Blue Water Fuels, LLC ("BWF") requests to amend Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy's Order No. 4202 issued June 25, 2018, hereby to include sourcing liquefied natural gas ("LNG") from the Ehrenberg Spectrum LNG Facility:

- The Ehrenberg Spectrum LNG Facility is a small volume LNG production facility located in Ehrenberg, Arizona owned and operated by Spectrum LNG. This facility has a liquefaction capacity of 6280 thousand cubic feet ("MCF") per day ("Mcf/d") and storage capacity of 8300 Mcf. The facility is capable of loading (20) trucks per day. The Ehrenberg LNG Facility was built in 2010 and is subject to regulation by PHMSA.

BWF is requesting to export LNG via approved 40-foot ISO IMO7/TVAC-ASME LNG containers or tanker trucks to only Free Trade Agreement ("FTA") countries beginning on the Effective Date of August 21, 2019.
