

Enforcement Policy Statement – Ceiling Fan Light Kits

Issued: May 9, 2018

In an exercise of its enforcement discretion, DOE will not seek civil penalties concerning violations of the energy conservation standards in 10 C.F.R. § 430.32(s)(5) with respect to the distribution in commerce of a ceiling fan light kit manufactured on or after January 1, 2007, and prior to January 21, 2020, provided:

- (1) each ceiling fan light kit is packaged with lamps to fill all sockets; and
- (2) each basic model of lamp packaged with the basic model of CFLK and each basic model of integrated SSL in the CFLK basic model meets the minimum required efficacy standard set forth at 10 C.F.R. § 430.32(s)(6); and
- (3) the manufacturer of the basic model of ceiling fan light kit has certified that the ceiling fan light kit basic model meets the standards set forth at 10 C.F.R. § 430.32(s)(6).

This policy does not create or remove any rights or duties and does not affect any other aspect of EPCA or DOE regulations. This policy statement is not a final agency action, has no legally binding effect on persons or entities outside the federal government, and may be rescinded or modified in the Department's complete discretion. Accordingly, it is not intended to, does not, and may not be relied upon to, create any rights, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law by any party in any matter.
