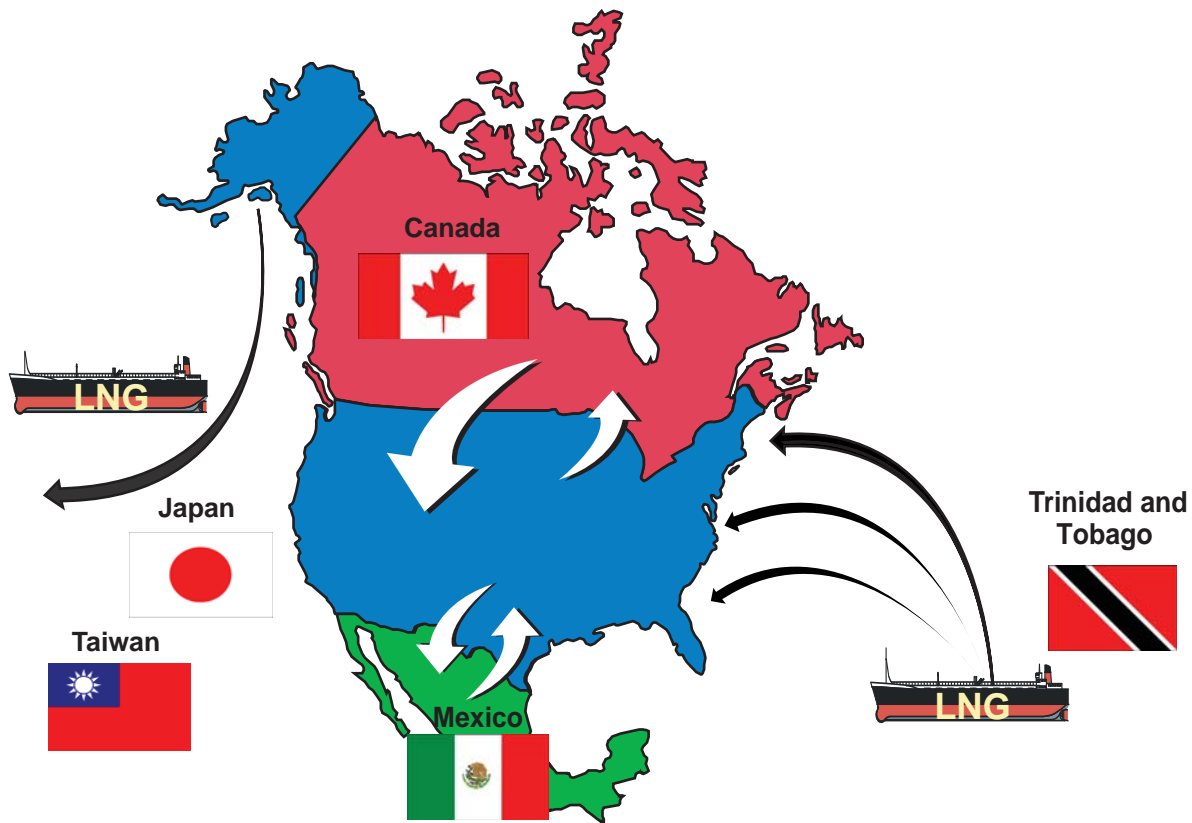

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SUMMARY

The Office of Regulation and International Engagement, Division of Natural Gas Regulation prepares quarterly reports on natural gas import and export activities. Companies are required, as a condition of their authorizations, to file monthly reports. This Natural Gas Import and Export Report is for the third quarter of 2015 (July through September).

Sections 1 and 2 contain quarterly summary charts and tables. Section 3 contains the detailed transactions of all imports and exports. The data in Section 3 are organized by activity: long-term imports, long-term exports, short-term imports, and short-term exports. Section 4 lists revisions made to data published previously. There is a table of contents for your convenience.

Third Quarter 2015 Highlights

U.S. imports totaled 657.8 Bcf and U.S. exports totaled 451.3 Bcf, resulting in net U.S. imports of 206.6 Bcf. Most of the imports came from Canada, comprising 96.3 percent of the total. U.S. imports from Mexico and LNG imports by vessel from Trinidad and Tobago made up the remaining 3.7 percent of total imports. Mexico eclipsed Canada in natural gas exports, with 67.0 percent going to Mexico and 31.2 percent to Canada. The remaining amount were LNG exports by vessel to Japan and Taiwan.

Third Quarter 2015 vs. Second Quarter 2015 - Highlights

As illustrated in the tables in Section 1, total imports increased by 3.3 percent compared to last quarter. Pipeline imports from Canada increased by 0.7 percent, while pipeline imports from Mexico also increased by 8.1 percent (although from a very small initial volume base). LNG imports increased 237.9 percent (although from a very small initial volume base). Canadian and Mexican import prices were both up from last quarter, 2.5 percent and 4.4 percent respectively. LNG import prices fell by 37.8 percent.

Total U.S. exports were 451.3 Bcf, 12.0 percent higher than the second quarter total. An 18.7 percent increase in U.S. exports by pipeline to Mexico was offset by a 1.2 percent decrease in U.S. exports by pipeline to Canada. Prices of U.S. pipeline exports to Canada and Mexico decreased and increased by 1.2 percent and 18.7 percent, respectively.

Additionally, there were three domestic LNG exports this quarter, two cargos to Japan (5.5 Bcf) and one cargo to Taiwan (2.8 Bcf). Total trucked U.S. import volumes (for LNG and CNG) increased by 3.7 percent while total trucked export volumes (for LNG and CNG) decreased by 51.2 percent. Total trucked U.S. export prices (for LNG and CNG) increased by 12.4 percent and import prices (for LNG and CNG) decreased by 2.4 percent, compared to last quarter.

Third Quarter 2015 vs. Third Quarter 2014 – Highlights

Total U.S. imports were up 3.9 percent from the third quarter of 2014. Pipeline imports from Canada increased 2.4 percent, pipeline imports from Mexico decreased 31.2 percent (although from a small base), and LNG imports by vessel increased 75.5 percent. The average price of pipeline imports fell 37.1 percent and LNG import prices also fell 55.9 percent. Trucked imports increased 205.6 percent from last year (although from a small base), with those prices increasing 4.3 percent on average.

Total U.S. exports rose 24.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014. U.S. pipeline exports to Canada decreased by 8.7 percent and U.S. pipeline exports to Mexico increased by 51.3 percent. Overall, U.S. exports by pipeline increased by 25.1 percent while prices declined 30.8 percent, U.S. trucked exports rose 2.2 percent, while their prices fell 34.6 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014.

Imports and Exports of LNG by Vessel

LNG imports by vessel rose 237.9 percent compared to last quarter and also rose 75.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014. Nine LNG cargos (23.9 Bcf) was imported by vessel this quarter, compared to three cargos (7.1 Bcf) second quarter of 2015 and six cargos (13.6 Bcf) in the third quarter of 2014. LNG import prices (by vessel) were 37.8 percent lower than last quarter and 55.9 percent lower than in the third quarter of 2014.

There were three exports of domestically-produced LNG in this quarter (8.3 Bcf), compared to two cargos (5.5 Bcf) in the last quarter and three cargos in the third quarter of 2014 (8.5 Bcf). The U.S. did not re-export cargos of LNG in this quarter and also did not re-export cargos of LNG in the last quarter, while the U.S. also reported no re-exports in the third quarter of 2014.

During this quarter, six LNG cargos were delivered to Puerto Rico (15.7 Bcf), compared to five in the second quarter (13.3 Bcf) and six in the third quarter of 2014 (16.5 Bcf).

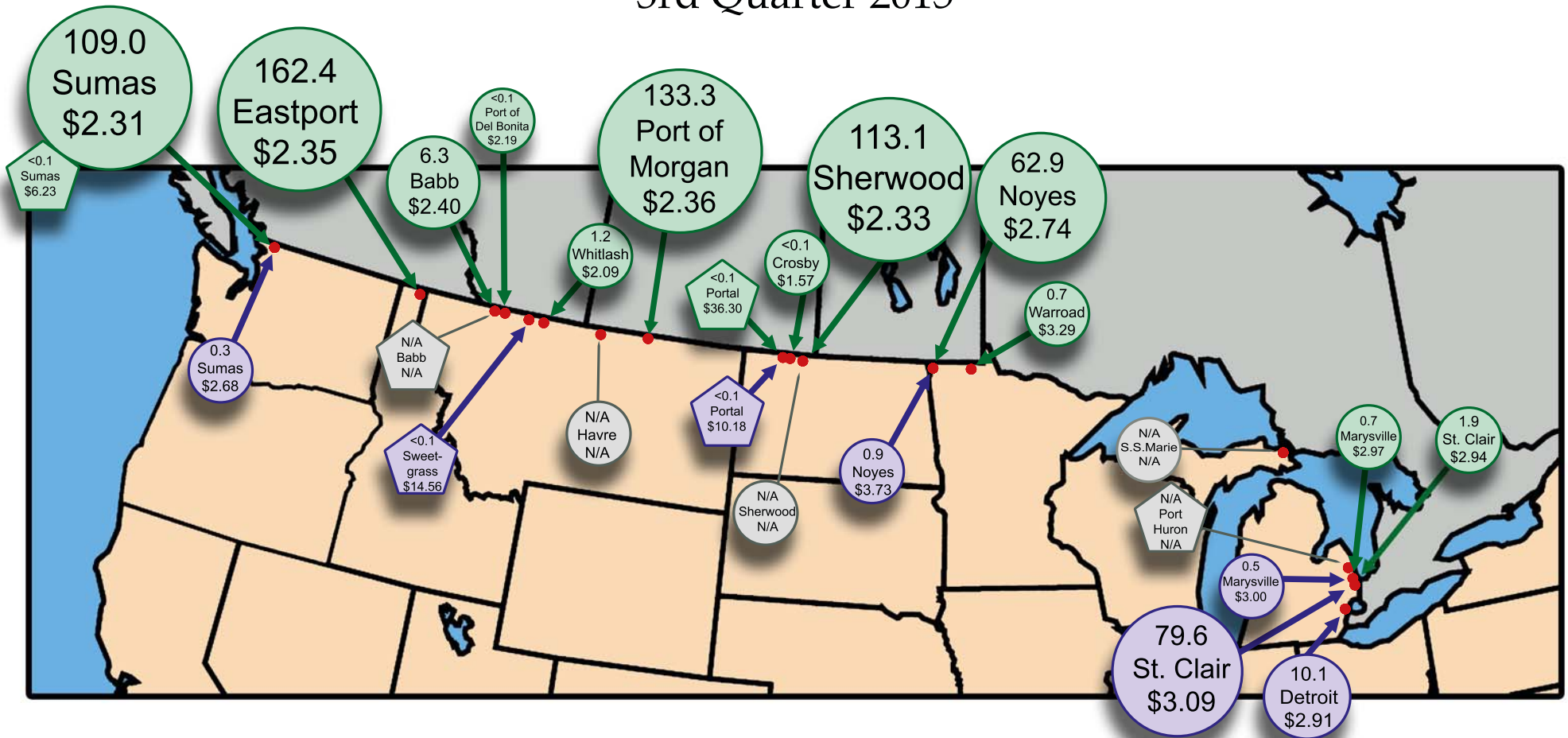

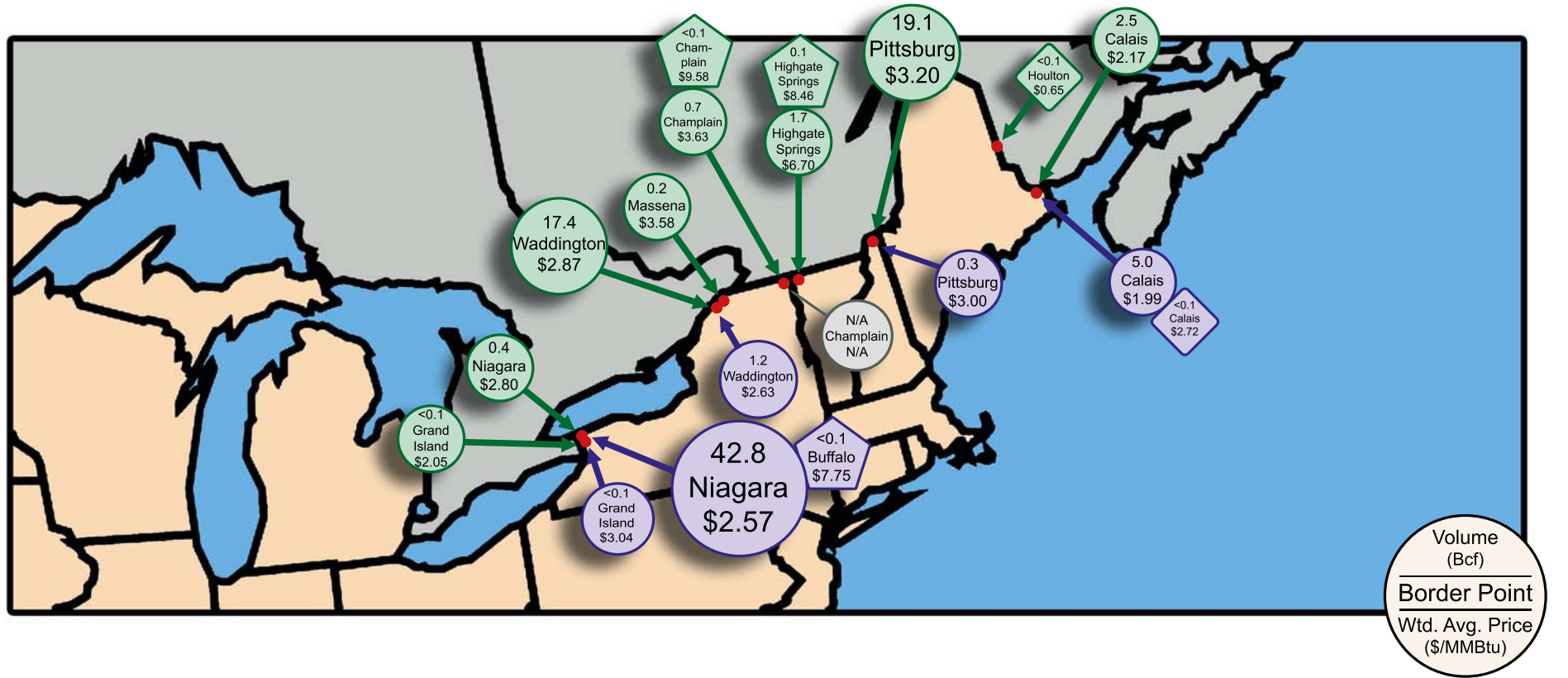

3rd Quarter 2015

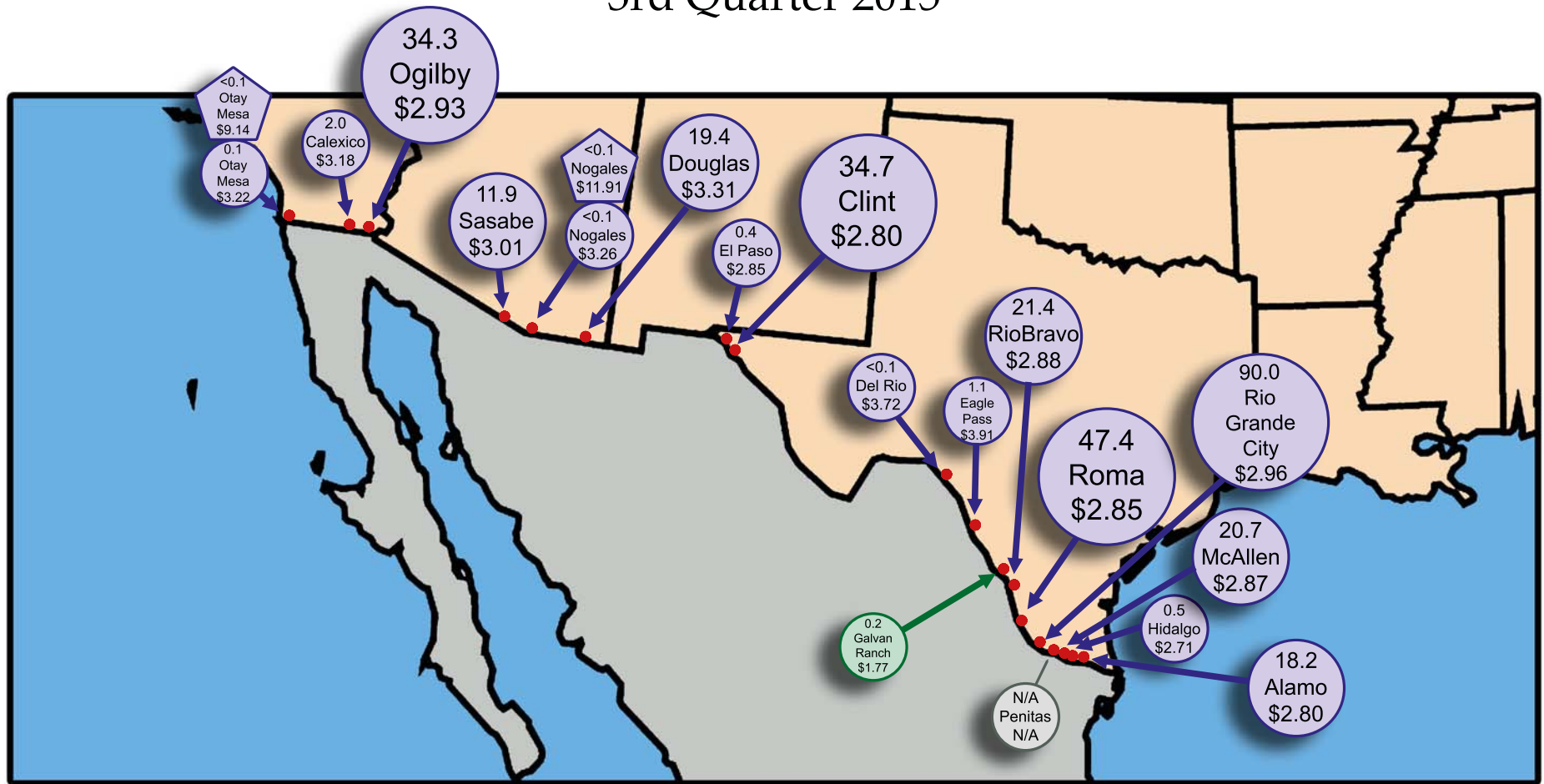

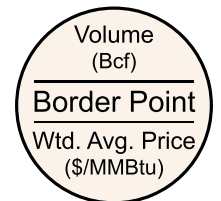
Natural Gas Imports & Exports by Border Point

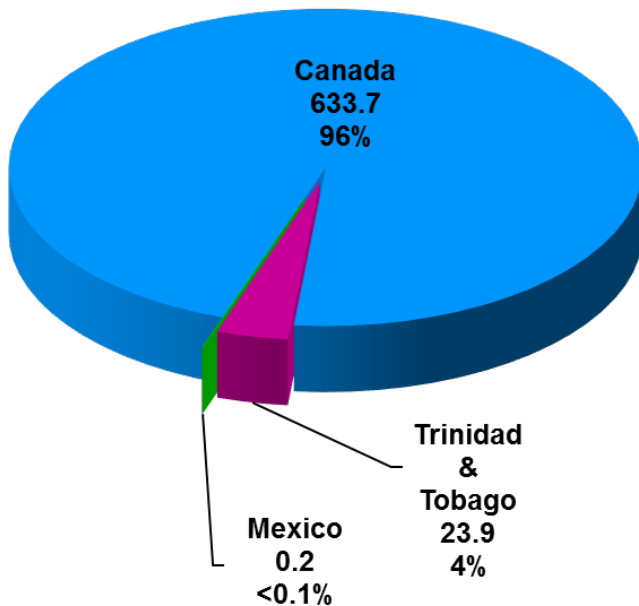

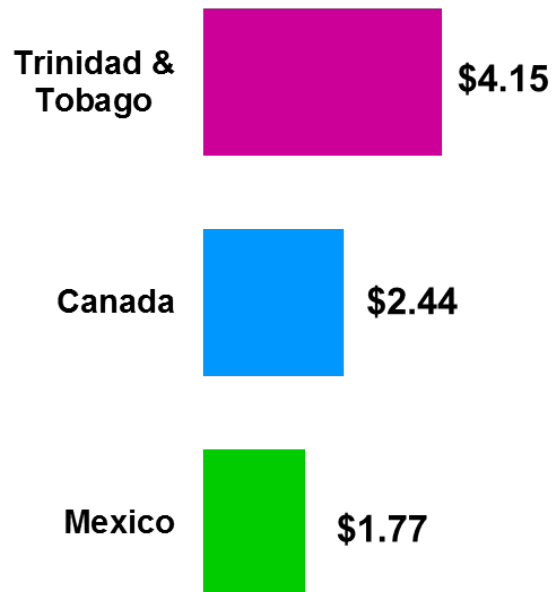

Avg. Import Price, 3Q2015 (\$/MMBtu)

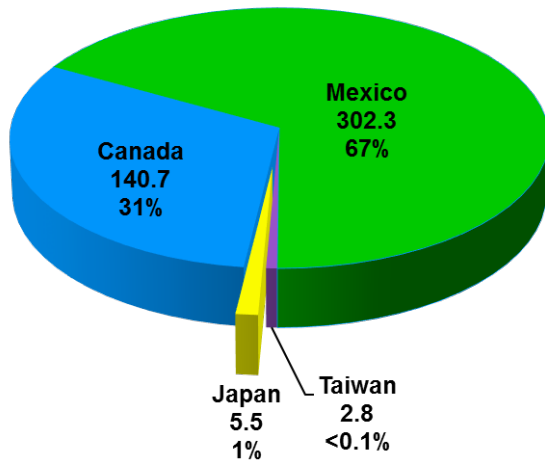


- In the third quarter of 2015, the U.S. imported 657.8 Bcf of natural gas.
- A large majority of imports originated in Canada, continuing a long-term trend. Trinidad & Tobago was the next-largest supplier, providing four percent of imports.
- The remaining volume was supplied by one other country – Mexico.
- Import prices averaged in the range of \$1.77 per MMBtu (for a very small amount from Mexico) to \$4.15 per MMBtu for LNG vessels from Trinidad & Tobago, with a quarterly weighted average price of \$2.50.

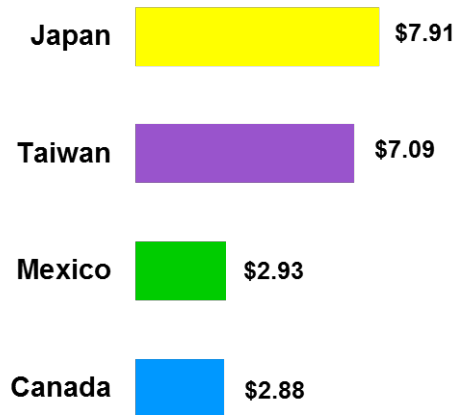
Domestic Natural Gas Exports, 3Q2015

(\$/MMBtu)



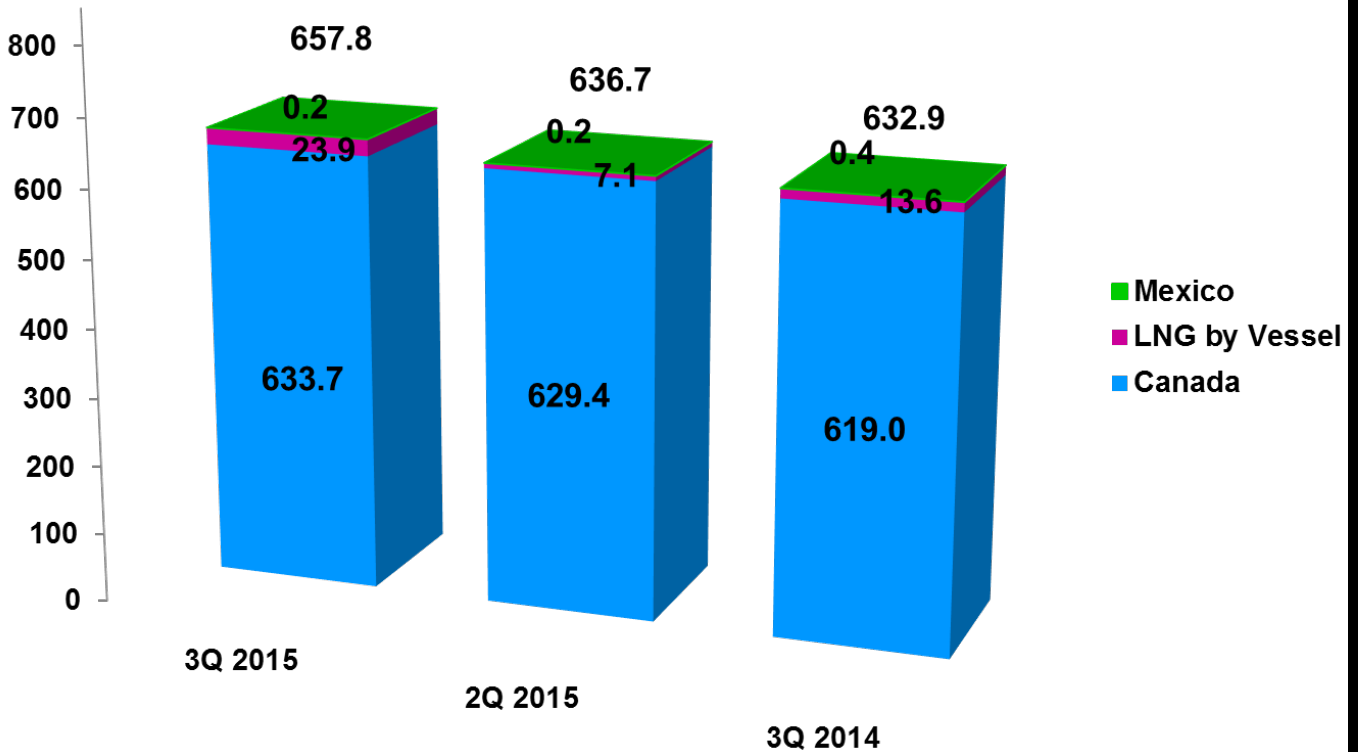

- About 67% of U.S. exports of domestically-produced natural gas during the third quarter were sent to Mexico, while 31% were sent to Canada.
- Prices of exports to Mexico were higher than prices of exports to Canada, with an average price of exports to Mexico at \$2.93 per MMBtu compared to an average price of exports to Canada of \$2.88 per MMBtu.

(Bcf)

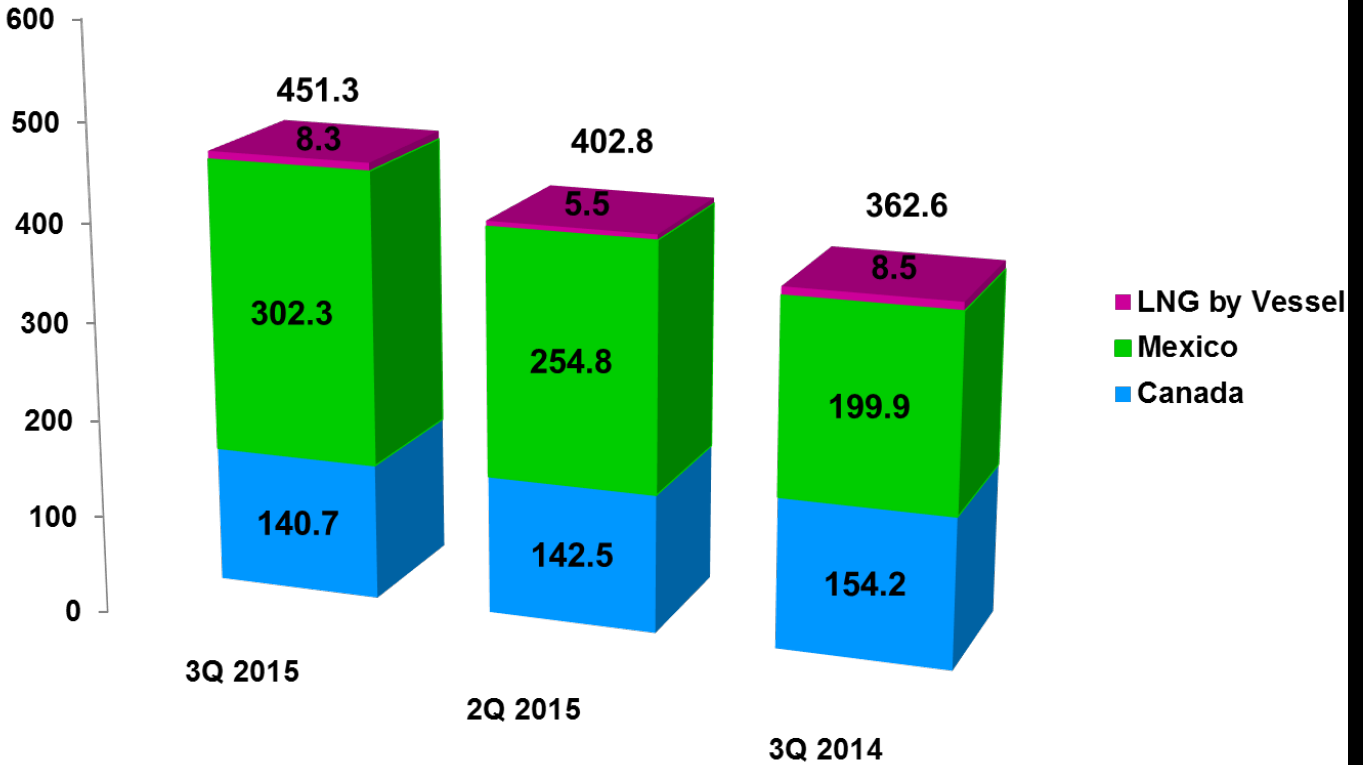

- The total volume of third quarter imports was slightly higher than the second quarter of 2015 and higher than the third quarter of 2014.
- The increase in imports relative to the second quarter of this year looks to be attributed to an increase in LNG imports by vessel.

(Bcf)

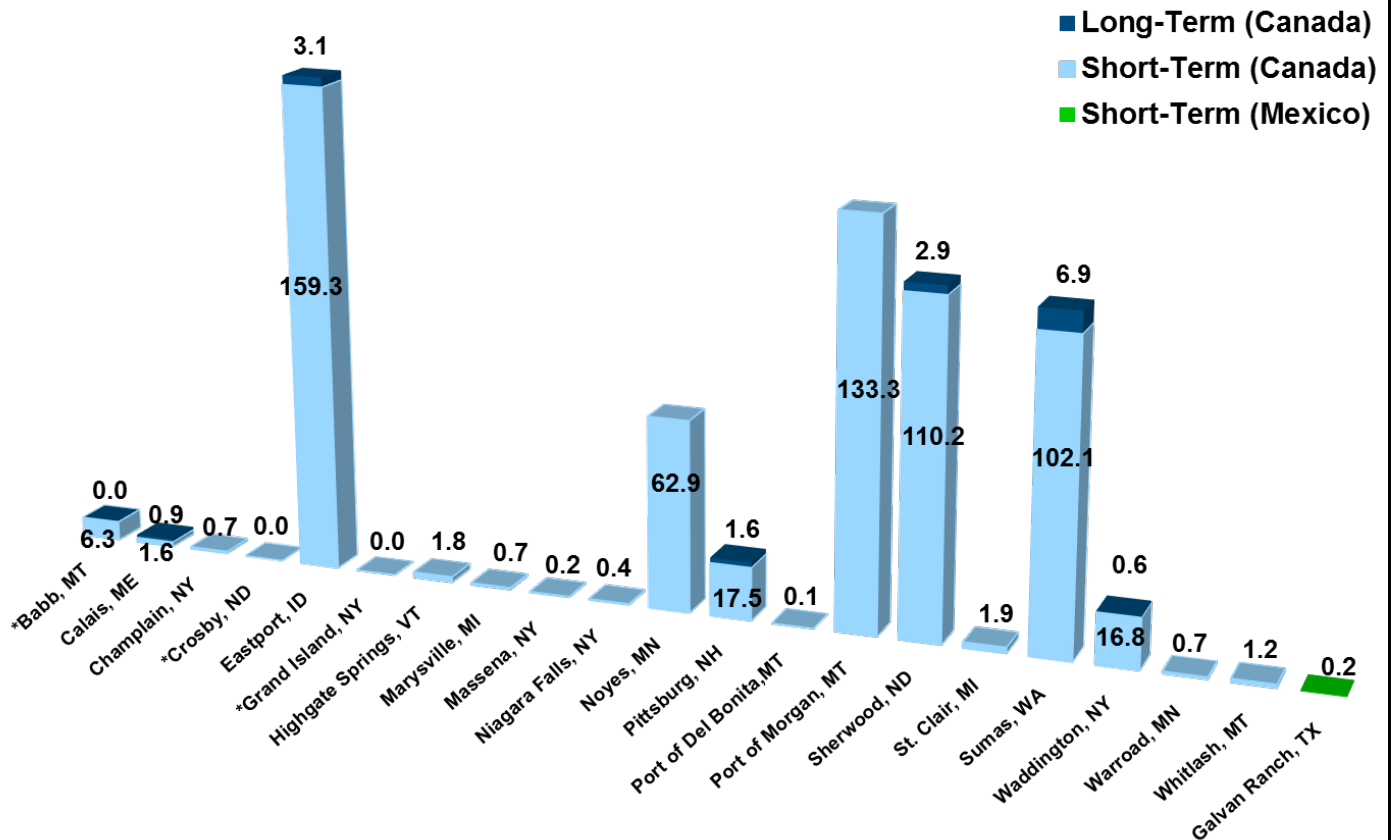

- Export volumes in the third quarter of 2015 were higher than the 2Q2015 and higher than the 3Q2014, by 12.0% and 24.5%, respectively.
- Exports to Canada were lower than both second quarter 2015 and third quarter 2014.
- Exports to Mexico in the third quarter of 2015 were higher than both the second quarter 2015 and the third quarter 2014, following the trend of growth in exports to Mexico.
- There were domestically-produced LNG exports this quarter totaling 8.3 Bcf, with the destination countries being Japan and Taiwan.

(Bcf)



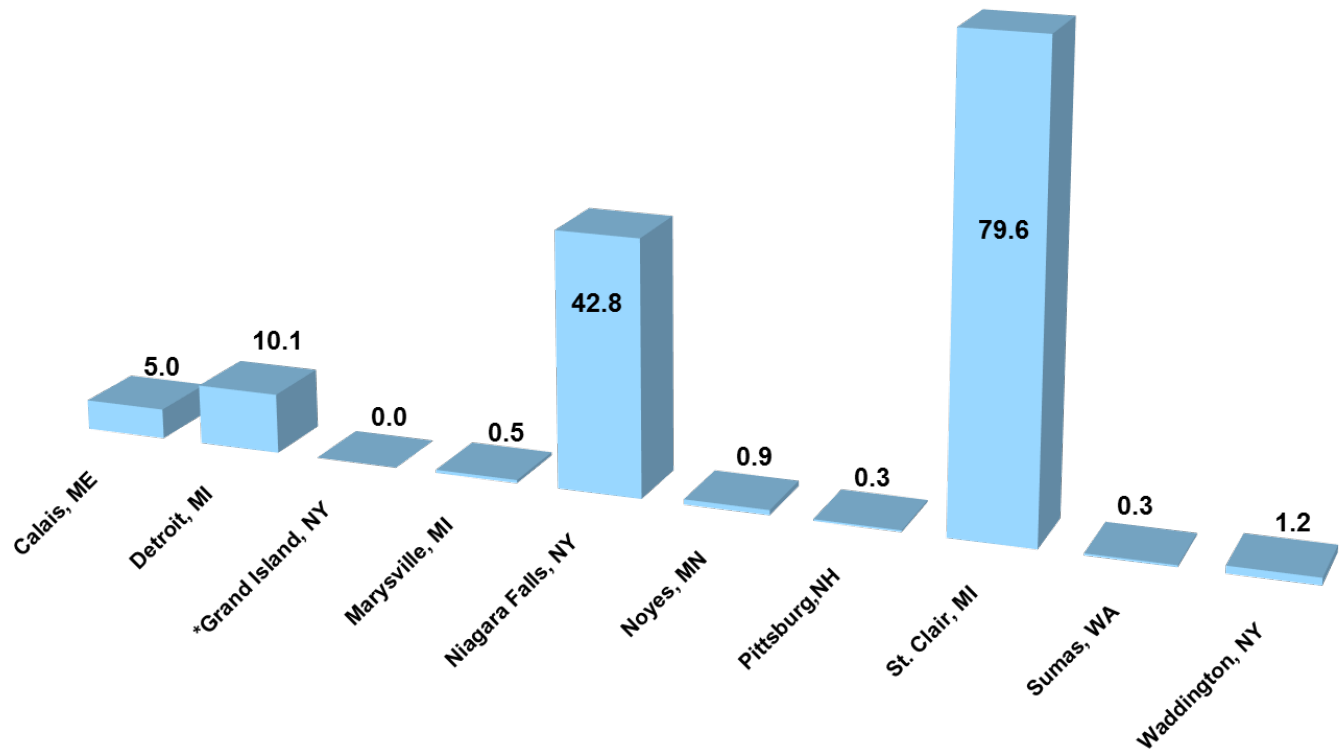

- Volumes of natural gas imported under short-term authorizations continued to eclipse volumes imported under long-term authorizations at all entry points.
- Eastport, Idaho experienced the highest volume of imports from Canada, at 25.6% of the total. Port of Morgan, Montana and Sherwood, North Dakota had the second and third largest import volumes, accounting for 21.0% and 17.9% of the total, respectively.
- Continuing a trend of negligible imports from Mexico in recent years, only a small volume of natural gas was brought into the country from Mexico, through only one entry point, during the third quarter.

■ Short-Term



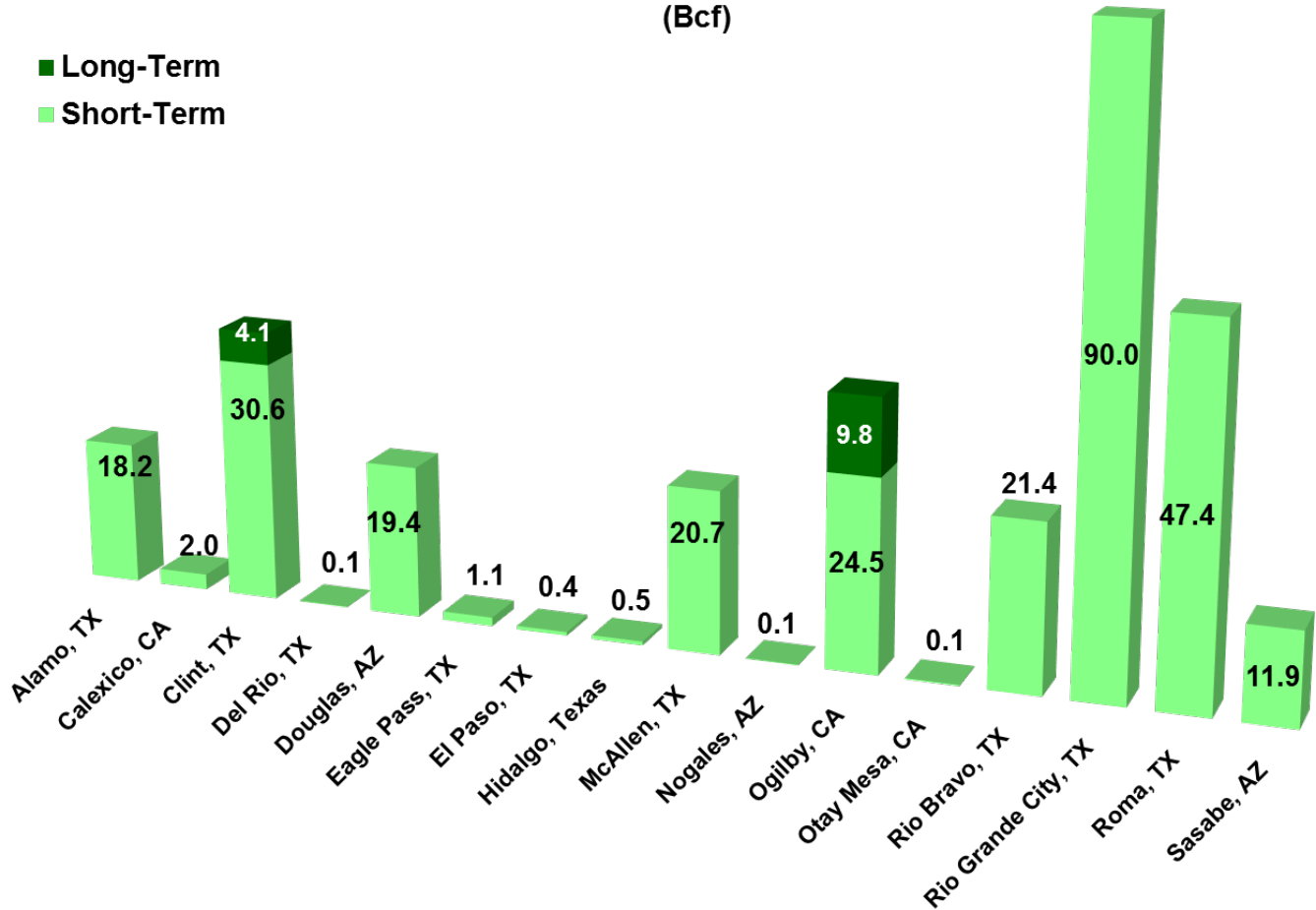

Pipeline Exports to Mexico by Exit Point, 3Q2015

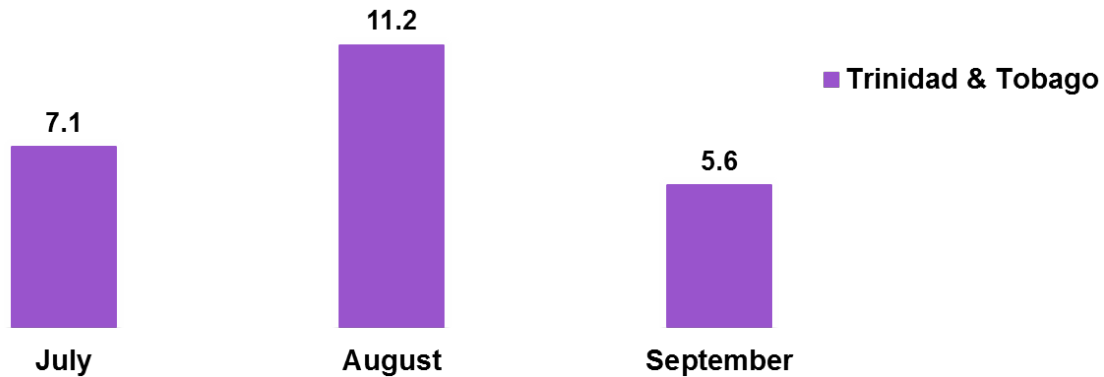

■ Short-Term



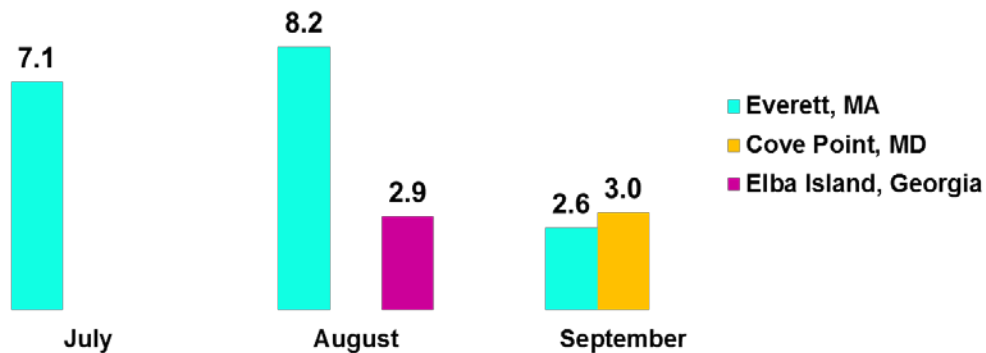

LNG Import Volume by Country (Bcf)



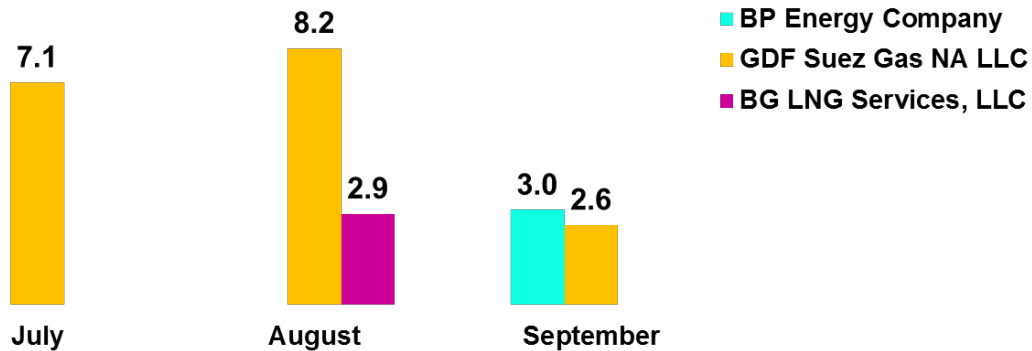
- Trinidad & Tobago was the only supplier of LNG to the U.S. in the third quarter.
