- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.
- B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

#### Rational for determination:

The State of Louisiana will provide \$1,000,000 in Recovery Act funds to Cleco Power, LLC, Northstar Resources LLC, and the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, hereafter referred to as the "consortium", to build and operate a three-ton-per-day biomass gasifier. The gasifier will be located in the Acadia Parish Industrial Park in the southwestern corner of the City of Crowley, Louisiana.

The majority of work outlined in the project meets the criteria of the Louisiana-signed SEP Template in that the system will not exceed the 3MMBtu/hr capacity limit for biomass boiler systems. The project is also a pilot-scale effort as a proof-of-concept for the gasifier design. The plans of the consortium; however, entail 2-phases for which this project addresses only Phase 1. DOE views the Phase 1 and Phase 2 activities as connected actions whereas the Phase 1 effort involves work to prove the concept of a 3MMBtu/hr system and Phase 2 involves a demonstation size scale-up of the system. The Phase 1 scope of work is as follows:

- Task 1 Select Gasifier Configuration
- Task 2 Complete System Design
- Task 3 Generate Bid Package
- Task 4 Initiate Construction at Site
- Task 5 Complete Construction
- Task 6 System Shake-Down
- Task 7 Fully Operational
- Task 8 Potentially Initiate Phase II (not formally part of DNR portion)

In view of consortium plans to scale-up the system to a size that exceeds the SEP Template guidelines and beyond that of a pilot-scale operation, DOE has determined that Recovery Act funds are not to be used in support of the Task 8 effort without resubmitting the Phase 2 effort inclusive of Phase 1, Task 8 for DOE review.

In view of the information provided by the State and recipient, DOE has determined that the Phase 1 work, absent Task 8, is consistent with activities identified in the State-signed SEP Template and Categorical Exclusion B3.6 and B5.1.
