Description:

A11 Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

Rational for determination:

The City of Saint Petersburg, Florida proposes to use federal funds to research, design, and construct a facility that will allow the city to process and dispose of bio-solids and yard wastes in a manner that will allow for the generation of thermal, electrical, or gas energy. The first phase of this project is to perform a feasibility study to analyze the necessary inputs and technologies available. This NEPA determination applies to Phase 1 only.

Phase 1 consists of biosolids and yard waste sampling for pertinent data, provide a summary of various technologies available to process sampled wastes, and have a consultant rank the various technologies.

Phases 2 and 3 are prohibited at this time and subject to futher NEPA review.

Phase 1 includes feasibility studies and information gathering therefore CX A9 & A11 apply.
