Authorization of export contracts is not in the public interest.

Not only is no "public good" served by these export projects they in fact inflict much public harm because:

- 1) the extraction of fracked gas turns public's property into sacrifice zones;
- 2) the infrastructure to transport and process this unnatural gas turns public property into sacrifice zones;
- 3) exporting our resources reduces what is available to the American public;
- 4) the public's property stands to be taken by eminent domain for private corporate profit;
- 5) the public assumes all the risk and the private sector reaps all the benefits.

We also request an extension of time to comment and intervene.
