**Subject:** Notification of Planned 230kV Outage at Potomac River Generating Station

In accordance with DOE Order No. 202-07-02, Pepco is required to provide notification of any and all 230kV planned and unplanned outages at Potomac River Generating Station.

To Whom It May Concern:

On Sunday June 24, 2007 Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco) will be taking a planned outage on the 23107 high voltage circuit between Palmers Corner Substation and the Potomac River Generating Station. The outage is scheduled to begin at 4:00 AM on Sunday June 24, 2007 with a scheduled return date of Sunday June 24, 2007 at 2:00 PM. This planned outage schedule is being moved up from the original schedule due to the predicted high temperatures that are expected next week for the Mid-Atlantic region.

These outages are necessary to continue the 230kV reliability upgrades into the Potomac River area.
