Dear Secretary Moniz,

I am opposed to Clean Line's Plains and Eastern Project and Clean Line's Grain Belt Express (a potential partnership with Clean Line Energy for the Plains and Eastern Project). The Missouri Public Service Commission has recently denied Grain Belt's request for application in the state of Missouri. Clean Line's President Lawlor has stated he would pursue federal eminent domain with the Department of Energy.

Plains and Eastern Project has not been found needed by any regional reliability organization. Clean Lines Energy Partner is not a Transmission Organization as defined in the Federal Power Act. In addition, Clean Line will financially benefit from its own finding that this project is consistent with a regional transmission expansion plan.

The use of Section 1222 aims that projects must be included in an appropriate regional transmission expansion plan if they are proposed within a regional transmission authority's territory. This is not the case in Clean Line's project.

Secretary Moniz, please deny Mr. Lawlor's partnership with the Department of Energy and the use of federal eminent domain.
