Dear Dr. Younger:

This letter serves as notification of the Office of Enterprise Assessments' Office of Enforcement's decision to conduct an investigation into the facts and circumstances associated with the introduction of classified information into unapproved information systems and unauthorized disclosure of classified information at the National Nuclear Security Administration's Sandia National Laboratories, in Albuquerque, NM. National Technology and Engineering Solutions of Sandia, LLC (NTESS) discovered this security incident in May 2018 and reported the incident closure in the Department of Energy's Safeguards and Security Information Management System on August 31, 2018. On January 30, 2019, the Office of Enforcement received the causal analysis and corrective action plan for this security incident.

The Office of Enforcement will conduct this investigation pursuant to the authority set forth in 10 C.F.R. § 824.5, *Investigations*. The investigation will include an onsite visit and interviews with contractor personnel, at a date to be determined. The Office of Enforcement will provide a document request to support this investigation separately via e-mail. We appreciate your cooperation to ensure timely submission of all documents to our office by the requested date.

Under the Major Fraud Act (MFA), as amended, 41 U.S.C. § 4310, this investigation may be a proceeding commenced by the United States that relates to a violation of, or the failure to comply with, a Federal regulation. Costs incurred in connection with such a proceeding are subject to the reimbursement restrictions of the MFA implemented at 48 C.F.R. § 31.205-47. As a result, NTESS should track any costs incurred that are directly attributable to supporting the Office of Enforcement's investigation, subsequent to receipt of this letter, and segregate them from other potentially allowable costs.
