I am writing to state that I feel no public good is served by the present rush to export LNG. I believe that it is ill-conceived and will be harmful to the environment at this time of severe climate change.

Because I and other affected parties only in the past couple of days became aware of this comment period--it was not widely announced--, I would request an extension of time for all affected parties to comment and intervene on this application.

Briefly, however, I will note that my (and my neighbors') concerns about the export of LNG has to do with:

- the much more significant output of greenhouse gas by the methane that the LNG produces (methane is 86 times more potent than CO₂). As a nation we need to take action to respond to the scientifically unquestioned effects of climate change. We must find ways to lower our emissions of both methane and CO₂. Exporting LNG only increases emissions.
- the fact that natural gas sells for 3 to 4 more times as much in foreign markets which would drive up the price in the domestic market
- over the long term, exporting LNG would reduce the supply available for the domestic market

For all of these reasons, I am opposed to approving this application to export LNG. It is not in the public interest.
