

What We're Doing

- **Submitted Grant Proposal to DOE to \$70 million in State Energy Program ARRA stimulus funding to establish several new programs.**
- **Developing applications and other on-line tools needed to implement the programs.**



New Programs

- **\$13 million: Grants for solar and small-scale wind-power systems installed at state government facilities.**
- **\$10 million: Grants for solar and small-scale wind-power systems installed at local government facilities, including public schools.**
- **\$15 million: Rebate Program for residential, commercial, and non-profit renewable energy installations (solar and small-wind systems).**
- **\$15 million: Rebate Program for owners of residential and commercial property in Virginia for energy-efficiency improvements.**
- **\$10 million: Grants for biomass-to-energy and waste-to-energy projects at water treatment plants, landfill facilities, state power plants, and other installations.**
- **\$10 million: Business development and commercialization of clean-energy technologies.**



EECBG Program in VA

DMME submitted Virginia's Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) to the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) on June 25, 2009, for its \$16.1 million allocation to fund the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program (EECBG) that will focus exclusively on funding energy-related projects at the local government level:

- \$9.7 million is earmarked for direct grants from the state to small cities and counties to support energy conservation activities.**
- \$5.3 million will be available for renewable systems for local government/public buildings such as schools, public libraries, public safety facilities, and governmental centers for the installation of solar thermal, photovoltaic and small-scale wind turbines.**
- \$700,000 will be used to provide technical assistance to local governments to use energy savings performance contracting to improve energy efficiency and reduce utility costs.**
