Yes....Biofuel Is a Bioproduct (Chemical Compound) Need...Parity, Agnostic, Not Overly Prescriptive Policy


Access to Capital (Push)

Speed to Market (Pull)

- Regulatory

- Preferential Programs
 - EPA (Green Chem/Safer Chemicals)
 - USDA Biopreferrred
 - DOE (Energy Star, Green Building/LEED, CAFÉ/light weighting autos)

Funding Decisions Lead With Vision, End Goal in Mind

- Proposals are proposals
- Project execution, supposed to change, iterative feedback loop, quality control, risk mitigation
- It's hard, takes time, bottlenecks
- Failure based on scientific integrity, including lessons learned not execution failure (*insanity doing same thing over and over and expecting different results*)
- Need collaborations and consortia, with industry leading the way

- Functionality, performance advantaged


Result: Project finance models, investment


