
The sample collection instrument below would be used by recipients of Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grants, State Energy Program grants, and Weatherization Assistance Program grants. Recipients in Each of these programs would report the required data via a web-based form that will be housed in the Performance and Accountability for Grants in Energy (PAGE) system. Recipients of these grant programs are already required to report performance and financial data in the PAGE system on a quarterly basis. By integrating this required Davis-Bacon information collection into PAGE, recipients will be able to enter the Davis-Bacon data at the same time and into the same reporting interface as they enter all other required reporting data. PAGE will also allow DOE program staff to quickly compile the data into a format that matches the DOL's Semi-Annual Enforcement Report.
