
Dear Mr. Lawrence:

This is in response to your June 17, 2015, request for DoD to review and comment on the Champlain VT, LLC, d/b/a TDI-New England (TDI-NE) proposal to develop the New England Clean Power Link Project ("Project") (OE Docket No. PP-400).

We have reviewed the Draft Environmental Impact Statement and the Presidential Permit application. DoD has no national security concerns with the project crossing the international border and, on that basis, does not object to the issuance of the Presidential Permit to TDI-NE.

Should the proposed action be amended in a manner that would result in it being sited, constructed, expanded or operated on land or interest in land controlled by DoD, including civil works activities, then a real estate use agreement must be obtained by separate action with the appropriate Military Department.
