Over the past few years, the food industry has incorporated renewable biobased resources into packaging materials like potato chip bags and yogurt containers while the electronics industry has started incorporating it into resins used in wiring boards for computers and cell phones. The Department of Energy's Bioenergy Technologies Office is investing in technologies that will reduce costs and optimize the performance of these bioproducts.
