Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering,

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information analysis, and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and dissemination informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to the Alaska Village Electric Cooperative (AVEC) for the installation of a 900 kilowatt capacity direct-drive wind turbine with associated access road and wind turbine pad. The wind turbine would be installed and maintained on Stebbins Native Corporation lands and would connect to an existing powerline that runs between the communities of Stebbins and St. Michael's, Alaska. This NEPA determination is only for Task 1 and part of Task 2 (Subtasks 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, and 2.4) of the approved Statement of Project Objectives. These tasks will help to more thoroughly define the remainder of the project.

Due to the height of the proposed turbine and the proximity to the Stebbins and St. Michael's Airports, project information must be submitted to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for an Obstruction Evaluation/Airport Airspace Analysis. The FAA has yet to complete an aeronautical study of the turbine and any potential effects to the airports and air navigation. At this time, there is not enough information to complete a thorough review of the construction and surface disturbing activities associated with the installation of the wind turbine at the proposed location. Once the FAA has completed their aeronautical study and additional details of project design and siting are completed, another NEPA review will be required to assess potential impacts associated with the procurement, construction, and operation of the wind turbine.
