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On October 16, 2019, Commonwealth LNG, LLC ("Commonwealth") filed an application with the Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy ("DOE/FE") requesting long-term, multicontract authorization to export domestically produced liquefied natural gas ("LNG") up to the equivalent of 441.4 billion cubic feet of natural gas per year to Free Trade Agreement ("FTA") nations, and to Non-Free Trade Agreement ("Non-FTA") nations. Commonwealth requested such authorization for: (i) a 25-year period for exports to FTA nations, and (ii) a 20-year period for exports to Non-FTA nations, each commencing on the date of first commercial export or seven years from the issuance of the authorization sought, from a proposed liquefaction and export facility located in Cameron Parish, Louisiana (the "Commonwealth LNG Project" or "Project").

As described in greater detail in its application filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. CP19-502-000, the Commonwealth LNG Project will include one LNG plant (including six liquefaction trains and appurtenant facilities), six LNG storage tanks, and one marine loading berth (collectively "LNG Facility"), and a 3.04-mile long, 30-inch diameter pipeline that will connect the LNG Facility with existing intrastate and interstate pipelines for the purpose of supplying feed gas to the Project. The feed gas pipeline will include interconnections with an existing interstate pipeline owned by Kinetica Partners, LLC, and two existing intrastate pipelines owned by EnLink Bridgeline Holdings LP.

The LNG Facility will be developed within a 393-acre property parcel in Cameron Parish, Louisiana, on the west side of the Calcasieu Ship Channel near its entrance into the Gulf of Mexico. In this regard, Commonwealth is submitting, as supplemental information, copies of its ground leases for the LNG Facility site.¹ The lease agreements are provided under seal, as Privileged and Confidential Information.
