

## HOW TO COMMENT

To indicate you would like to make a comment during the scoping meeting, raise your hand by clicking the hand icon in the bottom left of the Participants panel. If you don't see the panel, click the Participants icon in the control panel, as shown below.

### On a Phone Only:

1. Dial \*3 to raise your hand. The moderator will unmute your line. You will hear a beep when your line is unmuted.
2. Callers are requested to identify themselves for the record.

Do not use your phone controls to mute/unmute.

## PUBLIC HEARING TIPS

It is recommended to join the webinar up to 15 minutes early. This will allow time to install or download any needed software or applications and confirm that you are able to connect to both audio and video. All required software is free of charge to all participants

If you are unable to use computer audio, please be sure to enter the attendee ID number provided if using the call-in option. The attendee ID can be found by clicking the information button (i in a circle) at the top left of the WebEx window.

While WebEx software is intended to run on all commercial internet browsers (such as Internet Explorer and Safari), WebEx recommends using Chrome or Firefox internet browsers for the best experience.

Familiarize yourself with the meeting control that allows you to “raise your hand”, as this is how to sign up to comment during the public hearing. You will be called in the order in which you raise your hand, so do not “unraise” your hand prematurely. Once you have been recognized and made your comment, please unraise your hand (click the same hand icon).
