The Department of Energy (DOE) is holding this public meeting to solicit comment from the public on its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPR) to establish a retrospective risk pooling program whereby nuclear suppliers would provide premium payments to the United States equal to the amount that the United States would be obligated to contribute under the Convention on Supplementary Compensation for Nuclear Damage in the event of certain nuclear incidents outside the United States.
