Order No. 202-17-3

On July 14, 2017, Sierra Club submitted to the Department of Energy (DOE) a “Motion to Intervene and Petition for Rehearing” of DOE Order No. 202-17-2 issued on June 16, 2017.¹ The petition was submitted under section 313 of the Federal Power Act, which governs rehearing requests. 16 U.S.C. 825l.

On July 31, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted to DOE a “Motion for Leave to Answer and Answer.” The following day, Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) submitted to DOE its own “Motion to Strike the Procedurally Deficient Petition for Rehearing, or, in the alternative, Motion for Leave to Answer and Answer.”

Order Granting Rehearing for Further Consideration

In order to afford additional time for consideration of the matters raised and any additional relevant facts, rehearing of Order No. 202-17-2 is hereby granted for the limited purpose of further consideration. This Order No. 202-17-3 shall not operate as a stay of Order No. 202-17-2. 16 U.S.C. § 824l(c).

This order shall be effective upon its issuance.
