To the US Dept of Energy,

I respectfully request that you extend the comment period for the Pieridae LNG Export Permit application docket no. FE-14-179-LNG and require Pieridae to submit more details on its proposal in order to allow comments by our elected officials, many of whom were just sworn in in January.

The financial success of this export terminal is clearly inextricably linked to the construction of new interstate pipeline projects in the Northeast US, none of which (NED, AIM, CT Expansion) have been completed and all of which face legal and environmental challenges.

Further, if as claimed, the construction of these pipelines is to meet (not exceed) the energy needs of New England, then construction of a terminal to export much or all of this new supply would undermine the very purpose for which these pipelines are proposed.

The environmental impact of this terminal extends well beyond its local footprint and I would expect the US DOE to consider as much.
