

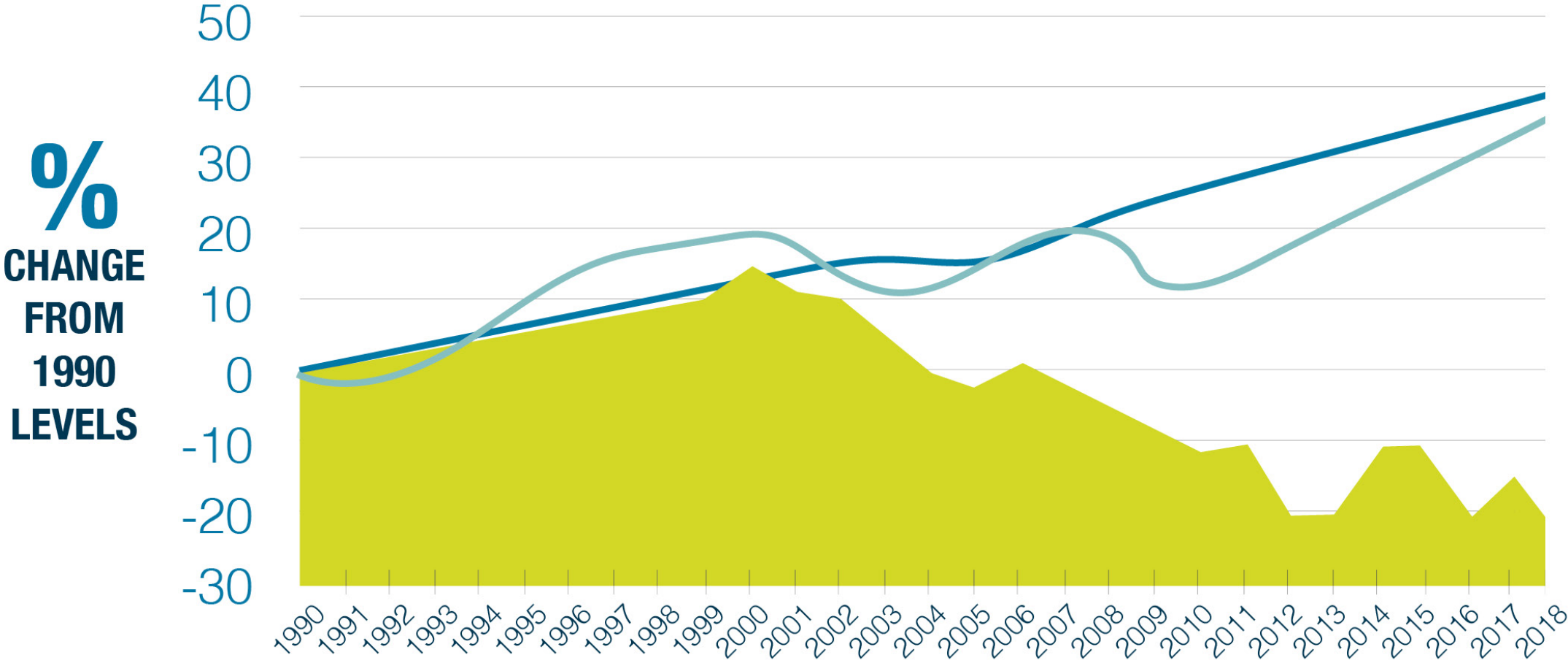

POPULATION GROWTH



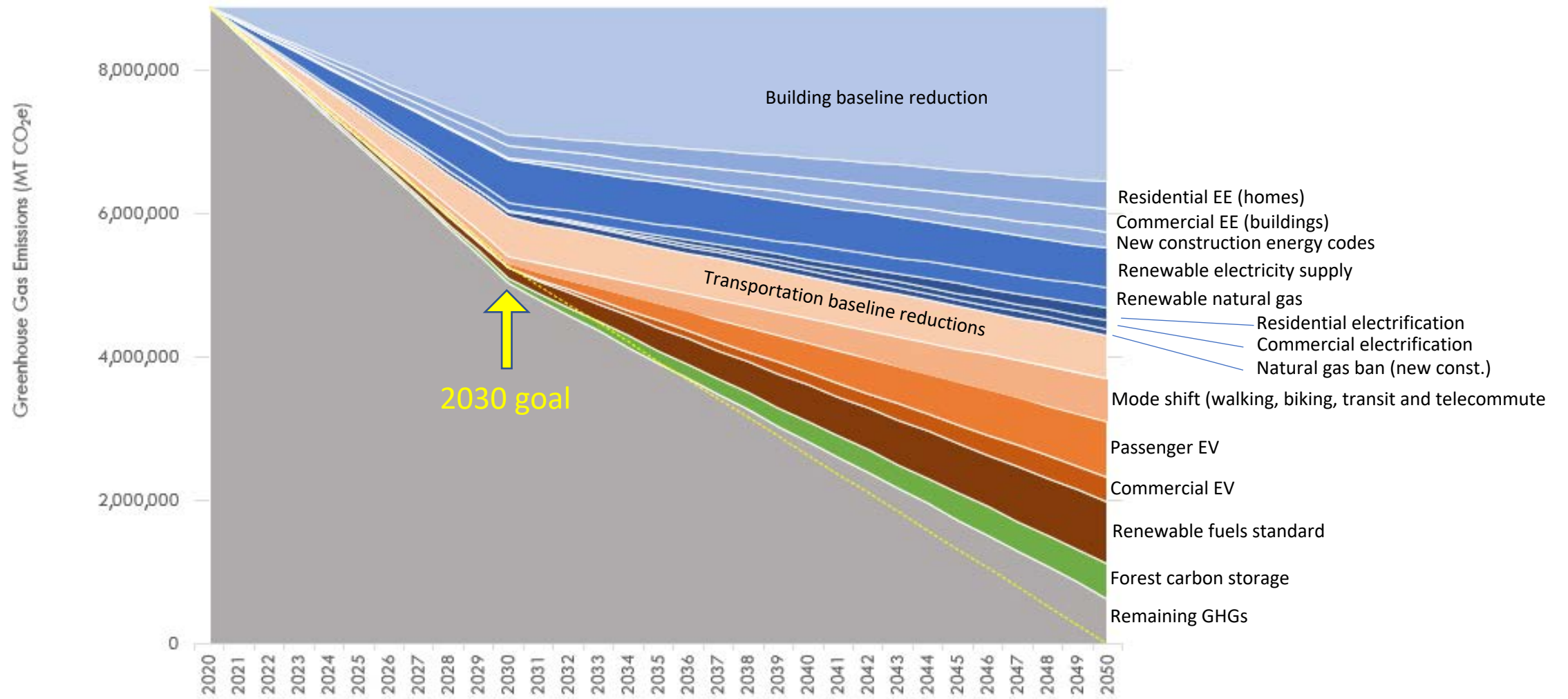
