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Comment:	DOE has requested information in response to the following question: 10. What, if any, supporting agreements might be expected between the Government and the host state/tribe/local community associated with a PI? Our response/comment: As mentioned in our previous responses to DOE's third and seventh questions, all liability must remain with the PI companies, not with the federal taxpayer. And as mentioned in response to DOE's fifth question, the PI companies must meet fixed costs commitments; any cost overruns would then be the private companies' problem, not DOE's (that is, not taxpayers'). And again, DOE and its replacement radioactive waste management
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agency must agree, once and for all, to stop targeting Native American communities, as well as any other low income and/or people of color community, for de facto permanent parking lot dumps. *🌐

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
