Title: Replace WH Radio Tower

Description: Subcontractor shall furnish all labor, tools, equipment, materials, services, transportation,

storage and supervision required to design and install a new design built radio tower, foundations, antenna wiring, lighting, grounding, and all the required electrical tray and tray supports and foundation at the West Hackberry SPR site. Subcontractor shall dismantle and dispose/recycle the old tower and accessories after the new tower is

installed and commissioned.

Regulatory Requirements: NEPA Implementing Procedures (10 CFR 1021)

10 CFR 1021.410 (Application of Categorical Exclusions)

- (a) The actions listed in Appendices A and B of Subpart D are classes of actions that DOE has determined do not individually or cumulatively have a significant effect on the human environment (categorical exclusions).
- (b) To find that a proposal is categorically excluded, DOE shall determine the following:
 - (1) The proposed action fits within a class of actions that is listed in Appendix A or B of Subpart D;

Appendix B (Categorical Exclusions Applicable to Specific Agency Actions)

The proposed action must not:

- 1. Threaten a violation of statutory, regulatory, or permit requirements for environment, safety, and health, including requirements of DOE and/or Executive Orders.
- 2. Require siting and construction or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities, but the proposal may include categorically excluded waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment actions.
- 3. Disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and /natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or
- 4. Adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources.

Categorical Exclusion to be applied: <u>B1.19</u>

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and removal of microwave, radio, communication, and meteorological towers and associated facilities, provided that the towers and associated facilities would not be in a governmentally designated scenic area unless otherwise authorized by the appropriate governmental entity.
