

NGLIA: Next Generation Lighting Industry Alliance

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What is NGLIA?

- ▶ An alliance of for-profit US companies formed to accelerate US SSL development and commercialization through government-industry partnership.
- ▶ Membership is open to any private, for-profit firm substantially active in SSL research, development, infrastructure, and/or manufacturing in the US.

Origin of NGLIA

- ▶ Established in 2003
- ▶ Relationship with DOE defined in 42 USC 16192:
Next Generation Lighting Initiative
 - ▶ “the Secretary shall competitively select an Industry Alliance to represent participants who are private, for-profit firms, open to large and small businesses, that, as a group, are broadly representative of United States solid-state lighting research, development, infrastructure, and manufacturing expertise as a whole.”

Functions of NGLIA

- ▶ “The Secretary shall annually solicit from the Industry Alliance
 - ▶ (A) comments to identify solid-state lighting technology needs;
 - ▶ (B) an assessment of the progress of the research activities of the Initiative; and
 - ▶ (C) assistance in annually updating solid-state lighting technology roadmaps.”
