Energy Security and Electric Industry Restructuring Forum

With partial funding from DOE, the **Consumer Energy Council of America** convened a blue-ribbon group of electric industry including state legislators, regulators, and energy officials; Federal officials; consumer and environmental representatives; Congressional staff; and academic experts to build a consensus set of electric policy recommendations for public officials.

The consensus set of recommendations was published in the April 2003 report *Positioning the Consumer for the Future: A Roadmap to an Optimal Electric Power System*. Download the 36-page **Executive Summary**.

In addition, **FY2000 grants** to the **National Council on Electricity Policy**, the **National Conference of State Legislators**, and the **Regulatory Assistance Project (RAP)** were continued in FY2002.
