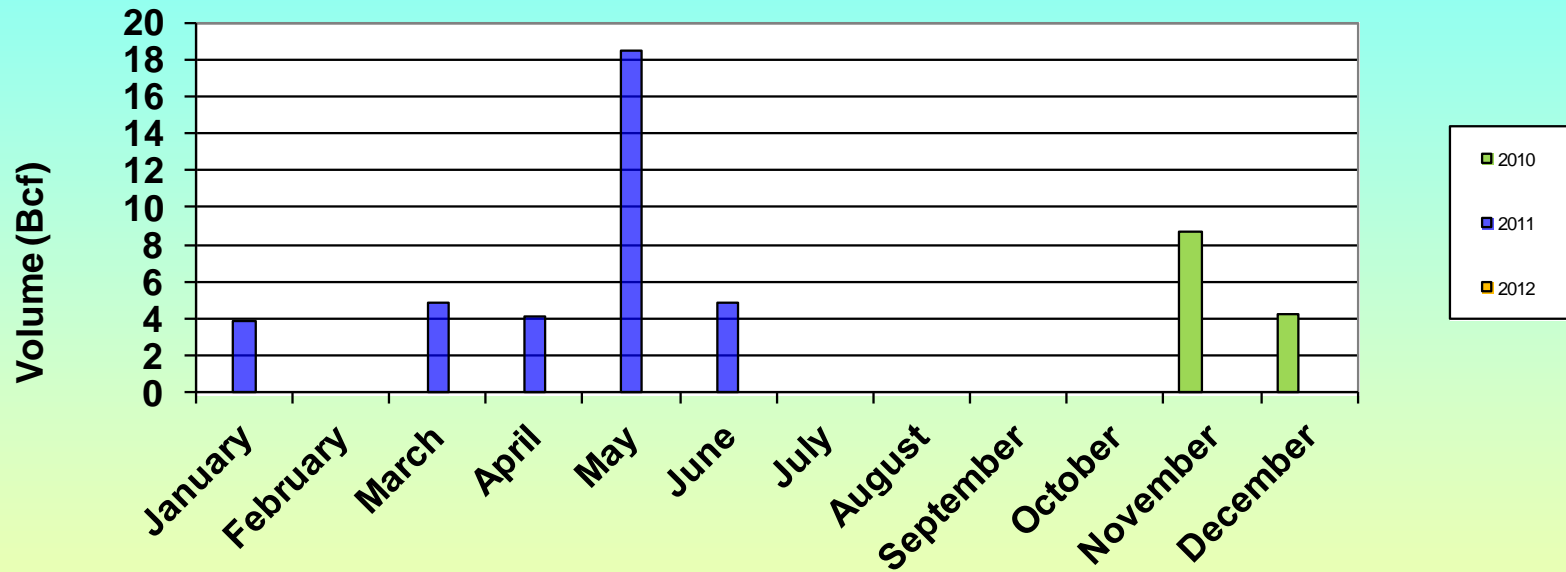

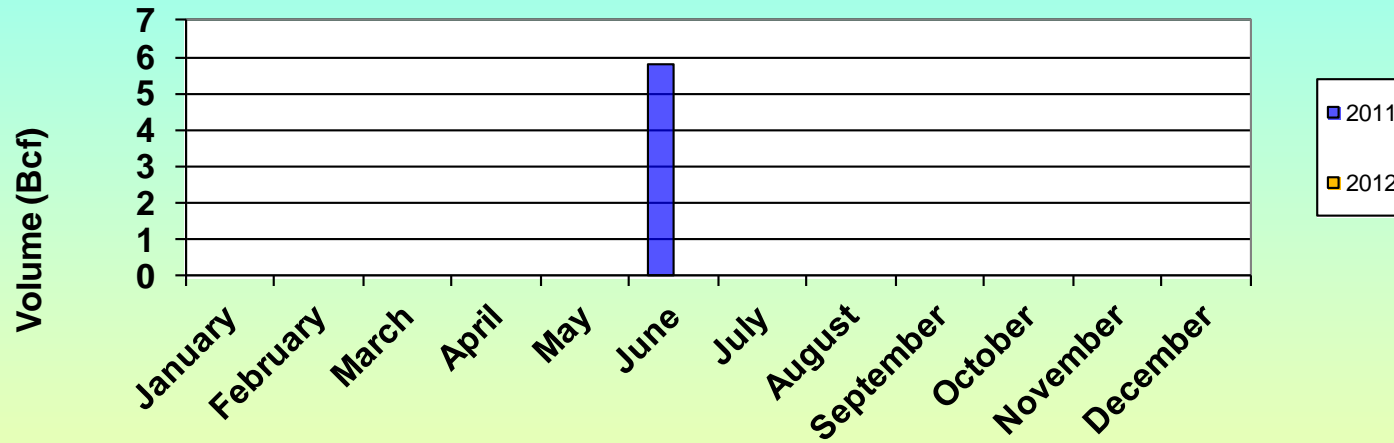

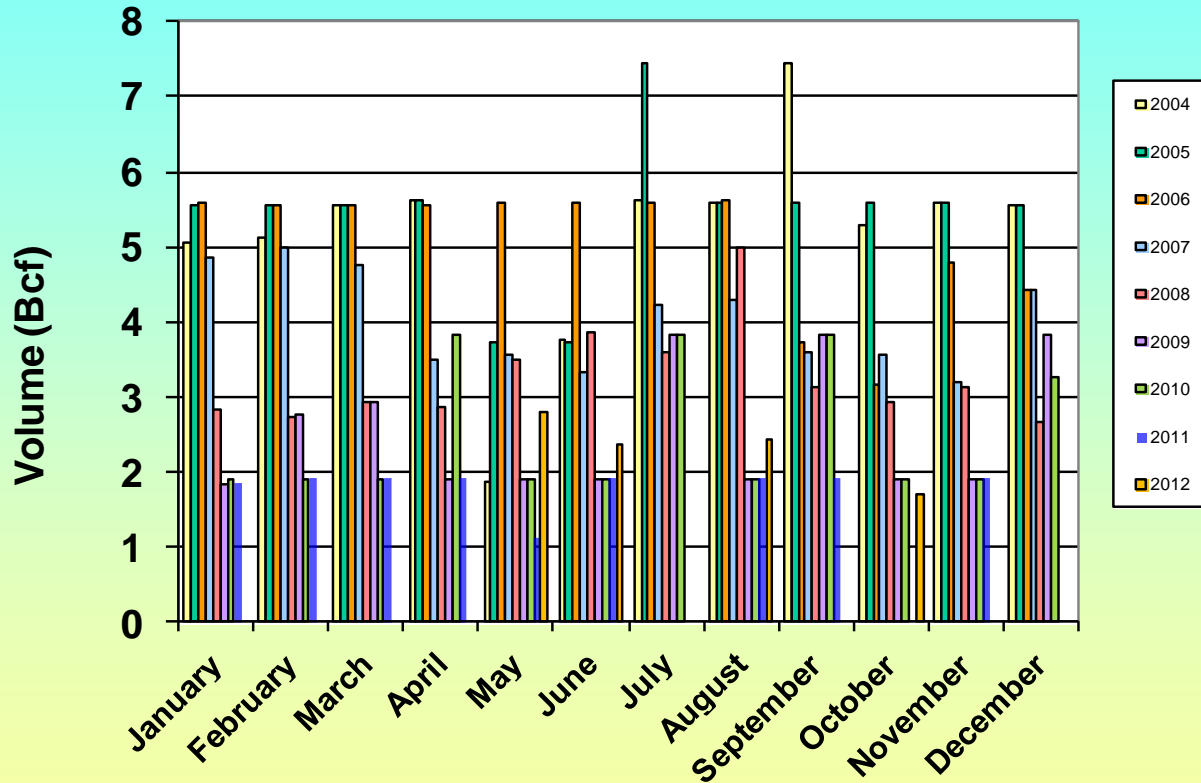

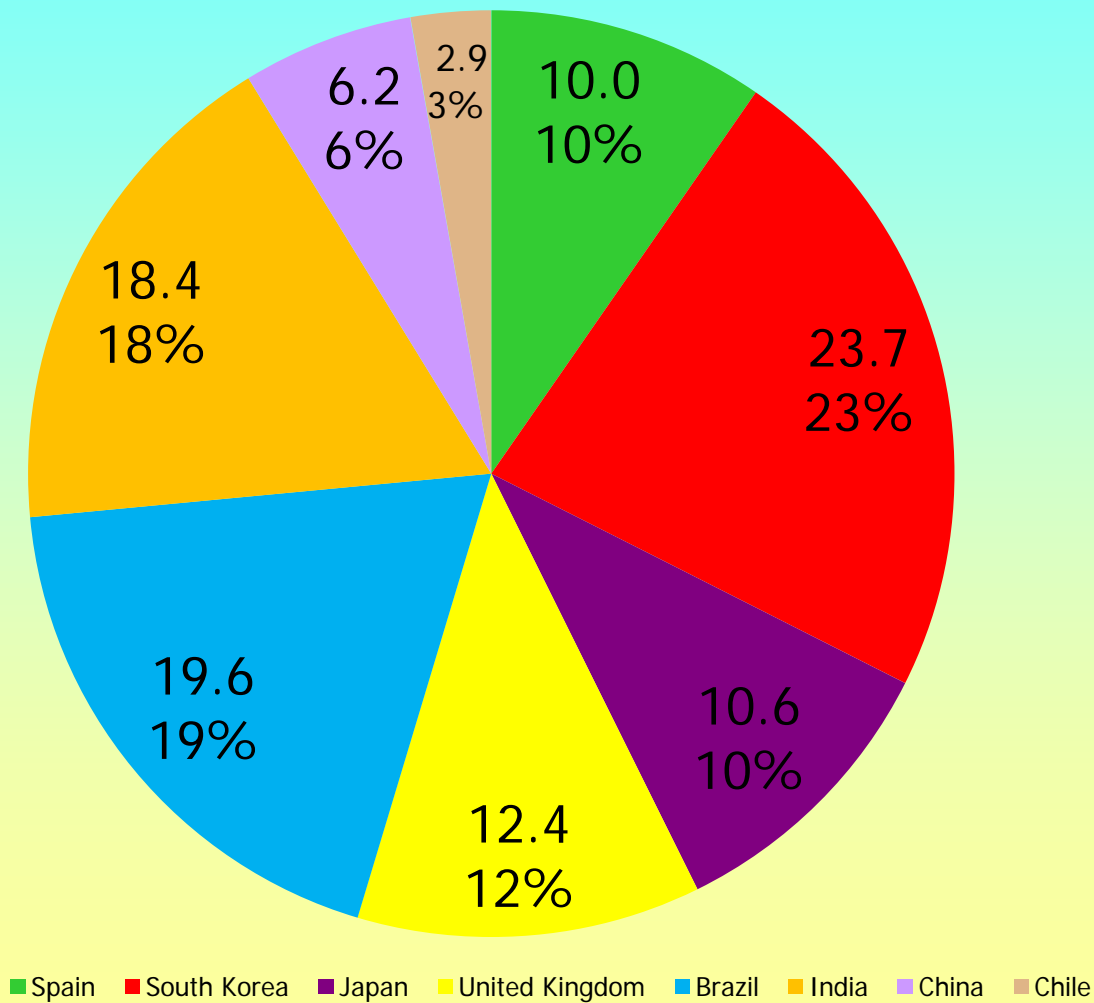
