ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4366-A

DECEMBER 22, 2020

On March 27, 2019, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 4366 to RBC Energy Services LP (RBC Energy Services) under section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717b(c). DOE/FE Order No. 4366 authorized RBC Energy Services to import and export up to a combined total of 15 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on May 31, 2019, and extending through May 30, 2021.

On November 18, 2020, RBC Energy Services (through Royal Bank of Canada) notified DOE/FE that, effective September 30, 2020, it ceased its natural gas marketing business and no longer needs the current blanket authorization. RBC Energy Services therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4366, effective as of September 30, 2020.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act, DOE/FE Order No. 4366 is hereby vacated, effective September 30, 2020.
