Task Force on Agriculture and Rural Prosperity

Building Rural Prosperity Through Infrastructure, Partnerships, and Innovation (IPI)

Led by Agriculture Secretary Perdue

- Established by Presidential Executive Order in 2017
- 22 federal agencies and departments
- Focused on agriculture, economic development, job growth, infrastructure, innovation, energy security, and quality of life
- Recommended over 100 legislative, regulatory, and policy actions

Provides loan funds for emerging technologies:

 - Renewable chemicals
- Biobased product manufacturing
- Maximum Loan \$250 Million




USDA Energy Resources
