ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4344-A

On February 13, 2019, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to EdgeMarc Energy Ohio, LLC in DOE/FE Order No. 4344 to export up to 50 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Canada via pipeline over a two-year term beginning on February 13, 2019, and extending through February 12, 2021.

On June 18, 2019, EdgeMarc Energy Ohio, LLC, notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization and therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4344, effective April 30, 2019.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Canada granted to EdgeMarc Energy Ohio, LLC in DOE/FE Order No. 4344 is hereby vacated, effective April 30, 2019.
