5670.1A - 43, REVISION 1**

DOE Order 5670.1A, MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE, establishes policies, responsibilities, and guidance for the foreign intelligence activities of the Department of Energy. This order cancels DOE Order 5670.1.

Paragraph 5.c of this DOE Order states:

"DIRECTOR, NAVAL NUCLEAR PROPULSION PROGRAM shall, in accordance with the responsibilities and authorities assigned by Executive Order 12344 (statutorily prescribed by 42 USC 7158, note) and to ensure consistency throughout the joint Navy/DOE organization of the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program, implement and oversee all policy and practices pertaining to this Order for activities under the Director's cognizance."

In conformance with the responsibilities and authorities set forth above, the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program implements DOE Order 5670.1A, without modification. Conflicts arising from the implementation of this Order should be directed to this office for resolution.

This DOE Order Implementation Bulletin supersedes Implementation Bulletin Number 5670.1 - 43, Revision 0. This revised Implementation Bulletin should be attached to copies of the subject Order and transmitted to those contractors for which you are responsible.
