ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO
REFLECT CORPORATE NAME CHANGE

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3765-A

On December 31, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 3765 (FE Docket No. 15-165-NG), under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA).¹ DOE/FE Order No. 3765 jointly grants Irving Oil Commercial GP and Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. (collectively, Irving) long-term authorization to import up

to 10 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas per year from Canada and to export up to 22 Bcf per year of natural gas to Canada for a 15-year term beginning on November 1, 2017.

On October 12, 2017, Irving notified DOE/FE that, effective September 30, 2017, Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. had changed its name to Irving Oil Terminals Operations LLC following its conversion to a limited liability company.² Irving requests that DOE/FE amend DOE/FE Order No. 3765 to reflect Irving's change in name and asks that this amendment be issued as soon as possible so that Irving may commence importing and exporting natural gas from and to Canada as authorized by DOE/FE Order No. 3765.

Finding good cause, DOE/FE hereby grants the request to amend the specified authorization to reflect the above-described corporate name change. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, it is hereby ordered that DOE/FE Order No. 3765 is amended to substitute Irving Oil Terminals Operations LLC as the joint importer or exporter of natural gas, as applicable, effective September 30, 2017. All other terms and conditions of DOE/FE Order No. 3765 shall remain in full force and effect.
