ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4030-A

On May 12, 2017, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Hermiston Generating Company, L.P. in DOE/FE Order No. 4030 to import up to 30 billion cubic feet of natural gas via pipeline from Canada over a two-year term beginning on July 1, 2017, and extending through June 30, 2019.

On December 11, 2018, Hermiston Generating Company, L.P., notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization and therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4030, effective December 12, 2018.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from Canada granted to Hermiston Generating Company, L.P. in DOE/FE Order No. 4030 is hereby vacated, effective December 12, 2018.
