DOE Order 3731.1, SUITABILITY, POSITION SENSITIVITY DESIGNATIONS, AND RELATED PERSONNEL MATTERS, establishes policies, responsibilities, and guidance for suitability, position sensitivity designations, and related personnel matters at DOE activities.

S-3 memo of April 23, 1991 recognized the Director, Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program responsibilities for oversight and implementation of safeguards and security matters within the Naval Reactors program. Therefore, the following paragraph will be included in the next revision to this DOE Order. This clarification, however, is in effect immediately:

"DIRECTOR, NAVAL NUCLEAR PROPULSION PROGRAM shall, in accordance with the responsibilities and authorities assigned by Executive Order 12344 (statutorily prescribed by 42 USC 7158, note) and to ensure consistency throughout the joint Navy/DOE organization of the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program, implement and oversee all policy and practices pertaining to this DOE Order for activities under the Director's cognizance."

In conformance with the responsibilities and authorities set forth above, the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program implements DOE Order 3731.1, without modification. Conflicts arising from the implementation of this Order should be directed to this office for resolution.

This DOE Order Implementation Bulletin should be attached to copies of the subject Order.
