

CLASS DEVIATION

FINDINGS AND DETERMINATION

**INCREASE IN THRESHOLD FOR REQUIRING
CERTIFIED COST OR PRICING DATA**

Findings


1. The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 (Section 811) increased the threshold for requiring certified cost or pricing data from \$750,000 to \$2,000,000. The threshold increase excludes contracts entered into on or before June 30, 2018. Contractors may request modifications to earlier contracts (without consideration) to use the threshold increase.
2. The Civilian Agency Acquisition Council (CAAC) issued CAAC Letter 2018-03 on May 3, 2018, authorizing agencies to issue class deviations implementing the threshold increase.
3. CAAC Letter 2018-03 is attached. It includes the FAR Deviation Text. There is no DEAR coverage impacted by this class deviation.

Determination

It is hereby determined that a class deviation (using the FAR Deviation text included in CAAC Letter 2018-03) is appropriate to implement section 811 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018. This class deviation is effective upon the date of signature and will remain in effect until cancelled or until the new threshold is incorporated into the FAR.
