- Note the category in which you are submitting the photo

- Include your contact information in the email

A broad selection of the photographs submitted will be featured at DOE's headquarters from April 14-21, and during Community Day, April 22, 2014, from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm, on the DOE Plaza. Photos will also be displayed on the DOE website and via PowerPedia on April 21, 2014.

Judging:

The 2014 DOE Earth Week Planning Committee will determine a winning photograph from each of the five categories (noted above).

Winners will be announced April 21, 2014, and will be notified via email. Their photographs will receive special recognition on Community Day and will be featured on the DOE website.
