

A Quick Refresher

- Powerpedia is DOE's internal wiki
- Same software as Wikipedia



- Non-public but also Non-sensitive
 - No PII
 - No Classified
 - No Procurement Sensitive info
- All DOE employees and contractors can read and edit
- Available to all HQ, Labs, M&Os, and Power Administrations





The Genesis

- Oct 2009 Statewiki
 - Led by GC for the Deputy Chief of Staff
 - Initial prototyping and Lessons Learned from IC's Intellipedia
- Jan 27, 2010
 - Blessed by Senior Leadership
 - Including Secretary Chu
- Feb 2010
 - OCIO stands up Powerpedia during Snowmaggedon

Three Key Ways to Measure*

- Vibrancy
 - Is the space active? Yes.
- Socialness
 - Are we working together on knowledge? Yes.
- Relevance
 - Is the knowledge in the wiki relevant to DOE? Emphatically yes.

- OCIO makes Powerpedia available to all Labs and M&Os
- Powerpedia's Biggest Win (July 2011)
- No other DOE collaborative tool has this reach
- Adhoc process for individuals needing access
- Open Question: "Prime Contractors"

- The first major process to move into Powerpedia
- A living timeline of key events across the Department
- Reports going back to Nov 2009
- Main page has 14k+ page views

DOE - DOD Energy Security MOU

(Redirected from DOD Energy Strategies)

The Department of Energy (DOE) and the Department of Defense (DOD) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on July 22, 2010 entitled Concerning Cooperation in a Strategic Partnership to Enhance Energy Security . Also known as the DOE - DOD Energy Security MOU, the MOU establishes an Executive Committee to create an overarching, strategic process between the departments and allow their sub-components to "strengthen and broaden" existing efforts. The Executive Committee is led by Co-Chairs chosen by the leadership in each Department. The Executive Committee established three Advisory Groups tasked to oversee a variety of activities conducted by the agencies.

- OCIO's AHE Staff played key roles
- Bots allow us to automate tasks
 - Four operational bots
 - Two watch for M&OE file uploads and create a PDF
 - Two bots help maintain the wiki
 - Double redirects and stats







Connective Tissue


- "talk" pages are being used
- Most knowledge in the wiki is included in "topical pages"
- Many pages have multiple editors and have been edited over long periods of time
- Most articles have internal links to other articles
- Over 5,000 redirects connecting our various acronyms and alternate names
- Increasingly hear
 - people in the hallway pointing others to Powerpedia
 - people start their searches on Powerpedia






Vibrancy




Stats: Total Pages








Stats: Daily Views


Underway: The 1.18 Upgrade

- Primary goals:
 - Get the enhanced editor working!
 - Stay current with the MediaWiki baseline so we are ready for the upcoming visual editor
- Address a variety of other technical issues
- Schedule
 - Upgrades and testing are already happening behind the scenes
 - Deploy 1.18 by the end of the fiscal year at the latest. Hopefully sooner

A True Visual Editor

- The editor is the most often cited complaint
 - The same is true on Wikipedia
 - WikiMedia's "Visual Editor" project is one of their highest priority efforts
 - First WikiMedia deployments planned for approximately July

 - Many hundreds of people have been trained on using Powerpedia
- The wiki will continue to evolve as our needs for it evolve
- Please help me achieve one million page views and
 100,000 edits by the end of my tour. As of 10 Apr, there are
 - 872k+ page views. We're on pace for 1M views. Let's surpass it!
 - 86k+ edits. We'd need to beat the average of 150 edits/day
