First, I am dismayed that the deadline for commenting was so poorly circulated. I just was advised of this deadline very late today. Accordingly, I ask that you re-open the comment period to give all concerned persons a chance to weigh in.

Exportation of LNG is not in the public good.

First, exported LNG sells for 3 to 4 times as much in foreign markets as it does here in the US, driving up domestic prices.

Second, LNG (methane) is a greenhouse gas. The effects of climate change, and the effects of greenhouse gases in promoting climate change, are undisputable. The United States should be working to reduce methane production, not encouraging the ramping up of production and the increased export of this dangerous product.
