Aha Macav Power Service (AMPS) was incorporated under a Tribal Charter authorized in July 1991.

Provides electric power service to homes and businesses located within the Fort Mojave Indian Reservation.



Provides natural gas for the Avi Resort and Casino and the Mojave Crossing Event Center.




