EIA's Mission

- The U.S. Energy information Administration (EIA) collects, analyzes, and disseminates independent energy information to promote sound policymaking, efficient markets, and public understanding regarding energy and its interaction with the economy and the environment.



EIA's Mandate

- EIA is the Nation's premier source of energy information and, by law, its data, analyses, and forecasts are independent of approval by any other officer or employee of the United States Government.



EIA's commitment to support DOE's Small Business Goals

- EIA successfully achieved it's FY 2009 Small Business Goal of 47% of Procurement Base
- Through third quarter 2009 EIA had obligated \$16.2M to SB
- In fact, EIA has been successful in consistently meeting it's Small Business Goals.



How EIA currently meets it's Small Business Goals

- EIA utilizes it's Omnibus Procurement II or (EOPII) Multiple Award (MAC) IDIQ Contracts
- Tasks are competed among the 30 vendor teams on the EOPII Contracts.
- 16 of the teams are SB led teams
- The EOPII MAC Contracts period of performance ends in January 2010



How EIA will meet it's Small Business Goals over the next five years?



- EIA is in the process of awarding Omnibus Procurement III (EOPIII) Multiple Award IDIQ Contracts to a new group of small and large vendors under Solicitation Number DE-SOL-0000186



The solicitation is for services in seven highly integrated support areas:

- Project Management
- Survey Operations
- Energy Analysis and Modeling
- Data integration
- Product Dissemination and Communication
- Automated Information Technology
- Organizational Support



Potential subcontracting opportunities for other small businesses may exist under the EOPIII Procurement after award.

- The Synopsis was issued in January 2009
- The Proposals were received in June 2009
- The Target award is Dec 2009
