

# Opportunities Available to Small Business in 2017 Through NRLFO and the M&O

## Construction - \$40M

- Building construction, building renovations and infrastructure maintenance

## Manufacturing - \$24M

- Fabricated metal product, machinery, computer and electronic product, electrical equipment and component manufacturing

## Wholesale Trade - \$47M

- Wholesale computer, peripheral equipment and software, office supplies, electrical equipment and wiring supplies

## Other Services - \$3M

- Commercial, industrial machinery, equipment, computer and communication equipment repair and maintenance

## Professional Services - \$32M

- Architectural and engineering services, consulting, computer programming and system design services

## Administrative and Support, Waste Management and Remediation Services - \$8M

- Remediation services, security support, septic tank services, extermination and pest control, security systems services

## Information - \$4.75M

- Software publishers, data processing and hosting services
