I would like to state my opposition the Plains and Eastern Clean Line project proposed to cross the state of Oklahoma. I own property on the Region 1 HVDC Alternative Route: AR 1-A in Garfield county. The proposed alternative route would go across my land for a mile and would be less than a half mile from two homes which are over 100 years old on our property.

The value of my property and my neighbors property will be drastically impacted by this project.

Since Plains and Eastern is a private company, and since they have proposed this project to create significant financial wealth for themselves and their investors, I feel my financial rights as a citizen and landowner are being violated. By taking my land through eminent domain and not paying for all that they taking from me, I am being asked to finance their project.

Clean Line will not compensate me for the visual pollution of my property for the rest of my life.

Clean Line will not compensate me for the noise pollution (corona effect) that goes on 24-7 in a quiet rural setting.

Clean Line will not compensate me for the property value loss that my heirs will experience in the future.

Clean Line will not compensate me for my loss of property rights.

I am not writing this because I want more compensation for my land being taken from me. NO amount of money could make me want this power line across my land. Eminent domain will enable Clean Line to take land without adequately compensating the owners adequately. Please reject this proposal and do NOT allow Clean Line to use eminent domain.
