ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM
VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL SOURCES BY VESSEL


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3666-A

On June 24, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to SV Global LNG Trading Company, LLC (SV Global) in DOE/FE Order No. 3666 to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from various international sources by vessel, up to a total volume equivalent to 80 billion cubic feet of natural gas, over a two-year term beginning on the first date of delivery.

On December 2, 2016, SV Global notified DOE/FE that it had not engaged in the business of importing LNG and therefore no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Accordingly, SV Global requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3666 retroactively, effective November 30, 2016. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import LNG from various international sources by vessel granted to SV Global in DOE/FE Order No. 3666 is hereby vacated, effective November 30, 2016.
