Newly Developed Security Police Officer/Special Response

Team Qualification Courses of Fire

In accordance with DOE Order 473.3, *Protection Program Operations*, Section E, paragraph 2 and Section K, Paragraph 2, members of the Department of Energy (DOE) Firearms Policy Panel, DOE Protective Forces Safety Committee, DOE Training Managers Working Group, the National Nuclear Security Administration, and the DOE National Training Center have developed, reviewed and revised the following courses of fire (attached) for inclusion in the Protective Force Firearms Qualification Courses Manual. The courses of fire pertain to the incumbent Security Police Officer (SPO) and/or Special Response Team (SRT) member only:

- Daylight incumbent defensive SPO combined basic handgun/rifle qualification course of fire.
- Reduced lighting incumbent defensive SPO combined basic handgun/rifle qualification course of fire.
- Daylight incumbent offensive SPO/SRT combined rifle/handgun qualification course of fire.
- Reduced lighting incumbent offensive SPO/SRT combined rifle/handgun qualification course of fire.

By combining day/night handgun, rifle, and shooting-on-the-move qualification courses of fire, the amount of time necessary to qualify an incumbent SPO/SRT member is significantly reduced allowing more time for firearms training activities.

The new qualification courses of fire are designed for the incumbent SPO/SRT as his/her primary qualification for the handgun and rifle. The existing qualification courses for the Basic Security Police Officer Training, Tactical Response Force I, and Tactical Response Force II courses remain intact and are still required for initial qualification.

Incumbent Defensive Security Police Officers (SPO), Offensive SPO and Special Response Team Combined Handgun/Rifle Qualification Courses

1. Introduction These courses evaluate an officer's marksmanship and manipulation skills in both stationary and shooting-on-the-move environments in daylight and reduced-lighting conditions. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Standard Target must be used for all stages and scored in accordance with Appendix 4 of the Protective Force Firearms Qualification Courses Manual. Defensive Security Police Officers (SPO) are required to shoot a minimum score of 70 percent; Offensive SPOs are required to shoot a minimum score of 80 percent; and Special Response Team (SRT) members are required to shoot a minimum score of 90 percent for qualification.

These courses were developed to enable a basic assessment of the safe and effective application of the fundamentals of marksmanship and approved firearms manipulation skills for incumbent SPOs. As these courses are significantly reduced in terms of stages of fire and ammunition, follow on live fire sustainment/skills-enhancement training must include, at a minimum, the resources (ammunition and training time) required by the most comprehensive qualification course of fire for that firearm that is listed in the currently approved DOE Protective Force Firearms Qualification Course list.

2. Instructions for Incumbent Combined Qualification Courses

- a. Reference all general instructions for firearms qualification courses in Attachment 2, Section K (Contractor Protective Force), and in Appendix A, Section E (Federal Protective Force), of DOE O 473.3, *Protection Program Operations*.
- b. During rifle stages, the rifle is in the proper load configuration, in a low ready position, and with the selector lever in the safe position at the beginning of each stage.
- c. Shooters will manipulate the selector lever to the appropriate firing position at the beginning of each stage.
- d. Shooters will place the selector lever in the safe position after each stage.
- e. Shooters will place the selector lever in the safe position or ensure the rifle is inoperable before transitioning to the handgun during a stage of fire.
- f. The handgun will be secured in the holster in a full load configuration
- g. All draws will be from a snapped or secure holster. Shooters will start with their hands relaxed, hanging by their sides, unless otherwise directed.
- h. Shooters will de-cock double action semiautomatics before holstering.
- i. Shooters are responsible for managing their ammunition. Shooters are given the opportunity at beginning of each stage to "make ready." The shooter may then reload with a full magazine at his or her discretion, unless a mandatory reload is required.
- j. If, within a string of fire there is a mandatory reload, that weapon should be configured in a manner that the shooter will induce a lock-back.
- k. When required to fire from either the right or left side of the barricade, the shooter will use it for cover and may use it for support. During all barricade positions the shooter must start at least one step from the barricade unless otherwise directed.
- 1. Any rounds fired from a stationary position that should have been fired on the move will be deducted at full value from the total score.

- m. Any rounds fired not in accordance with the prescribed stage of fire will be deducted at full value from the total score.
- n. SPOs firing this course for qualification will wear the equipment required for duty during tactical response situations.
- o. Shooters will don an approved protective mask during the required stages.
- p. Shooters will use a site approved flashlight technique to identify targets during dark stages of fire (to include the transition drill).
