ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4012-A

On April 17, 2017, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Noble Americas Gas & Power Corp. in DOE/FE Order No. 4012 to import and export up to a combined total of 400 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico over a two-year term beginning on June 1, 2017, and extending through May 31, 2019.

On April 9, 2018, Noble Americas Gas & Power Corp. notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Noble Americas Gas & Power Corp., therefore, requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4012, effective December 31, 2017. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico granted to Noble Americas Gas & Power Corp. in DOE/FE Order No. 4012 is hereby vacated, effective December 31, 2017.
